IN DEVBHUMI DWARKA

Wife's family clubs man to death over interfaith marriage, 6 held

A 24-YEAR-OLD man was allegedly beaten to death by his in-laws who disapproved of their interfaith marriage in Gujarat's Devbhumi Dwarka. As tension gripped the village after the incident, police said that a case of murder had been registered and six people, including the woman's brother and uncles, were arrested Sunday.

Those arrested have been sent to judicial custody Monday. The victim, identified as Yagnik Dudhrejiya, was allegedly assaulted with sticks and axes in Sheddakhai village between 2 pm and 3 pm on August 3.

He was rushed to a government hospital in Jamnagar city where he died late in the evening, the police said.

A resident of Sheddakhai village, Dudhrejiya had married a woman from a different community around a year-and-a-half ago. "However, the woman's family members disapproved of her marriage to a man from another community. The couple

were living elsewhere. But they returned to Sheddakhai around 45 days ago," Bhanvad Police Sub-Inspector KK Maru told *The Indian Express* Monday.

She added that the couple had welcomed a baby girl about a month-and-a-half ago. However, the threats from the woman's family persisted.

"Dudhrejiya was standing at a bus station near his home in Sheddakhai when the accused, wielding wooden sticks, iron pipes and an axe came rushing and beat him severely," the PSI said. The attackers have been identified as Adam Detha (42), his brother Juma (40) and Osman (37), Hothi alias Dado Detha (27), Sajid Detha (26) and Salim Detha (32).

Maru said all the accused are family members of Dudhrejiya's wife Rajma. "Sajid is Rajma's brother, while the rest of the accused are her distant relatives," she said, adding, one teenage boy was also involved in the murderous assault.

Based on a complaint filed by Dudhrejiya's mother Nirmala, a case has been registered under the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita

Sections 103(2) (murder committed by a group of five or more persons on the grounds of race, caste or community or sex), 189(2) (unlawful assembly), 189(4) (unlawful assembly of members armed with deadly weapons), 191(2) (rioting), 191(3) (rioting with deadly weapons) and 190 (common intent of members of an unlawful assembly in committing a crime).

"We produced the six accused in a court on Monday. We have already recovered weapons used for committing the crime and we did not require custody of the accused as of now. Therefore, the court sent the six to judicial custody," said Maru.

Meanwhile, Devbhumi Dwarka Superintendent of Police Nitish Pandey said the situation has been under control in the village.

"We have deployed police and are also doing rounds of patrolling. We have also held a meeting with the local peace committee and there has been no untoward incident since the assault on Saturday afternoon," Pandey told *The Indian Express*.

Game zones shut down: Surat facility files plea against closure order in HC

Ahmedabad: The Gujarat High Court on Monday issued notices on a plea moved by a Surat-based gaming zone challenging the closure notice given to it by civic authorities following the May 25 fire at such a facility in Rajkot, which killed 27 people.

Following the May 25 fire at Rajkot's TRP game zone, the state had closed all gaming zones and the HC, in its May 27 order, said they shall remain closed until further orders. The petitioner, Lets Jump Trampoline and Adventure Pvt Ltd in Surat, said that it was sealed by authorities despite holding requisite permissions.

The petitioner, through its counsel Amit Thakkar, submitted it was served a closure notice pointing out irregularities that were based on "flimsy grounds and without giving it a chance to put its side".

Thakkar said the petitioner had filed a civil application before the HC seeking modification of its May 27 order directing state authorities to not permit any gaming zone to operate until further orders in the wake of the May 25 fire incident.

The petitioner told court it had invested a huge amount of money and employed 120 personnel, and the abrupt closure was causing it huge loss.

The civil application was rejected on July 4, but the petitioner was allowed to challenge the action independently before the competent court. The court issued notices to respondents, including the state government and Surat Municipal Corporation, returnable on August 12. PTI

State govt increases Eklavya Model Schools to 44 with over 11,000 students

THE GUJARAT government has increased the number of Eklavya Model Residential Schools (EMRS) to 44 since its launch in 2003, with more than 11,000 students from the tribal community enrolled there, officials said on Monday.

Beneficiaries said these schools, equipped with cutting-edge classrooms featuring six interactive LEDs, smart technology, and green boards, are a boon for them by offering free and quality education for children from Classes 6 to 12.

Tribal Development Minister Kuber Dindor said more than 12 lakh tribal students have received pre-matric scholarships, and approximately 2.5 lakh students have benefited from post-matric scholarships.

"Thanks to the state government's efforts, education levels among the tribal communities have risen, with children and youth now actively contributing to nation-building through their education," he said.

An EMRS in the tribal-dominated Dahod district has a well-equipped library and computer labs with more than 40 computers and WiFi, providing modern, internet-based education, school principal, Vishnu Kumar, said.

"In our school, we have smart classes in every classroom. We also have a projector room, a li-

brary and sports facilities, which are provided free of cost to children. The objective of this school is to ensure the overall development of children from Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes communities," he said.

The EMRS has separate hostels for boys and girls, with canteens. The school also has sports facilities and offers cultural exposure to students.

"I have been studying here for the last six years, we have received a lot of facilities here. We are happy, and we receive a lot of training. We are proud of our teachers," said Prithvi Damor, a student at EMRS Dahod.

To further support the students, the government provides a grant of Rs 4,000 per student for their uniforms. The first EMRS was launched in Gujarat in June 2003. Today, it has grown to 44, covering 11,066 students, a government statement said.

Under the scheme, admission is based on a centralised test, and qualifying students are allocated a school within a radius of 30 km from their home, it said.

The schools are managed by the Gujarat State Tribal Education Society (GSTES), an autonomous society under the state tribal development department. The GSTES operates Eklavya Model Residential Schools (EMRS) (44), Girls Literacy Residential Schools (GLRS) (43), Model Schools (12), and Sainik Schools (2), it was stated.

CEPT UNIVERSITY Ahmedabad Monday announced the appointment of two Deans and an advisor to lead key initiatives at the institute.

While senior urban planner Prof Shalini Sinha is now the Dean of Faculty of Planning, industry veteran Prof Pranavant is her counterpart in the Faculty of Management.

CEPT alumnus Jinraj Joshipura has joined the university as an advisor to lead Endowment and Alumni and also as a visiting faculty at the Faculty of Management.

The three appointments were made last week, CEPT stated.

Prof Sinha, who has over 23 years of experience in the urban sector across India and the UK, has been a CEPT faculty member from 2009. Currently, she serves as the Programme Chair for the Master of Urban Transport Systems programme and also

heads the Centre of Excellence in Urban Transport (CoE-UT) under the CEPT Research and Development Foundation. Prior to her tenure at CEPT, Prof Sinha had spent eight years in urban and transport consulting. She has authored numerous research papers and practice documents on topics ranging from strategic transport planning, public transport operations to multimodal integration.

Prof Pranavant has been appointed the Dean of Faculty of Management for three years. Born in Bihar, Prof Pranavant completed his undergraduate studies in civil engineering from Birla Institute of Technology, Mesra (Ranchi) in 1984. He then went did Masters in Civil Engineering from NIT, Patna in 2002 and later finished Masters in Public Management and Policy from IIM Ahmedabad in 2008.

Prof Pranavant has worked as a part of government and public sector in infrastructure sector, including as general manager of National Highways Authority of India. He later joined management consultancy firms such as PwC and Deloitte.

CEPT alumnus Joshipura had worked with late BV Doshi and has been practicing architecture with 17 projects to his credit across three countries.

His work on electronic music, deciphering animal language and underwater language, has been archived at NID, BBC, and Getty Museum, USA.

Heavy rain pounds Navsari, Valsad, rivers in spate; 1,300 evacuated

HEAVY RAIN battered Navsari and Valsad districts of south Gujarat, sending rivers in spate and prompting the evacuation of more than 1,300 people from water-logged low-lying areas Monday.

Khergam taluka in Navsari district received 229 mm rain in 24 hours up to 6 am Monday while 12 talukas in Dangs and Tapi districts in south Gujarat received more than 100 mm rain in this period, State Emergency Operation Centre (SEOC) data showed.

Aurang River in Valsad taluka crossed the danger mark amid incessant rain in the upstream areas. Floodwaters of the Kaveri and Ambika rivers in Navsari district inundated low-lying areas.

Approximately 1,000 people were shifted to safety in Gandevi taluka in Navsari district after heavy rainfall triggered a flood in Ambika and Kaveri rivers on Sunday. More than 300 people in the low-lying areas of Valsad were moved to shelter homes over the weekend following heavy rain and a rise in the water level in the Auranga river.

Seven labourers stranded in a flooded pond were rescued by National Disaster Response Force personnel on Sunday, Valsad district administration stated.

"Around 162 people were relocated and shifted to shelter homes from low-lying areas in Valsad city. A man was swept away in floodwater in Dharampur taluka of the district," said in-charge collector ARJha.

Gandevi MLA Naresh Patel said at least 1,000 people were relocated in Navsari district. "An elderly man was swept away in the flood and effort is underway to recover his body," Patel said.

The water level in the Auranga river had risen to the dangerous level of 4 metres at Bhairavi village following heavy rainfall Sunday. As a result, the Valsad district administration, with assistance from fire brigade officials and police teams, had to relocate 300 residents from the low-lying areas in Kashmiranagar to shelter homes.

The India Meteorological Department (IMD) had predicted heavy rain in the district on Monday and Tuesday. However,

barring the 25 mm rainfall in Kaprada taluka, Valsad saw no rain until Monday noon.

The authorities closed 98 roads in various villages due to waterlogging Sunday. District authorities have advised people to use alternative routes.

"Currently, the situation is under control, and there is no major rainfall in the district. The water level in the Auranga river is receding. Out of the 98 roads closed Sunday, many have started reopening for public use. Those who were relocated to shelter homes are now returning to their houses. No casualties have been reported so far. The fishing community has been advised not to go to sea for fishing activities," Valsad Disaster Management Mamlatdar Nafisha Shaikh told *The Indian Express*.

Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel spoke with collectors of Navsari and Valsad districts, directing them to shift residents of low-lying areas to safer places and prevent loss of life and property due to rain.

Khergam taluka in Navsari district was pounded by 229 mm rainfall in 24 hours ending 6 am on Monday, followed by 185 mm and 180 mm rainfall in Dharampur and Valsad talukas, respectively. At least 12 talukas, including the Dangs and Tapi districts in south Gujarat, received more than 100 mm of rainfall, according to SEOC.

With the recent wet spell, Gujarat has recorded more than 67 per cent of the total average rainfall of the monsoon season so far. Kutch zone received the highest rainfall of 86 per cent in the

state, followed by the south Gujarat region, and Saurashtra zone with 81 per cent and 77 per cent of rainfall, respectively.

Comparatively, north and east-central Gujarat recorded around 50 per cent of the cumulative average rainfall of the season so far, the SEOC stated.

With upstream areas receiving heavy rains, the water storage in the Sardar Sarovar Dam in Narmada district crossed 60 per cent of its storage capacity at 2,04,901 million cubic feet (mcf).

The water storage in another 206 reservoirs across Gujarat reached 3,25,972 mcf at 58.19 per cent of their total storage capacity, while 47 reservoirs are brimming. Ten other reservoirs are 90 to 100 per cent full, raising a high alert, the state Water Resources Department said. A total of 13 reservoirs in south Gujarat region are 70.32 per cent full. The water storage in 141 reservoirs in Saurashtra region increased to 52.68 per cent. In Kutch, 20 reservoirs are 52.15 per cent full.

The water level in Madhuban Dam has also risen significantly due to heavy rainfall in Maharashtra's upper catchment area and Valsad. On Sunday, the dam authorities recorded heavy inflow of water, reaching up to 1.11 lakh cubic metres and as a result, the water level rose to 76.60 metres, nearing the danger mark of 80 metres. The dam's total storage is 265.26 million cubic metres.

On Sunday, over 14.62 lakh cusecs of water from Madhuban Dam were discharged to the river, while on Monday, it was reduced to 47,762 cusecs.

AMID INCESSANT rainfall, the Indirasagar Dam (ISP) authorities in Madhya Pradesh has alerted that they would start releasing 9,252 cumec (3.32 lakh cusec) of water on Tuesday by opening eight gates of the largest reservoir of the country.

According to officials, the water released from Indirasagar will arrive in the Sardar Sarovar Dam a day later, through Omkareshwar (OSP) Dam in Madhya Pradesh. The development comes even as the Sardar Sarovar Project in Narmada crossed the 125-metre mark Monday due to heavy rainfall.

Both ISP and OSP have been generating hydropower to release water from their reservoirs. On Monday, Sardar Sarovar recorded a level of 125.07 metres with an inflow of 92,148 cusecs.

Six turbines of the Riverbed Powerhouse of the Sardar Sarovar are currently operating in 12-hour cycles to produce hydropower, while two turbines of the Canal Head Powerhouse are also operational.

An average inflow of about 95,000 cusecs from upstream Narmada dam has been recorded since mid-July, taking the level up by about five centimetres a day, SSNNL officials said. Currently, the Sardar Sarovar basin has about 2,101.02 million cusecs of water, which is about 60 per cent of the dam's capacity.

On Monday, the Gujarat government said in a release that 47 of the 206 other dams in Gujarat had been completely filled, leading to a high alert sounded in the respective areas. Close to 10 dams are filled over 90 per cent capacity and are on high alert, while 38 dams are over 70 per cent full with warning alerts.

IN VADODARA'S SSG HOSPITAL

3-member panel to probe video of 'unauthorised' man suturing patient

A THREE-MEMBER committee was formed on Monday to probe a widely shared video of an 'unauthorised' person allegedly suturing a patient at the emergency ward of Vadodara's SSG Hospital even as the hospital medical superintendent termed the incident "unacceptable".

SSG Hospital Medical Superintendent Dr Ranjan Aiyer set up the three-member committee comprising Baroda Medical College Dean Dr Rupal Doshi, Orthopedics Associate Professor Dr Viswanath H Chavali and Resident Medical Officer in charge Dr Hitendra Chauhan to look into the matter and submit a report in three days. According to the hospital, the incident took place between 11 pm on August 3 and midnight on August 4, when the 'unauthorised' person was allegedly "assisting trainee interns".

Aiyer said, "A video has been brought to my notice and is also circulating on social media... We don't know the exact time frame of the video. An unauthorised person wearing surgical gloves, holding needles and taking sutures on a patient can be seen in the video which seems to be from one of the emergency wards of SSG. A probe has been directed into the incident. According to primary investigation, this person was allegedly assisting the trainee interns."

"We have directed the probe to find if this person had any authorisation, who gave him gloves and equipment? Who were the people watching him doing the sutures? Who was on duty that day?" Aiyer said. "We have not received any complaint from the patient seen in the video... However, if an unauthorised person entered the emergency ward and administered the stitches on a patient, it is unacceptable. Strict action will be taken against all those responsible," he said.

Aiyer said, "...if the video is recent, the information on who was on duty will be available. This is an educational medical college and we also train undergraduate students to take sutures. So, we are investigating the matter."

According to sources, the unauthorised person seen in the video has been alleged to be a private ambulance driver, however, there is no confirmation regarding the same.
