The Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) vide its General Circular No. 20/2020 dated 05th May, 2020, 09/2024 dated 19th September, 2024 read with the relevant circulars on the subject, including General Circular No. 03/2025 dated 22nd September, 2025 (collectively referred to as 'MCA Circulars') and in line with the Circulars issued by the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) has permitted the holding of the Annual General Meeting (AGM) through Video Conferencing (VC)/ Other Audio Visual Means (OAVM), without the physical presence of the Members at a common venue. In compliance with the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 (Act), SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, (SEBI Listing Regulations) and MCA Circulars, the 36th AGM of the Company is being held through VC / OAVM on 30th September 2026 at 3.00 p.m. (IST). The deemed venue for the 36th AGM shall be 419-A, Arun Chambers, 4th Floor, next to AC Market, Tardeo, Mumbai-400034.
3. The AGM is being held pursuant to the Circulars through VC / OAVM, physical attendance of Members has been dispensed with. Accordingly, the facility for appointment of proxies will not be available for the AGM and hence the Proxy Form and Attendance Slip are not annexed to this Notice.
4. Since the AGM will be held through VC / OAVM, the Route Map is not annexed in this Notice.
5. Corporate Members intending to appoint their authorised representatives pursuant to Sections 113 of the Act to attend the AGM through VC/OAVM or to vote through remote e-Voting are requested to send a certified copy of the Board Resolution to the Company.
6. Members attending the AGM through VC / OAVM shall be counted for the purpose of reckoning the quorum under Section 103 of the Act.

For shares having a value above ₹10,000 and up to ₹10 lakh, an Affidavit-cum-Indemnity Bond on a non-judicial stamp paper of appropriate value is required. Duplicate shares shall be issued only in dematerialised form.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION 102 OF THE COMPANIES ACT, 2013:

ITEM NO.4:

The Shareholders of the Company at the Annual General Meeting held on 30th September, 2022 approved the appointment of Mr. Atish Kumar Chattopadhyay (DIN: 09483136) as an Independent Director of the Company, to hold office for a term of 5 (five) consecutive years with effect from 02nd February, 2022 upto 01st February, 2027. Mr. Atish Kumar Chattopadhyay is also the Member of the Committees of the Board of Directors of the Company (the "Board").

Based on the recommendations of Nomination and Remuneration Committee, the Board at its meeting held on Monday 24th August, 2026, has recommended the reappointment of Mr. Atish Kumar Chattopadhyay as an Independent Director of the Company, for a second term of 5 (five) consecutive years with effect from 02nd February, 2027.

Notices under Section 160 of the Companies Act, 2013 (as amended) (the "Act") have been received by the Company from members proposing the candidature of Mr. Atish Kumar Chattopadhyay as an Independent Director of the Company, not liable to retire by rotation. Further, since this re-appointment is recommended by the Nomination and Remuneration Committee, the requirement for deposit of Rs. 100,000/- is not applicable.

Based on the aforesaid recommendations and consent of Mr. Atish Kumar Chattopadhyay to act as a Director of the Company and other statutory disclosures including declaration confirming that he meets the criteria of independence under the Act and the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (as amended) (the "Listing Regulations"), it is proposed to re-appoint Mr. Atish Kumar Chattopadhyay as an Independent Director of the Company whose period of office shall not be liable to determination by retirement of directors by rotation. Further as per the declarations received by the Company, Mr. Atish Kumar Chattopadhyay is not disqualified under Section 164 of the Act. Mr. Atish Chattopadhyay is not a director on the Board of any other company. Accordingly, the provisions relating to the maximum number of directorships prescribed under the Companies Act, 2013 and the SEBI Listing Regulations are duly complied with. The said proposal is in compliance with the Nomination and Remuneration Policy of the Company. On the basis of the report of performance evaluation, Mr. Atish Chattopadhyay is re-appointed as an Independent Director of the Company to hold office, subject to the approval of Company for a second term after considering the overall good performance

thereunder and the Listing Regulations, for his re-appointment as an Independent Director of the Company and he is independent of the management. Mr. Atish Kumar Chattopadhyay is a teacher, fondly called 'Master Moshai' in his native place, Calcutta. Mr. Atish Kumar Chattopadhyay is presently the Director of IMT Ghaziabad, he has rejoined the institute after a gap of about seven years. He has held leadership roles at several institutions, including SPJIMR Mumbai, MICA Ahmedabad, and JAGSoM Bangalore. Additionally, he served as the Founding Vice Chancellor of Vijaybhoomi University, where he developed an innovative liberal-professional curriculum framework based on the multiple-intelligence model. Pedagogical innovations initiated by him won global accolades – featuring in AACSB's 'Innovations.

Brief resume of Mr. Atish Kumar Chattopadhyay as stipulated under Regulation 36(3) of Listing Regulations and SS-2 issued by the ICSI forms part of the Notice. Considering their experience, knowledge and contribution made towards the growth of the Company and pursuant to recommendation of Nomination and Remuneration Committee, the Board of Directors has proposed to re-appoint them with effect from 05th December 2026 to 04th December, 2029 for a further period of 3 years and whose period of office shall be liable to retirement by rotation.

Taking into consideration the increased business activities of the Company and the higher responsibilities cast on Mr. Pranav Padode in addition to that as part of the long-term strategy, from time to time, the Board of Directors, on the recommendation of the Nomination and Remuneration Committee, has approved the proposal to revise his remuneration.
