Pursuant to Regulation 30 read with Para A of Part A of Schedule III of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended, and SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/PoD-2/CIR/P/0155 dated November 11, 2024, we inform you that consequent to Hon'ble Supreme Court's Order dated 23rd October 2024 vide which it has upheld the State's authority to levy import/export fees on denatured alcohol, the Excise Commissioner of Uttar Pradesh has reinstated import/export fees on denatured alcohol by revoking its earlier Order of 2018 by which it had suspended import/export fees on denatured alcohol.

Nature and details of the action(s) taken, initiated or order(s) passed	Reinstatement of Import/Export Fees on Denatured Alcohol by the Excise Commissioner, Uttar Pradesh by revoking its earlier Order of 2018 vide which it had suspended such fees. This is pursuant to the Hon'ble Supreme Court's Order dated 23rd October 2024 vide which it has upheld the State's authority to levy such fees.
Date of receipt of direction or order, including any ad-interim or interim orders, or any other communication from the authority.	The Order was received at the Distillery, at Daurala on 15 th July, 2025. There was a delay in reporting the matter to the undersigned as the Distillery was getting the legality of the order and exploring the possibility of challenging its retrospective impact.

<p>Details of the violation(s) / contravention(s) committed or alleged to be committed</p>	<p>There has been no violation as the import / export fee was in abeyance and notified now retrospectively from 2018-19.</p>
<p>Impact on financial, operation or other activities of the listed entity, quantifiable in monetary terms to the extent possible</p>	<p>There is no material impact financially, operationally or otherwise on the Company, except to the extent of Rs. 8.81 crore. The Company has represented to the Government to reconsider the levy.</p> <p>In the meantime, the Hon'ble High Court of Allahabad (Lucknow Bench) by an interim order dated 30.07.2025 in a writ petition filed by UP Sugar Mills Association, which represents Sugar Mills / Distilleries in the state of Uttar Pradesh, stayed the Order of the UP Government referred to above.</p> <p>The next date of hearing is on 28.08.2025.</p>
