- The Financial results of the company have been prepared in accordance with Indian Accounting Standards (Ind AS) as notified by Ministry of Corporate Affairs Pursuant to section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 and in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations 2015.
- The figures of the quarter ended March 31, 2026 & quarter ended March 31, 2025 are the balancing figure between the audited figures for the full financial years ended March 31, 2026 and March 31, 2025 and the unaudited figures for the nine months ended December 31, 2025 & December 31, 2024 respectively.
- The above audited financial results for the year ended March 31, 2026 have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors of the Company at their meeting held on April 20, 2026. The Statutory Auditors have expressed an unmodified audit opinion on these financial results.
- The Company entered into an assets purchase agreement dated August 28, 2025 with Jarvis Labs AI Private Limited for the acquisition of identified assets, the conditions as envisaged in agreement has been satisfied on December 16, 2025 accordingly the Company has accounted the transactions in accordance with the relevant Indian accounting standard as on business acquisition date.
- The Company raised INR10,700 Lakhs in equity share capital through a Qualified Institutional Buyers ("QIB") via Qualified Institutional Placement ("QIP") of 4,28,000 equity shares, face value of INR10 each and at a premium of INR 2,490 per share. This issue was approved by the Board on September 29, 2025, followed by members' approval on October 30, 2025. These shares were allotted on February 26, 2026. This issue was made in accordance with the SEBI (ICDR) Regulations, 2018 as amended. Pursuant to this, the paid-up equity share capital has been increased from INR 2,012.69 Lakhs to INR 2,055.50 Lakhs.
- The Board of Directors has approved the sub-division (split) of equity shares of the Company from face value of INR 10 each to INR 1 each in the ratio of 1:10, subject to the approval of the shareholders and other applicable regulatory/statutory approvals.
- The requirement of Ind AS- 108 "Operating Segments" is not applicable to the company as it is engaged in single business segment.
- Basic & Diluted earning/(loss) per share is not annualised for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2026 & December 31, 2025 and for quarter ended March 31, 2025.
- The figures of the previous periods have been regrouped, wherever necessary, to correspond with the current period.
- The Company confirms that it does not have any subsidiary, associate, or joint venture company as of March 31, 2026.

Report on the Audit of Financial Results

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying Statement of Financial Results of E2E Networks Limited ("the Company") for the quarter ended 31st March, 2026 and year to date results for the period from 1st April, 2025 to 31st March, 2026 ("the statement") attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirement) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("the Listing Regulations").

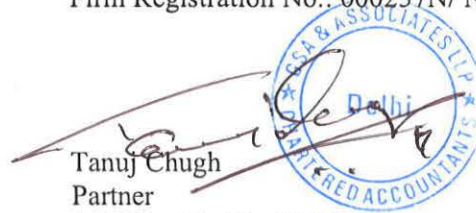

The loss reported for the full year is mainly due to high depreciation on the ₹1,185+ crore investment in GPUs. However, the core business is generating strong cash flows."
