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विधानसभा में खंडवा विधायक छाया मोरे ने स्वी मांग खंडवा को जबलपुर के बजाय इंदौर हाई कोर्ट बेंच से जोड़ा जाए

प्रश्न काल के दौरान गुड़ी उपमंडी, गोशालाओं में सोलर प्लांट और छेमांव माखन को नगर पंचायत बनाने की भी स्वी मांग

खंडवा, (निप्र)। पंचायत विधानसभा की विधायक छाया मोरे निरंतर क्षेत्र के समग्र विकास के लिए सक्रिय रूप से प्रयासरत हैं, उसी कड़ी में विधानसभा सत्र के दौरान भाजपा विधायक छाया मोरे ने एक के बाद एक कई महत्वपूर्ण मुद्दे उठाए।

समाजसेवी बहू प्रवक्ता सुनील जैन ने बताया कि विधानसभा की विधायक छाया मोरे ने किसान, पशुपालक, नगरीय विकास तथा न्याय व्यवस्था से जुड़े विभिन्न विषयों पर तत्कालित प्रश्नों के माध्यम से सरकार से जवाब मांग और जनहित में ठोस कार्यवाई की अपेक्षा जताई। पूछे गए प्रश्न क्रमांक 627 में छाया मोरे ने किसान कल्याण एवं कृषि विकास मंत्री से जानना चाहा कि क्या पंचायत विधानसभा अंतर्गत गुड़ी कृषि उपमंडी में प्लेटफार्म, लिंक सीसी रोड, पेजल संरचना, तोलकाटा तथा कृषक विश्रामगृह जैसी मूलभूत सुविधाओं की कमी है? उन्होंने यह भी पूछा कि यदि ऐसा है तो इन सुविधाओं की पूर्ति कब तक की जाएगी? इसके बाद छाया मोरे ने प्रश्न क्रमांक 1397 के माध्यम से पशुपालन एवं



डेयरी विभाग से यह जानकारी मांगी कि क्या मध्य प्रदेश में गोशालाओं में रेशन के लिए सोलर प्लांट लगाने की कोई योजना है? साथ ही उन्होंने पंचायत विधानसभा की 7 सुचारु रूप से कार्यरत गोशालाओं का भी भगवती देवी गोशाला समितित ग्राम सरसी, नवीन सुगंध गोशाला ग्राम देशगांव, माँ गंगा गोशाला ग्राम धर्मांव, श्रीचंद गोशाला ग्राम निहालवाड़ी, नर्मदा गोशाला ग्राम खण्डा, श्रीकृष्ण गोपाल गोशाला ग्राम घाटखेड़ी और श्रीरस सिंगाजी गोशाला पीपलदोड खास झ में सोलर प्लांट

लगाने की कार्ययोजना के बारे में पूछा। उन्होंने स्पष्ट किया कि यदि योजना है, तो इन प्लांटों की स्थापना कब तक होगी?

प्रश्न क्रमांक 1398 में विधायक छाया मोरे ने नगरीय विकास एवं आवास विभाग से यह सवाल उठाया कि पंचायत विधानसभा अंतर्गत इंदौरहाइलपुर हाइवे पर स्थित ग्राम पंचायत छेमांव माखन को बढ़ती जनसंख्या और विकास की आवश्यकता को देखते हुए नगर पंचायत में कब तक परिवर्तित किया जाएगा? साथ ही उन्होंने यह भी जानकारी मांगी कि मध्य प्रदेश में किसी क्षेत्र को नगर पंचायत घोषित करने के लिए क्या तय गति और नियम हैं? समाजसेवी व प्रवक्ता सुनील जैन ने बताया कि 'चल रही विधानसभा के अंतर्गत विधायक छाया मोरे ने प्रश्न क्रमांक 628 में उन्होंने विधि एवं विधायी कार्य विभाग से खर्चों से संबंधित एक नंबर और लम्बे समय से चली आ रही मांग को उठाया।

उन्होंने कहा कि वर्तमान में खंडवा जिला न्यायालय जबलपुर हाईकोर्ट के क्षेत्राधिकार में

आता है, जिसकी दूरी खंडवा से 477 किलोमीटर है, जबकि इंदौर खंडपीठ की दूरी मात्र 130 किलोमीटर है। इस वजह से पक्षकारों को कानूनी प्रक्रिया में बहुत कठिनाइयों का सामना करना पड़ता है। उन्होंने पूछा कि क्या खंडवा जिला न्यायालय को इंदौर हाईकोर्ट खंडपीठ से जोड़ने की कोई कार्ययोजना है? यदि हाँ, तो वह प्रक्रिया कब तक पूरी की जाएगी? इस मांग पर सदन में संसदीय कार्यमंत्री कैलाश विजयवर्गीय ने भी समर्थन दिया, वहीं पूर्व मुख्यमंत्री कमलनाथ ने भी इस बात का समर्थन किया। मुख्यमंत्री मोहन वाघव ने विधायक छाया मोरे की बात को गंभीरता से लेते हुए उचित निर्णय का आश्वासन दिया। विधानसभा में पूछे गए इन प्रश्नों से स्पष्ट है कि विधायक छाया मोरे अपने विधानसभा क्षेत्र की बुनियादी जरूरतों, किसानों और पशुपालकों की समस्याओं, नगरीय विकास और न्याय व्यवस्था को सुविधा बढ़ाने के मुद्दों को लेकर गंभीर हैं और इन पर ठोस कार्यवाही को अपेक्षा सरकार से कर रही हैं।

Mumbai: Adani Power on Friday said its board will consider a stock split on Friday. The company will also declare its June quarter results on the same day.

2025 will later also consider the proposal for alteration in the share capital of the company by way of sub-division/split of the existing equity shares of the face value ₹10 each, fully paid-up, in such a manner as may be determined

by the board." Adani Power said in a stock exchange filing. This would be subject to approval of the company's shareholders and any regulatory or statutory approvals as may be required, it added.

Shares of Adani Power closed 1.86% up at ₹657.45 ahead on the BSE on Tuesday. The company announced the stock split proposal during market hours.

EV, Consumer Durables, Retail Sectors to See Highest Salary Increment, says Report

Bengaluru: Employers in key industries are planning measured compensation increases, with salary increments projected to range between 6.2% and 12.3% across industries, according to the TeamLease Services' Jobs and Salaries Primer FY26. Some city and role-level salary increments may go up to 13.8%.

The report is based on data from 1,288 businesses in 23 industries and 30 cities, providing an outlook on how pay structures are evolving in a workforce shaped by sectoral transformation, skill-based hiring and macroeconomic shifts.

According to the report, the highest salary increments are expected in sectors such as electric vehicle (EV) and EV infrastructure (13.3%), consumer durables (10.7%), retail (10.7%) and non-banking finance companies or NBFCs (10.4%). Employers in these industries are placing greater value on roles that blend technical expertise, customer interaction, and adaptability to change. Top roles in industries with the highest salary increments are electrical design engineer (12.4%) in EV and EV infrastructure, in-store demonstrator (12.2%) in consumer durables, relationship executive (10.6%) in NBFCs and fashion assistant (11.2%) in retail.

This shift is driving compensation increases, particularly in Pune (10.4%), Mumbai (10.2%), Hyderabad (10.1%), Bengaluru (10.1%) and Chennai (10.1%). A few of the roles

within cities are expected to show exceptional salary increments—quality control inspectors in Pune (13.8%), MIS executives in Hyderabad (13.4%), data engineers in Bengaluru (12.9%), electrical design engineers in Mumbai (12.6%), sales executives in Gurugram (12.4%). Across functional areas, sales and marketing roles are projected to see the highest average salary increment at 9.9%, followed closely by engineering (9.5%). Other core functions, such as finance, customer service and back-office, blue collar,

and HR and administration, are expected to receive moderate hikes of between 8.2% and 9%, indicating a balanced growth trend across business-critical areas.

Role-specific data reveals that job profiles requiring a combination of technical knowledge and execution capability are seeing the highest salary hikes. Electrical design engineers are likely to see an increase of 12.4%, followed by in-store demonstrators at 12.2%, mechanical design engineers at 12.1%, and field sales executives at 11.9%. Additionally, positions such as MIS executives and IT support executives continue to experience steady growth, re-

flecting consistent demand across both frontline and back-end operations.

"While showcasing a year of steady salary growth, the report also highlights the ongoing structural evolution in India's job economy. The projected salary growth, ranging from 6.2% to 13.8%, signals a broader realignment in India's job and wage landscape. As new-age industries scale rapidly, demand is shifting toward roles that combine technical capability with immediate business impact," said Kartik Narayan, CEO, Staffing, TeamLease Services.

"What's equally telling is the upward momentum in blue collar wages, where even traditionally stable roles like mechanic and material handler are seeing double-digit hikes. We see this shift as a critical signal for employers to align hiring with new growth engines, and for job seekers to upskill toward relevance and resilience," he added.

The report points to a strong blue-collar rebound. Traditionally stable wage trends, this segment is now experiencing healthy increments, driven by rising infrastructure investments, the expanding EV ecosystem and ongoing revival in real estate and manufacturing. "The fastest-growing blue-collar roles are mechanic (10.4%), material handler (10.0%), machine operator (9.9%) and electrician (9.3%). With increasing competition among skilled operational workers, employers are reshaping their workforce strategies by focusing more on skill certification, retention and incentive-led engagement.

China's Coal Pipeline Risks Creating Glut

China's proposed coal mine development risks creating an oversupply and derailing climate goals, according to Global Energy Monitor. More than 400 sites are in development across China, with nearly 40% under construction or in test operation,

according to the California-based researcher, which promotes clean energy use. If they are all built, their combined capacity of 1.36 billion tons a year would surpass that operating in Indonesia and Australia, the top two exporters of the fuel for power generation and steelmaking.

The scale of China's coal ambitions threatens to overwhelm its own, and global, climate goals. The country accounts for 60% of all proposed mine capacity worldwide, and its buildout alone would generate 40% of the methane emissions tied to plan and projects, GEM said. Methane is more than 80 times more potent than carbon dioxide over a 20-year period.

"Without drastically scaling back plans for new mine capacity, the world could see a massive rise in potent methane emissions that would make it all but impossible to reach the goals of the Paris Agreement," said Dorothy Met, project manager of the Global Coal Mine Tracker at GEM. China's current buildout risks another round of overcapacity similar to that from 2012 to 2015, which triggered price crashes and stranded assets, according to the report.
