GST on health, term insurance may be scrapped or cut to 5%

THE GOODS and Services Tax (GST) reforms expected around Diwali this year could likely lead to scrapping of the tax on insurance policies — or at least a calibrated reduction to 5 per cent —

In Kerala village, 'living lab' provides local weather forecast, landslide alert

BEFORE HE ventures for rubber tapping each morning, Anil T R scrolls his WhatsApp for weather updates. The information that he gets isn't from far-off weather stations — it's specifi-cally for his gram panchayat Kanichar, sourced from the neighbourhood and localised just for people like him.

Anii's village of Kanichar—60 km from Kannur—is India's first village panchayat where a living lab approach has been adopted for enhancing dimate sensitivity and people's resilience capacity. Implemented by the Kerafa State Disaster Management Authority (KSDMA), the project has one aim — making the 4,600-odd household owners in the panchayat resilient to natural disasters. Anil's village of Kanichar - 60

disasters. The living lab approach is an ecosystem that integrates real-world settings with research and innovation to create and test so-lutions. First developed in the Netherlands, the approach is marked by the involvement of several stakeholders — including

several stakeholders – including government, experts, private agencies and civic society — to find real-world solutions.

For the village, which saw three people being killed and 36 hectares of farmland being destroyed in a series of landslie in 2022, this has come as a relief. "Every day, we get data on rains and wind from an automatic weather station installer."

rains and wind from an auto-matic weather station installed at the village," 55-year-old Anil says, "When there's heavy rain, there are frequent alerts and up-dates about the situation." The village currently has one automatic weather station to pro-

vide local weather data in the landside-prone panchayat, with authorities now planning a dozen more in the panchayat's 13 wards. Another highlight is that the panchayat will have an early landslide warning system installed by IIF-Borofree.

This is the only place in Kerala where KSDMA has opened a resilience office; who is engaged instrengthening the disaster preparedness and social resilience.

According to Narendra Bharindwal, president, Insurance Embers Association of (India/IBAI)

Brokers Association of India (IBAI), the proposal to scap GST on in-surance would reduce the cost of premiums for policy-holders, thereby improving affordability and encouraging greater penetra-tion of insurance across life, health and general insurance segments "From a policy-holder's perspe rrom a poncy-noncer s perspec-tive, this is a welcome move that aligns with the national vision of 'insurance for all by 2047'," Bharindwal said. Forpolicy-holders, CST reduc-tion or exemption will make in-

rorpolicy-holders, GST reduc-tion or exemption will make in-surance more affordable, espe-cially in retail health and micro-insurance, directly benefitmicro-insurance, directly benefit-ing the masses. For example, if a family health insurance plan costs Rs 50,000 annually, the policy-holder ends up paying Rs 59,000 including GST. For term insurance, where affordability is a major sell-ing point, GST abolition could make basic life coverage more acake basic life coverage more ac-ssible to lakhs of low-and mid-


