**Reg.: Disposal of GST Demand orders dated April 26, 2024**

Dear Sir/Madam,

This is in furtherance to our Letters dated May 01, 2024 and July 29, 2024 whereby, in compliance of Regulation 30 read with sub-para 20 of Para A of Part A of Schedule III of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (“Listing Regulations”), we informed you regarding: (i) GST Orders dated April 26, 2024 under Section 73 of the SGST/ CGST Act, 2017 demanding a sum of Rs. 74,21,917 w.r.t. financial year 2018-19; and (ii) setting aside of the aforesaid GST Orders by the Hon’ble High Court of Delhi vide its order dated July 23, 2024 and remanding the matter back to the Adjudicating Authority for fresh consideration, respectively.

In this context, we would like to inform that the matter was considered afresh by the GST Adjudicating Authority wherein the Adjudicating Authority has disposed off its Orders dated April 26, 2024, on October 10, 2024.

Details as required under Regulation 30 of the Listing Regulations read with SEBI circular SEBI/HO/CFD/CFD-PoD-1/P/CIR/2023/123 dated July 13, 2023, are enclosed as **Annexure-A**.
