“Unfortunate and irresponsible”: SC on unproven media theories over Air India Ahmedabad crash

NEW DELHI : The Supreme Court on Monday took a dim view of the various baseless theories being floated in the media over what went wrong with the Gatwick-bound Air India flight that crashed near the Ahmedabad airport on June 12, killing 260 people.

A bench of Justices Surya Kant and N Kotiswar Singh termed such misrepresentation of the tragic accident as an "unfortunate and irresponsible kind of behaviour" and expressed concern over the premature conclusions being drawn in the public domain.

The Court was hearing a plea filed by Safety Matters Foundation, an NGO focused on aviation safety, which has sought a transparent, fair, independent, and expeditious inquiry into the crash. Appearing on behalf of the petitioner, Advocate Prashant Bhushan flagged serious concerns over the inadequacy of the preliminary investigation



conducted so far.

Bhushan argued that more than 100 days after the crash, the public remains in the dark about what went wrong, putting passengers of

similar aircraft models at risk. He expressed particular concern about the composition of the current five-member investigation team—three of whom are from the

Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA), the very body whose own role in ensuring airworthiness may come under scrutiny. He questioned the credi-

bility of such an internal investigation and cited Rule 12, which allows for a judicial inquiry in the event of such accidents. "How can officers investigate their own possible negligence?" he asked.

The bench acknowledged the call for transparency but cautioned against selective leaks or premature public disclosure of technical details, asking, "Why are they asking so many things to come in public domain?"

The Court noted that confidentiality must be preserved until the investigation is complete to avoid misinformation and misinterpretation. Bhushan, however, stressed that there was "no object of privacy" here, since the identities of the pilots, passengers, and staff are already publicly known. He said that the absence of a comprehensive report was fuelling speculation. Referring to an independent podcast titled Airline Matters, Bhushan said that several aviation professionals

had pointed to a possible electrical system failure as the cause of the crash.

He also raised concern about a line in the report where one pilot allegedly asked the other, "Why did you cut off fuel?" and the other responded, "I didn't." Bhushan argued that this ambiguous sentence was being interpreted in the media as pilot error, unfairly shifting blame without technical backing.

Considering the submissions, the Court opined that maintaining confidentiality during the investigation is essential, but also clarified that the conclusions must eventually be brought into the public domain. The Court has issued notice to the Union Ministry of Civil Aviation and the DGCA, to the limited extent of the plea seeking to ensure that an independent, fair and expeditious probe into the crash. Centre extends ban on National Socialist Council of Nagaland (K) for 5 more years under UAPA



NEW DELHI : Union Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) on Monday extended the ban on the National Socialist Council of Nagaland (Khaplang) [NSCN (K)] and all its factions, wings and front organisations for the next five

years. The extension of the ban was implemented with immediate effect for a period of five years starting September 28, 2025, under the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 (UAPA), says an MHA notifi-

cation, pointing out the outfit's declaration as an "unlawful association".

The decision comes in view of the outfit's continued involvement in violent, anti-national and criminal activities.

As per the notification, NSCN (K) has openly declared its aim to establish a sovereign Nagaland by carving out Naga-inhabited areas of India and Myanmar through secession from the Union of India. The group has been accused of aligning itself with other banned outfits such as ULFA(I), PREPAK and PLA, and of engaging in kidnapping, extortion, and procurement of arms with the help of anti-India forces abroad.

During the period between September 28, 2020 and April 30, 2025, security forces and police actions against the group resulted in the killing of 13 of its cadres, mentions the notification.

Authorities registered 71 criminal cases against the members of NSCN (K), filed 56 charge sheets, and prosecuted 35 cadres. Additionally, 85 cadres were arrested, 69 surrendered, and 51 other criminal incidents were linked to the outfit.

Large quantities of arms and explosives were also recovered, including 69 weapons, 52 magazines, 931 live rounds, 10 grenades, 150 detonators, and over two kilograms of explosive materials. The state governments of Nagaland, Manipur and Arunachal Pradesh had.

Delhi riots case: SC notice to Delhi police on pleas of Sharjeel Imam, Umar Khalid seeking bail



NEW DELHI : The Supreme Court on Monday issued notice to the Delhi police on pleas of Sharjeel Imam, Umar Khalid, Gulfisha Fatima, Meeran Haider and Shifa Ur Rehman challenging the Delhi High Court order, which denied them bail in the UAPA case linked to the alleged larger conspiracy behind the 2020 north-east Delhi riots.

A bench of Justices Aravind Kumar and NV Anjaria posted the matter for hearing on October 27.

Senior advocate Abhishek Manu Singhvi said they are students and have been in jail

for over five years. "Yes we will hear you and dispose it of... issue notice in all," the bench ordered.

The Delhi High Court on September 2 denied bail to Imam, Khalid and seven others - Mohd Saleem Khan, Shifa Ur Rehman, Athar Khan, Meeran Haider, Shadab Ahmed, Abdul Khalid Saifi and Gulfisha Fatima.

On September 2, the bail plea of another accused Tasleem Ahmed was rejected by a different High Court bench.

Delhi Police had opposed their bail pleas, saying it was not a case of spontaneous

riots but a case where riots were "planned well in advance" with a "sinister motive and well-thought-out conspiracy".

The High Court had observed that prima facie, the role of Imam and Khalid in the entire conspiracy was "grave", having delivered inflammatory speeches on communal lines to "instigate mass mobilisation of members of the Muslim community."

They sought bail from the apex court in the larger conspiracy case under the stringent provisions of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act (UAPA) in the Delhi riots case in February 2020.

In 2020, the Delhi police arrested Imam under the UAPA and named him the main conspirator behind the Delhi riots case.

The violence had erupted during the protests against the then-proposed Citizenship Amendment Act (CAA) and National Register of Citizens (NRC) and had left 53 people dead and over 700 injured.

Rahul Gandhi urges PM Modi to immediately announce comprehensive flood relief package for Punjab

NEW DELHI : Congress leader Rahul Gandhi on Monday again urged Prime Minister Narendra Modi to immediately announce a comprehensive relief package for Punjab following devastation caused by floods in the state. The Congress leader, who had written a letter to PM Modi earlier, said Punjab has suffered losses of "nearly Rs 20,000 crore" due to the floods, and the initial relief package of Rs 1600 crore announced by PM Modi is an "injustice" to the people of Punjab. "Lakhs of homes have been uprooted, crops over more than 4 lakh acres have been ruined, and a large number of animals have been swept away. Yet the people of Punjab have shown remarkable courage and spirit. I am fully confident that they will once again help Punjab regain its momentum—they just need support and strength. I urge the Prime

Minister once again to immediately announce a comprehensive relief package," Rahul Gandhi said in a post on X. Rahul Gandhi had, on September 16, written a letter to Prime Minister Narendra Modi seeking a comprehensive relief package for Punjab, stating that the state has suffered an estimated loss of at least Rs 20,000 crore due to floods and Rs 1,600 crore initial relief announced by the union government "does grave injustice" to the people of the state. Recalling his visit to the state, Rahul Gandhi, who is Leader of Opposition in Lok Sabha, said he witnessed shocking devastation and its human cost. He said over four lakh acres of paddy crop have destroyed, and over 10 lakh animals have perished. The Congress leader said that in this hour of need of Punjab, the Centre and people of the country must reassure every .

Gujarat: Amit Shah unveils statues of RDC Bank Ex-Chairmen

RAJKOT : Union Home Minister Amit Shah asserted that the Centre has provided whatever assistance is required for the Ministry of Cooperation. He urged the farmers to move towards organic farming.

He unveiled statues of Shri Rajkot District Co-Operative Bank Ltd. (RDC) Bank Ex-Chairman Vallabbhai Patel and Vitthalbhai Radadiya at Vitthalbhai Radadiya District Bank Building, Rajkot, on Monday.

Amit Shah said, "Until now, no government had considered the cooperative sector, but in 2021, Prime Minister Narendra Modi established a separate Ministry of Cooperation for the first time. PM Modi congratulates Ujjwala beneficiaries after Centre approves release of 25 lakh additional LPG connections under PMUY scheme

NEW DELHI : Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Monday extended greetings to women beneficiaries after the Centre approved the release of 25 lakh additional LPG connections under the Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) during the Financial Year 2025-26, a press release from the Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas said. "On the auspicious occasion of Navratri, I extend my best wishes to all mothers and sisters joining the Ujjwala family. This step not only brings them joy during this sacred festival but also strengthens our resolve towards women's empowerment," PM Modi wrote on 'X'.

Union Minister for Petroleum and Natural Gas, Hardeep Singh Puri, on Monday announced that the Centre will distribute 25 lakh free LPG connections under the Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) on the occasion of Navratri.

Sharing an X post, the Union Minister said that this will take the total number of LPG connections to 10.60 crore. "Expansion of Ujjwala Families. A Great Gift to Women's Power! With the auspicious beginning of Navratri, the gift of 25 lakhs new free PM Ujjwala connections is yet another proof that PM Narendra Modi ji honours women just like Goddess Durga ji. This decision further strengthens our resolve for the respect and empowerment of mothers and sisters," Hardeep Puri wrote. The Minister informed that the government will spend Rs 2050 on each of the 25 lakh new LPG connections. He added, "Now, the number of Ujjwala family members will increase to 10.60 crore. The Government of India will spend Rs 2,050 on each connection, so that beneficiaries can get free LPG cylinders along with gas stoves, regulators, etc., for free." Lauding the Prime Minister for the scheme, he said that the idea of 'Shakti' is reflected in his decisions. "The power of the Devi Maa is present in the form of women on Earth. In Indian culture, too, women are considered the embodiment of 'Shakti'. During Navratri, we worship the nine forms of Maa Durga, which symbolise women's power. The same spirit is clearly reflected in Modi ji's intentions and schemes," he wrote. Referring to the Union Cabinet's decision last month, Hardeep Puri noted that the Centre is providing a Rs 300 subsidy for over 10.33 crore cylinders, which can be refilled for Rs 553. The Union Minister hailed the scheme and called it a "torch of a massive revolution". Puri wrote, "The Ujjwala scheme, emerging as one of the most impactful social welfare programs in India, is a living example of respect and empowerment for women. The Delhi High Court on September 2 denied bail to Imam, Khalid and seven others - Mohd Saleem Khan, Shifa Ur Rehman, Athar Khan, Meeran Haider, Shadab Ahmed, Abdul Khalid Saifi and Gulfisha Fatima.

On September 2, the bail plea of another accused Tasleem Ahmed was rejected by a different High Court bench.

Delhi Police had opposed their bail pleas, saying it was not a case of spontaneous

riots but a case where riots were "planned well in advance" with a "sinister motive and well-thought-out conspiracy".

The High Court had observed that prima facie, the role of Imam and Khalid in the entire conspiracy was "grave", having delivered inflammatory speeches on communal lines to "instigate mass mobilisation of members of the Muslim community."

They sought bail from the apex court in the larger conspiracy case under the stringent provisions of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act (UAPA) in the Delhi riots case in February 2020.

In 2020, the Delhi police arrested Imam under the UAPA and named him the main conspirator behind the Delhi riots case.

The violence had erupted during the protests against the then-proposed Citizenship Amendment Act (CAA) and National Register of Citizens (NRC) and had left 53 people dead and over 700 injured.

Rahul Gandhi urges PM Modi to immediately announce comprehensive flood relief package for Punjab

NEW DELHI : Congress leader Rahul Gandhi on Monday again urged Prime Minister Narendra Modi to immediately announce a comprehensive relief package for Punjab following devastation caused by floods in the state. The Congress leader, who had written a letter to PM Modi earlier, said Punjab has suffered losses of "nearly Rs 20,000 crore" due to the floods, and the initial relief package of Rs 1600 crore announced by PM Modi is an "injustice" to the people of Punjab.

"Lakhs of homes have been uprooted, crops over more than 4 lakh acres have been ruined, and a large number of animals have been swept away. Yet the people of Punjab have shown remarkable courage and spirit. I am fully confident that they will once again help Punjab regain its momentum—they just need support and strength. I urge the Prime

Minister once again to immediately announce a comprehensive relief package," Rahul Gandhi said in a post on X. Rahul Gandhi had, on September 16, written a letter to Prime Minister Narendra Modi seeking a comprehensive relief package for Punjab, stating that the state has suffered an estimated loss of at least Rs 20,000 crore due to floods and Rs 1,600 crore initial relief announced by the union government "does grave injustice" to the people of the state. Recalling his visit to the state, Rahul Gandhi, who is Leader of Opposition in Lok Sabha, said he witnessed shocking devastation and its human cost. He said over four lakh acres of paddy crop have destroyed, and over 10 lakh animals have perished. The Congress leader said that in this hour of need of Punjab, the Centre and people of the country must reassure every .

Gujarat: Amit Shah unveils statues of RDC Bank Ex-Chairmen

RAJKOT : Union Home Minister Amit Shah asserted that the Centre has provided whatever assistance is required for the Ministry of Cooperation. He urged the farmers to move towards organic farming.
