Deltic Announces “Crossberg” - An Affordable Premium Electric Scooter Designed for India’s Real-World Riding Conditions



Delta Autocorp Limited (“Deltic”) announces the introduction of Crossberg, an electric scooter developed to meet a clear market gap: an affordable premium family scooter with retro elegance, robust engineering, and long-term reliability. Crossberg has not been positioned merely as another entrant in the scooter category; it is a statement of intent.

Built on extensive Indian rider-behaviour data, Crossberg reflects how families actually use their scooters: their load patterns, daily distances, and the varied road conditions they navigate. This approach results in a product centred on build quality, structural strength, and everyday practicality rather than unnecessary complexity.

The scooter features a performance-balanced chassis, 172 mm ground clearance, with a wheelbase of 1410 mm and a 1928 mm overall length, one of the largest in the segment. These proportions offer a stable, confident stance while retaining agility for urban and

semi-urban movement. Its refined retro design, combined with Deltic's signature Ergo-Tail silhouette, delivers a premium presence aligned with India's evolving aesthetic expectations.

Powered by a 64V 30Ah lithium (LFP) battery, Crossberg provides 75+ km of real-world range, engineered for narrow lanes, mixed surfaces, and high-frequency stop-and-go riding. Reinforced structural elements—from the strengthened frame to thicker ABS body panels—support long-term, high-usage family mobility across Bharat.

Crossberg projects a quiet confidence. It avoids exaggerated specifications and focuses instead on durability, practicality, and dependable performance - the fundamentals that will matter most to Indian consumers over the next decade.

The introduction of Crossberg marks a shift in Deltic's product discipline, design coherence, and manufacturing maturity. It reflects the company's transition toward a more precise, quality-led EV portfolio, reinforcing Deltic's readiness to compete on engineering depth and long-term operational stability.

The official unveiling is scheduled for Q4, along with additional models in final development.
