# Tech should not enslave students: PM

New Delhi, 9 February

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Monday advised students not to let technology enslave them, saying artificial intelligence should be used for guidance and value addition, not as a substitute for learning.

In the second episode of the ninth edition of the prime minister's annual Pariksha Pe Charcha event, he noted that mobile phones have become masters of some children, who cannot even eat without them or without a television screen.

"Every era has faced concerns with new technologies, whether computers or mobile phones. But the fear is unnecessary. Technology must not become the master of human life. You have to make a firm resolve that you will not let technology enslave you," Modi said in an interaction with students from Coimbatore, Raipur, Guwahati and Gujarat. The prime minister urged students not to be afraid of emerging technologies such as Artificial

Intelligence (AI), but use them to hone their skills.

"We should try not to make AI or mobile the master; some kids do not eat food unless they watch something on a smartphone. We can use AI efficiently. AI should be used for

guidance and value addition, not as a substitute for learning."

"The nature of jobs will always evolve, just as transport shifted from bullock carts to aeroplanes, but life continues," Modi said and highlighted that understanding

technology, expanding one's own capabilities, and integrating its strengths into work ensures progress without fear.

The prime minister also urged students to practise previous years' question papers and get a good night's sleep to perform better at examinations. "You will never feel tense after preparing well for exams. A good night's sleep will keep you cheerful for the rest of the day," Modi said.

He also advised parents not to compare their wards with others.

When asked what qualities he expects from the future generation of leaders, the prime minister remarked that the first quality is to be fearless. Leadership begins when one decides to act without waiting for others, Modi said and cited the example of picking up litter, thereby inspiring others to do the same.

"Leadership is not about elections or speeches but about the ability to explain and convince others," he said, adding that true leaders first understand people before guiding them.

"To become a leader, develop a mindset to take initiative. A key leadership quality is the ability to communicate your thoughts clearly and effectively to at least 10 people," the prime minister said.

On career choices, he said that constantly changing aspirations confuses families, but it is natural to feel inspired by successful people.

He stressed that one should not only look at their achievements but also at the effort and discipline behind the success. "True success makes its own noise, and when one becomes number one, the whole school, village, and community will recognise it," addressing another student's concern about balancing studies and passion, Modi noted that both are useful and can complement each other.

He illustrated with an example of the experiments, saying creativity can help in learning and reduce fatigue, recommending dedicating daily or weekly time to personal interests while ensuring that education remains a priority.

All-rounder Michael Leask starred with a late cameo and a four-wicket haul after opener George Munsey's attacking fly as Scotland thrashed debutants Italy by 73 runs in their T20 World Cup Group C match here on Monday. The left-hander Munsey, who survived a reprieve on 41, dominated the bowling with a fluent 84 off 55 balls (4x4, 2x6) before Leask gave the final flourish in a 22 out from last five balls, smacking Thomas Draca for two sixes and two fours at the Eden Gardens. After his quickfire cameo, the off-spinner took a wicket off the first ball of the innings and returned figures of 4/17. Italy folded for 134 for nine in 16.4 overs as captain Wayne Madsen did not bat after suffering a shoulder injury earlier in the game. PH

## No fees needed for registration of AI Impact Summit 2026

The India AI Mission has cautioned all stakeholders and participants of the AI Impact Summit about fraudulent activities, ahead of the meet.

It has clarified that there is no fee for registration, participation or speaking during the five-day event scheduled to start in New Delhi on February 16.

"This is an official alert issued by the India AI Impact Summit 2026 team

for all participants, stakeholders, and the general public regarding fraudulent activities being carried out in the name of the Summit. No fee is charged for registration, participation, or speaking. Any communication seeking money is fake and should be ignored and reported," the IndiaAI Mission said in a post on LinkedIn.

"The caution message was prompted after officials from the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) were alerted about cases in which interested speakers and participants had been asked to

pay a nominal fee to register for the India AI Summit.

"There have been a couple of cases in Bengaluru, where people have been asked to pay a fee for registration. There is no registration fee. We have asked the state government and law enforcement officials to look into this," a senior government official told Business Standard.

Some foreign delegates have also been asked to pay a nominal fee to "verify their documents" so that their registrations can be expedited, another official said.

During the five-day event, the government is expected to showcase the latest indigenous innovations to global stakeholders.

## SC limits micro-observers' role in Bengal SIR, extends scrutiny deadline

The Supreme Court on Monday underlined that the micro-observers deployed during the Special Intensive Review (SIR) process of the electoral rolls in West Bengal have no adjudicatory role, clarifying that only electoral registration officers (EROs) are empowered to pass final orders on claims and objections. The top court also allowed the Election Commission of India (ECI) to replace micro-observers with suitable Group B officers deputed by the State.

The court also extended the timeline for scrutiny of documents and objections by at least one week before February 14, the scheduled date for publication of the final electoral roll.

It also made it clear to the states that it will not allow anyone to create any impediment in completion of the SIR of electoral rolls and directed the director general of police of West Bengal to file an affidavit on the Election Commission's allegation of burning of its notices by miscreants.

- The unaudited Standalone and Consolidated financial results for the third quarter ended 31<sup>st</sup> December 2025 and year to date results for the period 01<sup>st</sup> April 2025 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2025 were reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors of the Company at their meetings held on Monday, 09<sup>th</sup> February 2026.
- The unaudited Standalone and Consolidated financial results for the third quarter ended 31<sup>st</sup> December 2025 and year to date results for the period 01<sup>st</sup> April 2025 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2025 presented were subjected to a "Limited Review" by the Statutory Auditors of the Company. An unmodified report was issued by them thereon.
- These unaudited Standalone and Consolidated financial results have been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standards (Ind AS) prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 (The Act) read with the relevant rules issued thereunder; other accounting policies generally accepted in India and in compliance with the presentation and disclosure requirements of Regulation 33 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulation, 2015 (as amended).
- The Group Company operates in a single reportable segment viz. retail and wholesale sales of consumer durables and electronics products through its retail stores and online platform. The Chief Operating Decision Maker ("CODM") reviews the results as a whole when making decisions about allocating resources and assessing the performance of the Group.
- Exceptional Item:
  - On 29<sup>th</sup> May 2025, a fire incident occurred at one of the Company's Godowns, resulting in significant damage to inventory valued at ₹ 81.72 million. The Company lodged an insurance claim for the full amount and recovered the loss as an exceptional item during the quarter ended 30<sup>th</sup> June 2025. In the previous quarter, the Company recovered full and final settlement for ₹ 75.27 million against the claim, which was recognized as an exceptional item in the Statement of Profit and Loss.
  - The Company, during the previous quarter, transferred its four "1C" retail stores located in the States of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh, along with the related trademarks and certain immovable assets, but excluding inventory, for a total consideration of ₹ 90 million. The gain on disposal of such assets of ₹ 76.65 million has been recognized as an exceptional item in the Statement of Profit and Loss.
- The Government of India has merged various existing labour laws into a unified framework comprising four labour codes, collectively referred to as the "New Labour Code". Accordingly, the Company has recognized a one-time impact of ₹ 42.83 million in compliance with Ind AS 19, relating to changes in employee benefit obligations, and has presented this amount as an exceptional item in the Statement of Profit and Loss for the third quarter and nine months ended 31<sup>st</sup> December 2025. The Government(s) in the process of notifying the corresponding rules under the New Labour Code, and any further impact will be accounted for in the period in which such rules are notified.
- From the first quarter ended 30<sup>th</sup> June 2025 onwards, the Company reclassified self-out scheme incentives and cash discounts received from suppliers from "Revenue from Operations - Other operating income" to "Revenue from Operations - Purchases of Stock in Trade" in the Standalone and Consolidated Statement of Profit and Loss in accordance with the applicable accounting standards, since such incentives and discounts are directly associated with inventory purchases and are not in exchange for any distinct goods or services by the Company to such suppliers. The consequent adjustments made to the comparative financial information are not considered material to these financial results.
- The EPES for quarter and year to date period are unaudited.

- The unaudited Standalone and Consolidated financial results for the third quarter ended 31<sup>st</sup> December 2025 and year-to-date results for the period 01<sup>st</sup> April 2025 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2025 were reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors of the Company at their meetings held on Monday, 09<sup>th</sup> February 2026.
- The unaudited Standalone and Consolidated financial results for the third quarter ended 31<sup>st</sup> December 2025 and year-to-date results for the period 01<sup>st</sup> April 2025 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2025 presented were subjected to a "Limited Review" by the Statutory Auditors of the Company. An unmodified opinion was issued by them thereon.
- These unaudited Standalone and Consolidated financial results have been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standards (Ind AS) prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 (the Act) read with the relevant rules issued thereunder, other accounting principles generally accepted in India and is in compliance with the presentation and disclosure requirements of Regulation 33 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (as amended).
- The Group Company operates in a single reportable segment viz retail and wholesale sales of consumer durables and electronics products through its retail stores and online platforms. The Chief Operating Decision Maker (CODM) reviews the results as a whole when making decisions about allocating resources and assessing the performance of the Group.
- Exceptional Item:
  - On 29<sup>th</sup> May 2025, a fire incident occurred at one of the Company's Godowns, resulting in significant damage to inventory valued at ₹81.72 million. The Company lodged an insurance claim for the full amount and recorded the loss as an exceptional item during the quarter ended 30<sup>th</sup> June 2025. In the previous quarter, the Company received full and final settlement for ₹5.21 million against the claim, which was recognized as an exceptional item in the Statement of Profit and Loss.
  - The Company, during the previous quarter, transferred its four "ICI" retail stores located in the States of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh, along with the related trademarks and certain immovable assets, but excluding inventory, for a total consideration of ₹80 million. The gain on disposal of such assets at ₹76.65 million has been recognized as an exceptional item in the Statement of Profit and Loss.
- The Government of India has merged various existing labour laws into a unified framework comprising four labour codes, collectively referred to as the "New Labour Code". Accordingly, the Company has recognized an one-time impact of ₹42.63 million in compliance with Ind AS 13, relating to changes in employee benefit obligations, and has presented this amount as an exceptional item in the Statement of Profit and Loss for the third quarter and nine months ended 31<sup>st</sup> December 2025. The Government's are in the process of notifying the corresponding standards under the New Labour Code, and any further impact will be accounted for in the period in which such rules are notified.
- From the first quarter ended 30<sup>th</sup> June 2025 onwards, the Company reclassified sell-out scheme incentives and cash discounts received from suppliers from the "Revenue from operations - Other operating income" to reduction from "Purchase of Stock in Trade" in the Standalone and Consolidated Statement of Profit and Loss in accordance with the applicable accounting standards, since such incentives and discounts are directly associated with inventory purchases and is not in exchange for any distinct goods or services by the Company to such suppliers. The consequent adjustments made to the comparative financial information are not considered material to these financial results.
- The EPES for quarters and year to date period are not annualized.
