Sub: Intimation under Regulation 30 of SEBI (Listing Obligation and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 regarding the fire accident that occurred during the intervening night of 28th and 29th May 2025 at the Electronics Mart India Limited's Godown located at Guntur, Andhra Pradesh

Dear Sir/Madam,

Under regulation 30 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, we wish to inform you that a fire accident took place at midnight, i.e., early hours of Thursday, 29th May 2025, at a Godown located at Commercial property bearing No. 211-240, Survey No. 175, 184, 185, Block No. 22H, Phase – IV, Auto Nagar, Guntur District, Andhra Pradesh – 522001.

The cause of the fire is currently under investigation. Although the fire has been controlled, operations at the affected godown have been disrupted. We are relieved to report that there have been no injuries or casualties. The godown is adequately insured, and the insurance provider has been duly notified of the incident. While the company is determining the exact extent of the loss, preliminary estimates suggest that the damage may be Rs. 6 to 7 crores. Any further developments related to this incident will be communicated in due course.

In compliance with Regulation 30 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, and under SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CFD-PoD-1/CIR/2023/123 dated 13th July 2023, we have enclosed the incident details as required in Annexure A.
