2. The Ministry of Corporate Affairs (“MCA”) and SEBI vide their Circulars have permitted holding of the AGM through Video Conferencing (“VC”) / Other Audio Visual Means (“OAVM”), without the physical presence of the Members. Accordingly, in compliance with the provisions of the Act, SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (“SEBI Listing Regulations”) and MCA Circulars, the 29th AGM of the Company is being held through VC / OAVM.
3. Since the 29th AGM is being held pursuant to the MCA Circulars through VC / OAVM, physical attendance of Members is dispensed with. Accordingly, the facility for appointment of proxies by the Members is not available for this AGM and hence the Attendance Slip, Proxy Form and Route Map are not annexed to this Notice.
4. 20. PROCEDURE FOR REMOTE E-VOTING

21. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (as amended) and Regulation 44 of SEBI Listing Regulations (as amended), the Company is pleased to provide its Members with a facility to exercise their right to vote by electronic means for the business to be transacted at the AGM as detailed below:

- i. The remote e-voting period will commence at 9.00 A.M. (IST) on Saturday, August 15, 2026 and ends at 5.00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 18, 2026. During this period, Members of the Company, holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialized form, as on the cut-off date i.e. Wednesday, August 12, 2026 may cast their vote by remote e-voting. Once the vote on a resolution is cast by a Member, it shall not be allowed to be changed subsequently.
- ii. In addition to the facility for voting through electronic voting system, Members attending the AGM who have not cast their vote by remote e-voting shall be eligible to cast their vote through e-voting during the AGM.
- iii. Members who have cast their vote through remote e-voting for the 29th AGM shall also be eligible to attend the AGM but they shall not be eligible to cast their vote again at the meeting.
