**Sub: Disclosure under Regulation 30 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("SEBI Listing Regulations") – Intimation of order passed**

**Ref: Stock Exchange Intimation No. 30/2024-25 dated May 1, 2024**

With reference to the captioned subject and in earlier intimation as referred above, the Company had informed the stock exchanges about the receipt of an order under section 73 of the SGST Act, 2017, raising demand pursuant to the assessment order passed by the Deputy Commissioner of State Tax, (Mumbai-LTU-520), LTU-2, Mumbai, Maharashtra dated April 30, 2024 for the year 2018-19.

Accordingly, the Company had filed an appeal against the said order before The Commissioner (Appeals). In this regard, the Company has now received the order from the Joint Commissioner of State Tax (Appeal-VI), wherein the order of the Deputy Commissioner has been partially confirmed.

Based on the merits of the matter, prevailing law and the advice of the consultant, the Company is planning to appeal against this order in line with the provision of Section 112 of SGST Act, 2017 and reasonably expect favourable order from the appellate authorities.
