CHAMPIONS LEAGUE | Real going to Liverpool and Almaty TOUGH DRAW FOR PSG

Paris Saint-Germain was handed a tough start to the defense of its Champions League title when the draw was made Thursday with no opponent from any of the lower-ranked nations.

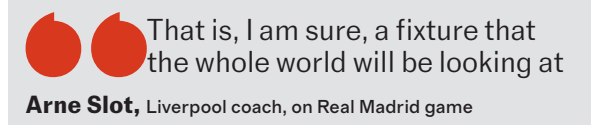
PSG was drawn against Bayern Munich and Barcelona from the pot of top-ranked teams, while Tottenham came from the pot of third-seeded teams in a repeat of their tight Super Cup game two weeks ago.

Bayer Leverkusen, Atalanta and Portuguese champion Sporting Lisbon complete the title holder's slate of eight games in the 36-team league phase.

"It's always difficult," said PSG president Nasser Al-Khelaifi, whose team stumbled to 15th place in the single-standings league last season before surging to its first Champions League title.

Madrid and Liverpool drawn together again

Real Madrid also got a challenging draw, including a long-haul trip to play Kairat Almaty of Kazakhstan - 6,420 kilometers (4,000 miles) from the Spanish capital, which is the furthest east the Champions League has ever gone.

Record 15-time champion Madrid got two English opponents from the pot of highest-ranked teams. Madrid will host Manchester City, which it beat in the knockout playoffs last season, and return to Liverpool after losing 2-0 at Anfield in the league phase last year.

PRIZE MONEY

UEFA has allocated 2.47 billion euros (\$2.88 billion) in prize money for the 36 teams.

The lowest-ranked team, Kairat, is guaranteed at least 20 million euros (\$23 million) from UEFA. High-ranked teams Real Madrid and PSG will get at least 60 million euros (\$69 million).

The title winner should receive about 150 million euros (\$175 million) in prize money.

Foreigners announced for first Archery Premier League

The Archery Association of India on Friday announced nine out of 12 foreign Archers who will compete in the inaugural edition of the Archery Premier League, set to take place at the Yamuna Sports Complex in New Delhi from October 2 to 12, 2025.

The national federation has roped in the USA's Brady Ellison, the reigning No. 1 Men's Recurve Archer in the world. The five-time Olympic medalist will be joined by 2020 Tokyo Olympics Gold medalist Mete Gazoz (World No. 8) from Turkey in the Men's Recurve line-up for the competition.

Mexico's Alejandra Valencia (World No. 5), who won a bronze medal each at the Tokyo Olympics and Paris Olympics, will also compete in the tournament among the Women's Recurve Archers.

The Women Compound archer's line-up includes Mexico's Andrea Becerra (World No. 1), Great Britain's Ella Gibson (World No. 2), and Estonia's Meeri-Marita Paas (World No. 5).
