Appointment of Mr. Murali Yadama (DIN:00034952) as Non-Executive, Independent Director of the Company

Based on the recommendation of the LNR Committee, the board of directors on 23 July 2026 appointed Mr. Murali Yadama as an Additional Director in the capacity of Non-Executive Independent Director for a term of 5 consecutive years commencing from 23 July 2026 until 22 July 2031, subject to the approval of the members through a Special Resolution without being liable to retire by rotation.

Mr. Murali Yadama is not disqualified from being appointed as Director in terms of Section 164 of the Companies Act, 2013, as amended from time to time. He has given consent in writing to act as director in Form DIR-2, pursuant to Rule 8 of the Companies (Appointment and Qualifications of Directors) Rules, 2014 and intimation in Form DIR 8 in terms of the Appointment Rules to the effect that he is not disqualified under Section 164 of the Act.
