# Doctor held for cough syrup deaths got 10% cut for prescribing: Police

THE DOCTOR arrested in connection with the death of several children in Madhya Pradesh's Chhindwara district allegedly got a 10% commission for prescribing a cough syrup that has been linked to the casualties, state police have told a sessions court.

Dr Praveen Soni allegedly received the commission from Sresan Pharmaceutical Manufacturer, the Tamil Nadu-based firm that produced the adulterated Coldrif syrup. On Monday, the Tamil Nadu government ordered the shutdown of the company and revoked its licence, while the ED conducted raids at premises linked to Sresan.

Additional Sessions Judge (Parasia) Gautam Kumar Gujar was hearing Dr Soni's bail application. The court had, on October 8, denied bail, saying that the doctor "knowingly prescribed and allowed administration of a dangerous adulterated drug that could cause child deaths, even after being aware of the government's December 2023 directive

prohibiting such prescriptions for children under four".

The probe report submitted by the police before the court stated that on December 18, 2023, the Directorate General of Health Services, Government of India, issued guidelines to all states and Union Territories directing that Fixed Dose Combinations (FDCs) not be administered to children below four years of age. "Despite this, Dr Soni continued prescribing such medications and Coldrif syrup, even after being aware that the drug was causing urine retention and kidney failure in children," the report alleges.

It states that "15 children have died so far under his treatment"

and that he "received a 10% commission from the company for prescribing Coldrif syrup".

Dr Soni denied the allegations in court. His lawyer, Pawan Kumar Shukla, told the court that as a government doctor, the applicant "merely prescribed medicines during treatment".

"The contaminated batch of the drug was manufactured by the company, of which he had no knowledge. Having practised medicine for 35-40 years, he did

not knowingly prescribe harmful drugs. Drug quality testing is the responsibility of the Drug Controller Department," he told the court.

The police probe is also focusing on his family members after it was "found that a medical store adjacent to his private clinic is owned by his relatives, and the stockist of the dangerous syrup in Chhindwara is a family member", the police report submitted to the court states.

## TN govt shuts firm, cancels its licences

THE TAMIL Nadu government on Monday revoked the manufacturing licences of Sresan Pharmaceuticals, the maker of Coldrif cough syrup linked to the deaths of at least 23 children in Madhya Pradesh and other states and ordered the company's permanent closure.

According to the state's Drug Control Department, laboratory analysis confirmed that the syrup contained 48.6% diethylene glycol (DEG), a toxic industrial solvent that can cause acute kidney failure and death. Officials also found the company had violated over 300 Good Manufacturing Practice and Good Laboratory Practice standards. The facility is located off the Chennai-Bangalore Highway in Sunguvarchatram near Sriperumbudur.

# NC to contest all 4 RS seats in J&K, 'snubbed' Cong keeps out

THE NATIONAL Conference is set to contest all the four Rajya Sabha seats Jammu and Kashmir, for which elections will held on October 24, with ally Congress refusing its offer to contest seat number four.

The NC leadership had announced three candidates for the polls last week, and said that discussions were on with the Congress for the fourth. However, on Sunday, PCC chief Tariq Hameed Karra said the alliance numbers meant that winning a fourth Rajya Sabha seat was impossible, and hence the Congress would not put up a candidate.

Indicating the Congress's unhappiness with the NC, Karra said the party core committee that took the call also "evaluated our experience as part of the ruling alliance over the past year". "We unanimously decided not to field

our candidate for seat number four, since the safe seats that we had sought — No. 1 and 2 — were not offered."

Last week, NC general secretary Ali Mohammad Sagar had announced Chowdhary Mohammad Ramzan, Shammi Oberoi and Sajad Kitchloo as the party's three Rajya Sabha candidates. On Monday, it named party spokesperson Imran Nabi Dar as its fourth candidate.

While Chowdhary Ramzan is an NC leader from Kupwara who lost last year's Assembly polls to Sajad Lone (People's Conference), Sajad Kitchloo is a former NC legislator from Kishtwar who too lost in the state polls to BJP's lone woman legislator, Shagun Parihar. Oberoi has long served as the NC treasurer and has worked closely with J&K Chief Minister and NC vice-president Omar Abdullah, while Dar has been a part of the NC's media team.

On the Congress's decision to not contest the polls, CM Omar

Abdullah said, "We felt that the best chance of winning that seat was with the Congress and they felt otherwise. So be it"

The NC is the single-largest party in the 90-member J&K Assembly, with 41 MLAs. The Congress, which fought the 2024 Assembly polls in alliance with the NC, has 6 MLAs, while another ally CPI(M) has 1 legislator. The NC can also count on the support of 4 Independents.

Pointing out that the BJP has 28 MLAs and has fielded three candidates, Abdullah said the Rajya Sabha polls will be "a true test of who is with the BJP and who is against". "They need 30 (votes) to win a seat and they have 28... The BJP cannot win three seats without doing horse-trading... Not a single MLA besides their 28 has shown any support for the BJP in the past year... Which means if they are claiming they are going to win three seats, it is money power, muscle power and the power of the agencies," the CM said.

## THIRD LEOPARD ATTACK DEATH THIS YEAR

# Six-year-old killed in Shirur, suspected leopard captured

IN THE third incident of a death in human leopard conflict in Pune district this year, a six-year-old girl was mauled to death next to a sugarcane field in Shirur taluka on Sunday morning. On Monday morning, one of the dozen trap cages installed by the Forest Department after the incident, captured a female leopard suspected to be the one that attacked the girl, officials said.

The incident took place around 9.30 am on Sunday in Dhome Mala area of Pimparkhed village of Shirur taluka located around 80 kilometers from Pune City. Forest Officials have identified the deceased girl as Shivanya Shailesh Bombe (5). At the time of the incident, Shivanya was on her way to give water to her grandfather who was working in the field. Officials said that Shivanya's father works for a private company near Pune while the family also has a farm in Pimparkhed.

Initial probe suggests that a leopard who was hiding in the nearby sugarcane field, suddenly attacked the girl inflicting injuries on her neck and hands. Upon witnessing the attack, her grandfather raised an alarm and some other people working in a nearby field also rushed to the location. But before they could reach, the leopard had dragged her to a distance before leaving her. She was rushed to a government hospital in Manchar where she was pronounced dead. Forest Department teams were immediately deployed after receiving information from the locals.

A forest department official said, "The villagers and kin of the deceased held an agitation after the incident and demanded permanent solution to the human-leopard conflict. They held a road

blockade and stopped the forest department vehicles from moving. In response to the incident, we installed 11 trap cages, five trap cameras in the area and also deployed patrolling teams with tranquilizer dart guns. On Monday morning, one of the cages trapped a female leopard aged between five to six years. Based on initial observations, we believe that this is the same animal which had caused the fatal attack on Sunday morning. The leopard has been sent to the Manikdoh leopard rehabilitation centre."

This is the third human death in cases of human leopard conflict in Pune district this year. Earlier this year in April, an 85-year-old woman was killed in an incident of leopard attack in a village in Shirur taluka. In the last week of September, a six-year-old boy who was studying in the open space in front of house in the village of Junnar taluka was killed by a leopard.

The year 2024 witnessed eight deaths in the incidents of human leopard conflict in Pune district with five of those deaths being that of children. These were the second highest toll re-

ported in a year in the last 20 years. After the back to back incidents of human leopard conflict last year, the forest department had issued a Red Alert for 13 villages in a five square kilometer area in Junnar taluka. People in these villages were asked not to step out before 9 am and after 5 pm. Subsequently Pune District Collector had notified over 230 villages from four talukas of Pune district -- Junnar, Ambegaon, Shirur and Khed -- as prone to disaster due to repeated incidents of human leopard conflicts.

Considering various driving factors of human leopard conflict in the region, the forest department has focussed on creating awareness and sensitising villagers. With a growing leopard population in the Junnar forest area in Pune leading to increased incidents of human leopard conflict in the region, the State Forest Department has sent a proposal to the union Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC) to sterilise 36 female and 11 male leopard as a targeted birth control method to bring down the rate of increase of leopard population.
