EXPANDING PRESENCE ACROSS INSTITUTIONAL MOBILITY APPLICATIONS

Delta Autocorp Limited (“Deltic”) wishes to inform stakeholders that its electric three-wheeler vehicles have been selected for supply under two separate government-led electric mobility procurement programs across Eastern India, covering approximately **240 L5 electric garbage collection vehicles and 100 L3 electric rickshaws\***. The Company has qualified as the OEM supplier under these programs and is currently awaiting issuance of the formal work orders and procurement schedules from the respective authorities and executing entities.

Based on current procurement requirements, the opportunities represent a potential supply value of approximately \*₹8–10 crore, with execution expected during **H1 FY 2026-27\***, subject to issuance of the relevant work orders and supply schedules.

The program involving approximately **240 L5 electric garbage collection vehicles marks Deltic’s first institutional mobility program in the L5 category**, representing an important milestone in the

Company's expanding commercial mobility portfolio. The development reflects Deltic's continued efforts to broaden its participation across utility-oriented and institutional mobility applications, while strengthening its presence beyond traditional retail-driven demand segments.

The opportunities span sanitation, waste management, public utility, and last-mile service requirements, where electric three-wheelers are increasingly being adopted owing to their operating economics, practicality, and suitability for high-utilization environments. Deltic's presence across both L3 and L5 categories enables the Company to address a broader range of mobility requirements as electrification continues to expand across public-sector and commercial applications.

Over the last several quarters, Deltic has steadily strengthened its commercial mobility platform through product portfolio expansion, manufacturing readiness, service network development, retail ecosystem strengthening, and continued investment in product development capabilities. These efforts are gradually enabling the Company to participate in a wider range of opportunities across retail, commercial, and institutional mobility segments.

In addition to these programs, the Company continues to actively participate in similar opportunities across **Northern and Western India**, where electrification initiatives across public utility and commercial mobility applications continue to gather momentum. Deltic remains encouraged by the increasing scale of such opportunities and continues to strengthen its readiness across products, service support, and execution capabilities.

The development also supports the Company's strategy of building multiple operating channels across its mobility ecosystem, including **\*Company-Owned Company-Operated (COCO) retail outlets for both two-wheeler and three-wheeler products, dealership-led retail sales, commercial mobility solutions, and institutional procurement programs\***. The Company believes that this multi-channel approach strengthens long-term business resilience by creating multiple avenues for growth across retail, commercial, and institutional mobility segments, while reducing dependence on any single market category or demand cycle.

These developments complement Deltic's broader strategy of building a diversified electric mobility platform spanning two-wheelers, passenger three-wheelers, cargo vehicles, utility-focused mobility solutions, and institutional mobility applications. As the Company continues to expand its commercial mobility portfolio, participation across government and public utility programs is expected to increasingly complement its retail and commercial mobility businesses.

Deltic remains committed to developing practical, affordable, and purpose-driven electric mobility products designed around Indian operating conditions while continuing to expand its presence across emerging mobility segments.
