# CPSE dividends on track to meet FY26 target

● ₹57,800 crore collected so far

New Delhi, February 22

**THE CENTRE'S DIVIDEND** receipts from central public sector enterprises (CPSEs) have reached ₹57,800 crore so far this financial year. This is marginally lower than collections during the same period last year but remains broadly on track to meet the full-year budget target.

In the revised estimates for FY26, the government pegged CPSE dividend receipts at ₹71,000 crore, higher than the budget estimate of ₹69,000 crore, signifying that the government is targeting relatively benign global crude oil and commodity prices, which supported profitability in several state-owned energy companies.

The pattern has broadly

major sources such as surplus transfers from the Reserve Bank of India and proceeds from telecom spectrum auctions. In FY25, CPSE dividend receipts climbed to a record ₹74,140 crore, comfortably exceeding the budgeted target of ₹69,000 crore. That increase was aided by relatively benign global crude oil and commodity prices, which supported profitability in several state-owned energy companies.

The pattern has broadly

sovereign investment vehicles have emerged as significant dividend contributors. The National Investment and Infrastructure Fund has paid a dividend of ₹4,013 crore to the Centre so far, while returns from the SWAMIH housing fund amounted to about ₹1,078 crore, highlighting the growing role of such platforms in augmenting non-tax receipts.

Higher dividend inflows from CPSEs, together with the record surplus transfer from the Reserve Bank of India, have helped cushion the Centre's fiscal position in recent years. Supported by an RBI dividend of ₹2.69 lakh crore, the fiscal deficit for FY26 has been pegged at 4.4% of GDP, lower than 4.8% in FY25. Overall, non-tax revenue is estimated to rise to ₹5.36 lakh crore in FY26, reflecting an estimated year-on-year growth of about 24.4%.

**PRIME MINISTER NARENDRA** Modi on Sunday inaugurated development projects worth around ₹12,930 crore in Meerut and said the BJP's work culture ensures the timely completion of projects once their foundation is laid.

Addressing a public meeting after flagging off the Meerut Metro and the Namo Bharat train from Shatabdi Nagar Namo Bharat Station, Modi said the programme showcased the governance model of the "double-engine" government.

"BJP's work culture is about toiling day and night to ensure projects are completed once their foundation is laid. Improved law and order and safer travel have now transformed the area," he said.

He said for the first time, rapid rail and metro services were launched from the same platform and called it a glimpse of the connectivity envisioned for a developed India. "Metro for intra-city travel and modern rapid rail for cleaner, faster mobility together reflect the vision of urban transformation," Modi said.

The prime minister said projects no longer face prolonged delays as in the past, and noted that he had the opportunity to both lay the foundation and inaugurate the services.

Recalling his metro ride earlier in the day, he said students and other passengers expressed surprise at the scale and quality of the infrastructure. He said the region has undergone a transformation with increased workers' participation in various sectors.

## Rapid rail services to reduce travel time: CM Yogi

**UTTAR PRADESH CHIEF** Minister Yogi Adityanath on Sunday lauded the Centre's push for digital and physical infrastructure, saying India's transformation under Prime Minister Narendra Modi has drawn global recognition and improved ease of living for citizens.

Addressing a gathering at the inauguration of the Namo Bharat Rapid Rail and Meerut Metro services, Adityanath said India has built a robust digital public infrastructure covering 1.4 billion people, processing nearly 20 billion digital transactions every month.

He said more than 500 million digital health IDs have been issued under the "One Health" initiative, enabling beneficiaries to avail treatment under the Ayushman Bharat scheme.

Referring to praise from French President Emmanuel Macron, the chief minister said the world has acknowledged India's success in leveraging technology to deliver welfare benefits to the poor, farmers and youth without discrimination. Adityanath said the prime minister's regular review of infrastructure projects has helped fast-track projects worth ₹85 lakh crore that had remained pending for decades.

## 'Looking forward to my upcoming Israel visit'

**PRIME MINISTER NARENDRA** Modi on Sunday said he was looking forward to his upcoming visit to Israel. The prime minister said this on X in response to Israel's Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's comment that Modi will visit Israel on Wednesday.

"Thank you, my friend, Prime Minister Netanyahu. I fully agree with you on the

bond between India and Israel as well as the diverse nature of our bilateral relations. India deeply values the enduring friendship with Israel, built on trust, innovation and a shared commitment to peace and progress. Looking forward to our discussions during my upcoming Israel visit," he said.

Taking a swipe at the Congress, Modi said metro services were operational in only five cities during its tenure, whereas the BJP-led government had expanded the facility to more than 25 cities.

## Mumbai-Pune E-way disruption: Motorists to get toll refund

**MORE THAN 100,000** motorists who were caught up in a massive traffic gridlock on Mumbai-Pune Expressway earlier this month after a gas tanker mishap valued at ₹5.16 crore, a senior Maharashtra State Road Development Corporation official

said. On February 3, a gas tanker turned turtle on the Khopoli stretch of the Expressway, leading to a 33-hour disruption which saw traffic come to a standstill for several kilometres, leaving many motorists and passengers facing shortage of water, food and other basic amenities.

Following the accident, the administration had ordered an immediate suspension of toll collection. However, by then, toll charges had already been deducted from the FASTag accounts of several motorists.

"It has been decided to refund the entire amount col-

lected from vehicle owners even after the order to halt toll collection was issued. The refund of ₹5.16 crore will be processed by MSRD. The amount will be directly credited to FASTag accounts of affected vehicle owners in the next few days," official.

# Maha brace for Budget session face-off over plane crash row

**THE MAHAJUTI AND** the Opposition are headed for a showdown on several issues, including the death of Deputy CM Ajit Pawar in a plane crash, mounting debt on government, and the impact of the Indo-US deal on farmers, in the Budget session of the state legislature beginning Monday.

This will be the first session in Maharashtra's legislative history in which both the assembly and legislative council won't have a Leader of Opposition (LoP). Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis is scheduled to present the state budget for the financial year FY27 on March 6, replacing Deputy CM Ajit Pawar, who was killed in a plane crash last month.

This will be the first legislative session of Pawar's wife and

newly-appointed Deputy CM Sunetra Pawar. On Sunday, the Opposition boycotted the customary tea party hosted by Fadnis, claiming that the state government had not expressed any regret over the potential impact of the Indo-US trade deal on cotton growers and fisherfolk from Maharashtra.

The Opposition camp, however, suffered an embarrassment when leaders of the NCP (Sharadchandra Pawar) skipped the Maha Vikas Aghadi meet-

ing, citing previous engagements. Shiv Sena (UBT) played down the absence of the ally, attributing it to a "bit of a communication gap".

However, the timing raised eyebrows as the Uddhava Thackeray-led party has asserted its "first right" to the opposition alliance's lone winnable Rajya Sabha seat from Maharashtra in the upcoming elections.

Addressing a press conference, Fadnis said the state government has requested Union Home Minister Amit Shah to order a CBI investigation into the plane crash that killed NCP chief Ajit Pawar last month.

He said the month-long session would see the introduction of 15 Bills. The chief minister announced that he would seek to implement the ideas and suggestions of the late Pawar.

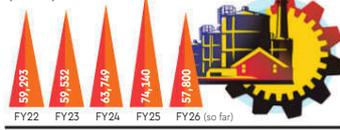

the budgeted target of ₹69,000 crore. That outperformance was aided by relatively benign global crude oil and commodity prices, which supported profitability in several state-owned energy companies.

The pattern has broadly continued in FY26, with dividend payments once again dominated by energy sector

\*In terms of Regulation 7(1) of the SEBI (Substantial Acquisition of Shares and Takeovers) Regulations, 2011 ("SEBI SAST Regulations"), the open offer is required to be made for at least 26% (twenty six percent) of the Emerging Voting Share Capital of the Target Company, as on the 10th working day from the closure of the tendering period. As on such date, the public shareholding of the Target Company comprises 12.04% (Twelve Point Zero Four Percent) of the Emerging Voting Share Capital, after excluding the Other Shareholders of the Transferor Company who are proposed allottees in the preferential issue and are considered as Deemed Persons Acting in Concert with the Acquirers and the PAC for the purposes of this open offer and are, accordingly, ineligible to participate in the Open Offer in compliance with the provisions of regulation 7(6) of the SEBI (SAST) Regulations, 2011. The Acquirers have made a deposit of ₹ 1,75,00,000/- (Rupees One Crore Seventy Five Lakh only) in cash, being equal to 25% (twenty five percent) of the Offer Consideration payable to the Public Shareholders under this Offer. The amount deposited in the Escrow Cash Account is in compliance with the requirement of deposit of escrow amount as per Regulation 17 of SEBI (SAST) Regulation, 2011. The cash deposit has been confirmed by the Escrow Agent vide its letter dated February 20, 2026. Further, a fixed deposit shall be created against the aforesaid Escrow Account and lien shall be marked (subject to applicable law) in favour of the Manager to the Offer on the said fixed deposit.

3. The Manager to the Open Offer is duly authorized and has been duly empowered to operate and realize the value of the Escrow Cash Account in terms of SEBI (SAST) Regulations, 2011.

4. The Acquirers have confirmed that they have adequate financial resources to meet their obligations under the Open Offer and have made firm financial arrangements for financing the acquisition of the Offer Shares, in terms of Regulation 25(1) of the SEBI (SAST) Regulations, 2011.

(iv) such circumstances as in the opinion of the Board, merit withdrawal.

In the event of such a withdrawal of the Open Offer, a public announcement will be made within 2 (two) Working Days of such withdrawal. In the same newspapers in which this DPS has been published and such public announcement will be sent to BSE, SEBI and the Target Company at its registered office.

# भारत-अमेरिका व्यापार कराराला ब्रेक; टॅरिफ वाढीमुळे चर्चा लांबणीवर

**नवी दिल्ली, दि. २२ (वृत्तसंस्था) :** भारत आणि अमेरिका यांच्यातील बहुप्रतीक्षित अंतरिम व्यापार कराराला पुन्हा एकदा अडथळा निर्माण झाला आहे. अमेरिकेचे राष्ट्राध्यक्ष Donald Trump यांनी आयात शुल्कात केलेल्या अनपेक्षित वाढीमुळे आणि न्यायालयीन घडामोडीमुळे दोन्ही देशांमधील महत्त्वाची बैठक सध्या पुढे ढकलण्यात आली आहे. परिणामी वॉशिंग्टनमध्ये होणाऱ्या चर्चेला तास्रुता ब्रेक लागला आहे. भारतीय मुख्य वाटाघाटीकारांची टीम २३ फेब्रुवारीपासून तीन दिवसांच्या अमेरिका दौऱ्यावर जाणार होती. मात्र, वृत्तसंस्था पीटीआयच्या माहितीनुसार सध्याच्या परिस्थितीचा आणि त्याच्या संभाव्य परिणामांचा सखोल अभ्यास करण्यासाठी दोन्ही देशांनी थोडा वेळ घेण्याचा निर्णय घेतला आहे. त्यामुळे परस्पर संमतीने ही बैठक पुढील सोयीस्कर तारखेला घेण्याचे ठरवण्यात आले आहे. या घडामोडींच्या केंद्रस्थानी Supreme Court of the United States यांचा महत्त्वाचा निकाल आहे. ६-३ अशा बहुमताने न्यायालयाने स्पष्ट केले की राष्ट्राध्यक्षांना 'इंटरनॅशनल इमर्जन्सी इकॉनॉमिक पॉवर्स अॅक्ट' अंतर्गत सर्व देशांवर ससप्तकट मोठ्या प्रमाणात टॅरिफ लावण्याचा अधिकार नाही. या निर्णयामुळे ट्रम्प प्रशासनाने पूर्वी लागू केलेले अनेक टॅरिफ अवैध ठरले. न्यायालयाच्या या निकालानंतर ट्रम्प यांनी शुक्रवारी सर्व



देशांवर १० टक्के टॅरिफ लागू केला आणि त्यानंतर

शनिवारी तो वाढवून १५ टक्के करण्याची घोषणा केली. हे नवीन दर २४ फेब्रुवारीपासून पुढील १५० दिवसांसाठी लागू राहणार आहेत. दरम्यान, ट्रम्प यांनी स्पष्ट केले आहे की भारत-अमेरिका व्यापार कराराच्या चर्चेत कोणताही बदल झालेला नाही. मात्र बदललेल्या प्रेमवर्कनुसार भारतीय निर्यातीवर टॅरिफ लागू राहतील. भारताच्या वाणिज्य आणि उद्योग मंत्रालयाने सांगितले की, सरकार अमेरिकन सर्वोच्च

न्यायालयाच्या निर्णयाचा आणि ट्रम्प प्रशासनाच्या पावलांचा बारकाईने अभ्यास करत आहे. २०२५ च्या सुरुवातीपासून भारतीय उत्पादनांवर कधी ५० टक्क्यांपर्यंत टॅरिफ लावले जाणे तर कधी सवलतीची घोषणा होणे, अशा चढउतारांची परिस्थिती दिरंगन आली आहे. या पार्श्वभूमीवर भारत सरकार आता अत्यंत सावधगिरीने पुढील पावले टाकत असल्याचे संकेत मिळत आहेत.
