Israel hits Lebanon port city Tyre, 8 die

Israel struck the historic port city of Tyre in southern Lebanon on Tuesday, killing at least eight people, the Lebanese health ministry said.

On Monday, Israel and Iran halted direct attacks on each other after an appeal by US President Donald Trump for them to stop. However, Tehran said it would resume hostilities if Israel continued to attack its ally, the Hezbollah militia in Lebanon.

The Israeli raids, the deadliest on Tyre since fighting erupted in Lebanon on March 2, followed an Israeli evacuation order for the entire city. A video purporting to show the aftermath of a deadly strike on the city's eastern edge, verified by Reuters, showed debris

Israeli attack kills 2 Iranian soliders

Dubai: Iranian state television on Tuesday reported that at least two members of an air defence unit were killed in the Israeli attacks that rocked the country the day before. The report represented the first time Iran acknowledged fatalities from the attacks, which have put the Mideast on edge and represented the biggest blow yet to the straining ceasefire in the Iran war.

The conflict between Israel and Hezbollah began when Hezbollah launched rockets at Israel in support of its sponsor, two days after Israel and the US unleashed war on Iran. Israel's refusal to end its campaign in Lebanon, as Iran demands, has hindered Trump's efforts to extend a tenuous ceasefire in the wider US-Israeli war with Iran into a durable settle-

ment. Last week, Israel's military said Hezbollah fighters were hiding in Tyre. Lebanese state media reported people fleeing the city on Tuesday morning after the online evacuation order, with civil defence teams transporting elderly residents into temporary shelters. Israeli evacuation orders for southern Lebanon, much of which its troops occupy, have effectively emptied a fifth of the country, including areas far beyond the front lines.

Booed at NBA finals, POTUS calls it 'cheers'

Donald Trump was booed at a basketball match in New York on Monday as he became the first US president to attend the National Basketball Association (NBA) Finals.

The catcalls occurred after frustrated ticketholders waited for hours in queues that stretched more than two blocks outside Madison Square Garden due to the intense security restrictions accompanying the US president's appearance.

The New York Knicks lost 111-115 to the San Antonio Spurs in game three of the best-of-seven NBA Finals, cutting the lead of the Knicks in the series to 2-1.

After the game, Trump told reporters, "It was, I think, mostly cheers. It was loud, and it was very enthusiastic."

Booing broke out on Monday evening when a camera showed Trump on large screens in the arena while he saluted during the national anthem.

US copter crashes near strait, Trump says both pilots safe

A US Army helicopter crashed near the Strait of Hormuz, but President Donald Trump said the two crew members aboard were not injured in the incident near the strategic waterway that Iran has effectively closed during the war.

What caused the crash remained unclear Tuesday morning in the Middle East, which was still reeling after Iran and Israel exchanged fire the previous day in the biggest blow yet to the straining ceasefire in the Iran war. Iranian state television reported Tuesday the Israeli attacks killed at least two members of the country's air defense units.

Trump, speaking to journalists at John F. Kennedy International Airport in New York after watching the NBA Finals on Monday night, acknowledged the crash.

"The pilots are fine. Yeah," Trump said. "Nobody injured. We are going to issue a report tomorrow. But the pilots are



fine."

Late at night, Trump posted on Truth Social, "I have just been informed by our Great Military that last night the Iranians shot down one of our highly sophisticated Apache Helicopters while patrolling over the Strait of Hormuz. There were two pilots involved, both are safe and uninjured. Nevertheless, the United States must, of necessity, respond to this attack."

The New York Times first reported that a US Army Apache attack helicopter went down near the strait in unclear circumstances. The US military's Central Command and the Defense

Department did not immediately respond to requests for comment from The Associated Press.

Apache helicopters have been a key asset for the American military as it enforces a blockade on Iranian crude oil shipments and tankers, seeking to pressure Tehran into reaching a deal. The helicopters also have been used by the United Arab Emirates to shoot down Iranian drones during the Iran war.

Trump insists an Iran deal is coming

Trump also expressed renewed optimism over negotiations with Iran.

"We have a good chance" of signing a deal in "two or three days," Trump said. But he didn't provide any details on why there was reason for new optimism. Trump has repeatedly predicted that a deal is near over the two months since the US and Iran agreed to an initial ceasefire.

"We're very close to having a very, very good, strong, powerful deal," the president said.

Lost generation: 3.8 mn Afghan girls are out of school, says UN

Kabul: The United Nations has warned that Afghanistan risks creating a "lost generation" as nearly 3.8 million girls continue to remain out of school due to restrictions imposed by the Taliban, local media reported on Tuesday.

Addressing the UN Security Council on Monday, the Acting head of the UN Assistance Mission in Afghanistan (UNAMA), Georgette Gagnon, said an estimated 3.8 million girls aged between seven and 18 years remain out of school.

Lebanon army chief, Munir talk security

The Lebanese army chief on Tuesday met with his Pakistani counterpart Field Marshal Asim Munir, during which the two exchanged views on the evolving regional security situation.

The military's media affairs wing said in a statement that Lebanese armed forces' Commander-in-Chief General Rodolphe Haykal called on Chief of Defence Forces Munir at the General Headquarters (GHQ) in Rawalpindi.



During the meeting, they exchanged views on "matters of mutual interest, evolving regional security environment, defence cooperation and prospects for enhancing bilateral military relations".

Russian navy in Baltic Sea drills amid major NATO exercises

Russia's navy has conducted military drills in the Baltic Sea, practising unguided missile launches, bombing runs and missile strikes, it said, as major US-NATO exercises also took place in the region, the Interfax news agency reported on Tuesday.

The NATO BALTOPS naval exercise, which began on June 4 and runs until June 20, is the biggest war game in the Baltic Sea this year, bringing together some 20 vessels from 15 nations with around 6,000



personnel.

Russia carried out its own drills from June 8 to June 9 in and near its Kaliningrad exclave, involving around 10 military aircraft, including fighter jets and bombers, as well as two small missile ships, according to Interfax.

Zelenskyy in Estonia for summit meeting

Tallinn: Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy arrived in Estonia on Tuesday to attend a summit of Nordic and Baltic leaders and to meet with Estonian President Alar Karis, Estonian public broadcaster ERR reported.
