Pursuant to provisions of Regulation 30 read with sub-para 8 of Para B of Part A of Schedule III of SEBI (Listing Obligations & Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("Listing Regulations"), as amended, we hereby submit the disclosure regarding show cause notice received from the Additional Director, DGGI (Director General of GST Intelligence), Coimbatore.

The details of the above Order as required under Regulation 30 of Listing Regulations read with SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/PoD2/CIR/P/0155 dated November 11, 2024, are given below:

a)	brief details of litigation viz. name(s) of the opposing party, court/tribunal/agency where litigation is filed, brief details of dispute/litigation	<p>The Additional Director, DGGI (Director General of GST Intelligence), Coimbatore has issued a show cause notice covering a period of 6 years (FY 2018-19 to FY 2023-24) proposing a demand of Rs. 110,39,03,461/- under Section 74 of the CGST Act, 2017, questioning the classification of product. A proposal of interest and penalty on the principal amount, as applicable, has also been made.</p> <p>This demand has been proposed in-spite of the fact that the Hon'ble Supreme Court has earlier settled the classification of the product in Company's favour under the previous tax regime on classification of the same product. The Company shall be taking appropriate legal remedy under appropriate laws.</p> <p>The Company also wish to inform that in a separate product classification issue raised earlier, the Company, post filing writ petition, received a stay from the Hon'ble High Court.</p>




b)	expected financial implications, if any, due to compensation, penalty etc.;	There is no impact on financial, operation or other activities of the Company due to this show cause notice. The Company shall be taking suitable legal remedy under appropriate laws in consultation with its legal counsel.
