In accordance with Section 101 of the Act, read with Rule 18 of the Rules and in compliance with the MCA Circulars, the Company is sending this Notice only in the electronic form to those Members whose e-mail addresses are registered with the Company/Registrar and Share Transfer Agent (‘RTA’)/ Depositories and whose names appear in the Register of Members / List of Beneficial Owners as on Friday, 13th February, 2026 (‘Cut-off date’). In compliance with the provisions of Section 108 and Section 110 of the Act read with Rule 20 and 22 of the Rules, Regulation 44 of the SEBI Listing Regulations, and SS-2, the Company is pleased to provide remote e-voting facility to its Members, to enable them to cast their votes electronically instead of submitting the Postal Ballot Forms physically. The communication of the assent or dissent of the Members would only take place through the remote e-Voting system. The detailed procedure for remote e-Voting forms part of the 'Notes' section to this Notice. The Company has engaged the services of "National Securities Depository Limited" (NSDL) for facilitating e-voting.

In terms of Section 102 of the Companies Act, 2013, the following Explanatory Statement sets out all the material facts relating to the Item No. 1 of the accompanying Notice:

Item No. 1

Appointment of Mr. Sanjiv Goel (DIN: 03616090) as an Independent Director of the Company, for the first term of 5 years:

Based on the recommendation of the Nomination and Remuneration Committee, the Board of Directors of the Company ("Board") in its meeting held on 5th February, 2026 had appointed Mr. Sanjiv Goel (DIN: 03616090) as an Additional Director (Non-Executive, Independent) of the Company for a first term of five (5) years effective from 5th February, 2026, not liable to retire by rotation, subject to the approval of the Members of the Company.

Further, in terms of the amended Regulation 17(1C) of the SEBI Listing Regulations, effective from January 01, 2022, a listed entity shall ensure that the approval of the Members for appointment of a person on the Board of Directors has to be taken either at the next general meeting or within a time period of three months from the date of appointment, whichever is earlier. Accordingly, approval of the shareholders is sought in the ensuing Postal Ballot to comply with the SEBI Listing Regulations.
