धान खरीद मामले में किसानों ने मंडी गेट पर जड़ा ताला

काशीपुर (नजरिया खबर ब्यूरो)। काशीपुर मंडी समिति में गुरुवार को धान की पीआर 126 व पीआर-131 वैरायटी की खरीद से इंकार किए जाने पर किसानों ने भारी विरोध जताते हुए मंडी गेट पर ताला जड़ दिया। किसानों ने आरोप लगाया कि मंडी समिति प्रशासन और राइस मिलर्स के दबाव में इन वैरायटी की खरीद रोक दी जा रही है। इस मुद्दे पर किसानों के समर्थन में भारतीय किसान यूनियन (भाकियू) भी खुलकर सामने आ गई है।

करीब एक घंटे तक चली किसानों और मंडी अधिकारियों के बीच वार्ता विफल रही। किसान नेताओं ने स्पष्ट कहा कि जब तक सरकार की ओर से लिखित आश्वासन नहीं दिया जाता, तब तक धरना समाप्त नहीं किया जाएगा। भाकियू के जिला प्रभारी जितेंद्र सिंह जीतू ने कहा कि पूरे



प्रदर्शन करते किसान।

जिले में सबसे अधिक खेती पीआर-131 वैरायटी की धान की हुई है। पिछले वर्ष इसकी पैदावार बेहतर रही, इसलिए इस बार अधिकांश किसानों ने यही बीज बोया। अब जब फसल तैयार है, तो खरीद से मना किया जा रहा है।

यह किसानों के साथ खुला अन्याय है। किसान नेता टीका सिंह ने कहा कि मंडी समिति प्रशासन किसानों की

मेहनत को नजरअंदाज कर रहा है। किसानों ने पूरी लागत लगाकर फसल तैयार की, लेकिन अब खरीद से इंकार कर देना सरकार की नीतियों पर सवाल खड़ा करता है। उन्होंने कहा कि सरकार यदि तुरंत समाधान नहीं करती, तो आंदोलन को और तेज किया जाएगा। किसानों को उनका हक दिलाने के लिए हर स्तर पर संघर्ष जारी रहेगा।
