

We are pleased to present our report on the Postal Ballot conducted by **Crisil Limited** ("the Company") seeking consent of its Members for the Resolutions as contained in the Notice of Postal Ballot dated **September 24, 2025**.

- In terms of provisions of Section 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act") read with Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, we were appointed as the Scrutinizer by the Company on September 24, 2025 to conduct the Postal Ballot as contained in the Notice dated September 24, 2025 ("Postal Ballot Notice").
- 2. In terms of Sections 110 and 108 of the Companies Act, 2013, and all other applicable provisions, if any, of the Act read with Rules 20 and 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 and in accordance with the relevant circulars issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs ("MCA") from time to time, in relation to inter-alia "Clarification on passing of Ordinary and Special resolutions by companies under the Companies Act, 2013" read with rules made thereunder, Members' approval was sought for the one Special Resolution as contained in the Postal Ballot Notice through e-voting only.

#### 3. Notice of the Postal Ballot

3.1. The company has informed that, on the basis of the Register of Members and the List of Beneficial Owners made available by the Depositories viz., National Securities Depository Limited ("NSDL") and Central Depository Services (India) Limited ("CDSL"), as of September 19, 2025, ("the cut-off date"), the Company had completed the dispatch of Postal Ballot Notice on September 25, 2025, through e-mail to 71891 Members who had registered their email-ids with the Company/ Depositories / Depository Participants / Registrar and Share Transfer Agent (RTA).

- 3.2. The Company had hosted the Postal Ballot Notice on its website and the website of NSDL (e-voting Agency) and also intimated the same to the stock exchanges viz. BSE Limited and National Stock Exchange of India Limited on September 25, 2025.
- 3.3. Pursuant to Rules 20 and 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 and the relevant MCA Circulars, an advertisement regarding the Postal Ballot was published in Financial Express (English Newspaper) and Sakal (Marathi Newspaper) on September 26, 2025.
- 4. In terms of the aforesaid notice, Members were required to convey their assent or dissent, only through remote e-voting system, on e-voting platform provided by NSDL from 9.00 A.M. (IST) on Friday, September 26, 2025 to 5.00 P.M. (IST) on Saturday, October 25, 2025.
- 5. Thereafter, Members' demographic details, voting rights and voting pattern were downloaded by us from NSDL, the e-voting platform.
- 6. After scrutiny of votes cast, all the votes cast by Members were found to be valid.
- 7. We report that the one resolution, 01 (one) Special Resolution, as contained in the Postal Ballot Notice have been passed with the requisite majority.



The Board of Directors of the Company, in its Meeting, held on September 24, 2025 decided to obtain consent of the members through Postal Ballot under Section 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 and 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, in respect of the Special Resolution for the appointment of Mr. Dinesh Khara (DIN: 06737041) as an Independent

Director of the Company.

The Postal Ballot Notice was sent to the Members whose names appear on the Register of Members/List of Beneficial Owners as received from the National Securities Depository Limited (NSDL) and Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL). The Company had on September 25, 2025, completed the dispatch of the Postal Ballot Notice. Members whose names appeared on the Register of Members/List of Beneficial Owners as on Friday, September 19, 2025, i.e. the cut-off date, were eligible for the purpose of

voting.

The Company had made arrangements for e-voting and availed the services of NSDL to provide the facility to the Members for e-voting. Members whose names appeared on the Register of Members/List of Beneficial Owners as on Friday, September 19, 2025, i.e. the cut-off date, were considered eligible for the purpose of voting. In view of prevailing MCA Circulars on postal ballot process, the voting on the resolution covered in the Notice took place through e-voting only and no physical ballots were collected. The voting period commenced on Friday, September 26, 2025, at 9.00 a.m. and ended on Saturday, October 25, 2025, at 5:00 p.m. (inclusive of both the days). The e-voting module was disabled by NSDL at 5.00 p.m. on October 25,

The Company had appointed Mr. S.N. Vishwanathan, Practicing Company Secretary or failing him Ms. Ashwini Vartak, Practicing Company Secretary, as a Scrutinizer for conducting the Postal Ballot process in a fair and transparent manner. Mr. S.N. Vishwanathan submitted his report after completion of e-voting

process.
