New-age firms grow, gains priced in: Analysts

Investors advised to wait a few quarters before betting on these stocks

Even as the performance of India Inc was subdued during the September quarter (Q2FY25), a number of new-age companies stood out with a healthy showing.

Zomato, PB Fintech (the parent of Policybazaar and Paisabazaar), PSN - E-Commerce Ventures (which owns Nykaa) all reported robust numbers, reflecting growth and resilience.

reported a consolidated net profit (attributed to owners) for the September quarter at ₹10.04 crore compared to ₹5.85 crore in the same period a year ago, up 72 per cent.

Revenue from operations for the quarter stood at ₹1,874.74 crore compared to ₹1,507.02 crore a year ago, which implies a rise of 24.2 per cent.

Q2FY25 compared to a ₹21 crore loss in the corresponding period a year ago. Revenue grew 44 per cent at ₹1,167.23 crore in Q2 from ₹811.63 crore a year ago, up 43.8 per cent.

From an investment perspective, Ambareesh Baliga, an independent market analyst, believes that most positives are priced in for these firms.
