Subject: Intimation under Regulation 30 of SEBI (LODR) Regulations, 2015

Dear Sir/Madam,

In the matter of an application filed by one Mr. Babu Lal Jajoo (Application No. 189/2023(CZ) before the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal (NGT), Central Zone Bench, Bhopal alleging violation in discharge of waste water into river Chambal, Kota against the State of Rajasthan, other Govt. agencies and some corporate entities, the Hon'ble Bench has passed an Order dated 16.10.2025 (received today 17.10.2025 at 10:25 AM) giving certain directives. Shriram Rayons, a Unit of the Company, located at Shriram Nagar, Kota is named as Respondent No. 8. The Hon'ble Bench has not imposed any enforcement action but given certain directives to Shriram Rayons, which will be complied with.

As required under Regulation 30 and sub-para 20 of Para A of Part A of Schedule III of the SEBI (LODR) Regulations, 2015 read with the SEBI Circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CFD-PoD-1/P/CIR/2023/123 dated July 13, 2023, the required information in the prescribed proforma is given below:

NGT has passed an order dated 16th October 2025 in Original Application No. 189/2023(CZ) concerning environmental pollution in Kota city and discharge into the Chambal River. The order addresses industrial and municipal wastewater management issues.
3.	Date of receipt of direction or order, including any ad-interim or interim orders, or any other communication from the authority.	The order was pronounced by the National Green Tribunal on 16th October 2025. The Company received copy of the said order on 17th October 2025.

Details of the violation(s) / contravention(s) committed or alleged to be committed.	<p>No specific violation or contravention has been alleged or found against the Unit Shriram Rayons in the said order.</p> <p>The Original Application was filed concerning broader environmental pollution issues in Kota city arising from discharge of untreated domestic and industrial wastewater into the Chambal River and its tributaries. The order acknowledges that the Company's unit are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Operating with valid Consents to Operate (CTO) issued by RSPCB (with some renewals under process); 2. Discharging treated wastewater within permitted limits; 3. Meeting prescribed environmental

		<p>standards most of the time as per RSPCB's quarterly monitoring reports.</p> <p>The Tribunal's order is focused on ensuring city-wide compliance with environmental regulations and directing municipal authorities to improve sewage treatment infrastructure. The Company's operations have been referenced in the context of the overall industrial and municipal wastewater discharge framework of Kota city.</p> <p>The Order concludes as under:</p> <p>The company is generally complying but must address occasional non-compliance and pending consent renewals to fully meet the Tribunal's expectations and avoid enforcement action.</p>
5.	Impact on financial, operation or other activities of the listed entity, quantifiable in monetary terms to the extent possible.	The order does not impose any penalty, fine, closure directions, or operational restrictions on the Company or its units in Kota. Accordingly, there is no material adverse financial or operational impact on the Company arising from this order.
