**US, INDIA PROVIDE AID:** The US has provided humanitarian aid worth over \$3.6 million to affected people in Nepal, including emergency food support for up to 10,000 households, the US Embassy in Kathmandu said. Meanwhile, India has also provided 68.5 tonnes of relief materials and sent technical teams, forensic experts and equipment to assist in search operations, as per the Indian embassy.

## Briefs

### Ferry capsizes claims 8 lives

At least eight people died after a ferry carrying nearly 270 passengers and crew capsized off northern Cyprus on Sunday, Turkish media reported. Some 237 people were rescued and a search was on for 17, Northern Cyprus PM Unal Ustel said. The ferry encountered adverse weather and began taking in water 15 minutes after departure. The catamaran-style ferry was travelling from Kyrenia in Northern Cyprus to Tasucu in Turkey.

### One killed in rave shooting

A shooting at a rave in Switzerland's northern canton of Aargau left one person dead and five hurt on Sunday. A 22-year-old woman died at the scene, while four men and a woman, aged between 24 and 27, were injured. Police said they were searching for potentially more than one suspect. The motive remained unclear. Officials were alerted at 2.30 am to the shooting at a horse racing track in Aarau, where a rave was being held.

### UK woman stabbed to death at strn

A 31-year-old British woman was fatally stabbed at a train station in the southern German town of Rosenheim early on Sunday, police said. The woman was taken to hospital, where she died of her injuries. Police detained a 27-year-old German man shortly after the stabbing. The motive and circumstances are being probed.

### 3 bros perish in IED blast

Three brothers were killed and a relative injured when an improvised explosive device targeted their vehicle in Pak's Balochistan on Sunday. The victims were travelling to their agricultural land in a pick-up truck. Police said unidentified militants had planted the remote-controlled IED. No group claimed responsibility.

## Desi boy, 7, aces UK maths exam for 16-year-olds

**London:** A seven-year-old Indian-origin boy has aaced a mathematics examination nearly a decade earlier than most schoolchildren in the UK and is already preparing for the next level.

**Jiyyan Reddy Dhruba** scored 196 out of 240, securing Grade 8, equivalent to an A, across three papers in the General Certificate of Secondary Education (GCSE) examination, normally taken by 16-year-olds.

Jiyyan appeared for the Pearson Edexcel GCSE Higher Mathematics examination in May and received his results last week. "I felt really excited when I saw my result. My parents were very happy,



and they hugged me," Jiyyan said. "I wanted a Grade 9, so I was a little disappointed at first, but then I was very happy that I got Grade 8. I like maths because I like solving difficult problems and finding different ways to get the answer," he said.

Jiyyan now wants to study A-level Maths and Further Maths and hopes to invent robots and other technology to help people.

He attended a mainstream primary school in London until February, when his parents moved him to home education to allow him to learn at his own pace. His parents, originally from Andhra Pradesh, have lived in South Ruislip, west London, for nearly five years. —PTI

## FLASH FLOODS | Death toll rises to 16 as rescue teams race against time and search for hundreds of people unaccounted for after Nepal border 'tsunami'

# 49 INDIANS AMONG 546 STILL MISSING IN TIBET DISASTER

**Beijing:** The death toll from flash floods in Tibet near the Nepal border climbed to 16 on Sunday, with 546 people, including 49 Indians, still missing, Chinese officials said.

The massive flash floods struck the immigration port on the Gyirong-Nepal border on August 26, where hundreds were waiting to enter or exit Tibet.

In Nepal, the death toll has surged to 788, while nearly 2,500 people remain missing.

The disaster, believed to have been triggered by a collapse or avalanche of ice and rock near the border, left 546 people missing in Tibet.

They include 261 foreigners from 23 countries, among them 49 Indians.

A large number of Indian pilgrims were visiting Tibet for the Kailash Manasarovar Yatra after ties between China and India improved.

Some were reportedly at the immigration building on the Tibet-Nepal border when the flood struck Gyirong County.

The missing foreigners include 104 people from Nepal, 33 from Latvia, 18 from the US and 15 from the UK. People from Canada, Australia, South Africa, Malaysia, Germany, Russia and Ireland are also

missing, state-run Xinhua news agency reported.

Chinese authorities have notified the embassies and consulates concerned. Following searches and checks, no foreign tourists are currently stranded in Gyirong County, Xinhua said. —PTI

### Hospitals turn into search centres

Nepal hospitals have become centres of desperate searches as kin look for loved ones missing in the catastrophic disaster and forensic teams work to identify bodies recovered downstream.

Teaching Hospital, Kathmandu, families have gathered with photos, checking lists and waiting for information.

Dil Kumari Masrangi Magar put up photos of her missing brother-in-law and nephew at the hospital gate.

"There is nothing left to do but hope. Even if it's just their bodies, at least we'd know," she told Nepali Times.



### TEACHER SAVED 1,643 PUPILS

Nepal school principal's quick decision helped save 1,643 children in Nuwakot, The Times reported. **Rajendra Dawadi**, 47, principal and English teacher at Tribhuvan Trishuli Secondary School, received a warning around 9.20am that a nearby village had been swept away. When a parent arrived saying the water was rising rapidly, Dawadi rang the school bell and ordered teachers to evacuate the children. He told school bus drivers to turn back. The pupils rushed to higher ground and sheltered under a bodhi tree. Soon, floodwaters carrying mud, rocks, ice and debris destroyed the school. All 1,643 children survived, but two members of the staff, teacher Santos Pariyar, 32, and janitor Sultan Lama, died.



#### 3,500 IN RELIEF CAMPS

About 3,500 people displaced by the tragedy have been provided temporary accommodation in relief camps, schools and community buildings as shortages of drinking water, medicines and sanitation pose fresh challenges. Three relief camps have been set up in Rasuwa and 15 in Nuwakot, said a govt update. —PTI

## Xi in Kyrgyzstan for SCO Summit

**Beijing:** Chinese President Xi Jinping arrived in Kyrgyzstan on Sunday to attend the 26th Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) summit, which will also be attended by PM Narendra Modi and other leaders of member countries.

"I look forward to attending the SCO Bishkek Summit, working with all parties to revisit the 25-year development experience of the SCO, jointly discuss cooperation plans, create the future of the organisation," Xi said on arrival, state-run Xinhua news agency reported. The summit will be held from Aug 31 to Sept 1. Xi is also expected to hold bilateral meetings with



The SCO comprises China, India, Russia, Iran, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Pakistan, Tajikistan, Uzbekistan and Belarus. Xi is also widely expected to attend the Bric summit in New Delhi on Sept 12-13 and later travel to the US for a summit with President Donald Trump. —PTI

## Nasa launches Roman telescope to explore the hidden universe

**Cape Canaveral (US):** Nasa's newest space telescope blasted off on Sunday on a mission to hunt for planets around other stars, study dark energy and survey the cosmos.

SpaceX launched the \$4.3 billion Roman Space Telescope aboard a Falcon Heavy rocket from Kennedy Space Centre. The telescope is heading to an observation point 1.6 million kilometres away, also home to the Webb Space Telescope.

Named after Nancy Grace Roman, Nasa's first chief astronomer, the bus-sized telescope will take more than three months to reach its destination. "It's going to find thousands of supernovae, tens of

thousands of planets, billions of galaxies and tens of billions of stars," Nasa science mission director Nicky Fox said.

Roman's field of view is more than 100 times wider than that of Nasa's Hubble Space Telescope. Scientists expect it to help study dark matter and dark energy and determine how quickly the

universe is expanding.

The telescope also carries an experimental coronagraph designed to block starlight, allowing it to directly image faint planets orbiting stars.

Roman, launched nearly a year ahead of schedule and within budget, is Nasa's first space telescope named after a woman. —AP

## Unite against US, Israel: Mojtaba to Muslim nations

Iran's supreme leader calls on regional leaders to 'recognise real enemy', warns against divisions

**Tehran:** Iran's Supreme Leader **Mojtaba Khamenei** on Sunday urged Muslim countries to unite against the US and Israel, calling on regional rulers to "recognise your real enemy" and confront it, news agency AFP reported.

"The solution to the problems of the Islamic nations is unity of words, friendship, and cooperation on the path of goodness," Khamenei said in a written message as Shia Muslims marked the birthday of Prophet Mohammed.

He warned anyone creating divisions among Muslims, "knowingly or unknowingly, intentionally or unintentionally", was serving the interests of the "enemies of Islam". Mojtaba urged Iranian officials and citizens to put aside differences and maintain unity against Israel and the US. "Again, this servant's advice to the Iranian people is to not allow any differences to arise among themselves in any way," he said.

## US DEPORTS FAR-RIGHT BRITISH COMMENTATOR

**Washington:** British far-right commentator

**Milo Yiannopoulos** has been deported to the UK after US immigration authorities arrested him, Department of Homeland Security said on Saturday. Yiannopoulos, 41, was deported on Friday, a day after Immigration and Customs Enforcement arrested him at Louis Armstrong New Orleans International Airport.

DHS said Yiannopoulos had

legally entered the US in May 2019 but overstayed. He failed to appear for an immigration hearing and was issued a final removal order on July 22.

Yiannopoulos, a vocal supporter of Donald Trump during his 2016 presidential campaign, could not immediately be reached for comment.

Meanwhile, a California federal judge ruled the US govt was unconstitutionally silencing noncitizens critical of Israel's Gaza war through deportation threats. —Agencies

WHEREAS the service of summons could not be Affected in ordinary manner and whereas the Application for substituted service has been allowed by this Hon'ble Tribunal.

In accordance with Sub-Sec. (4) of Sec. 19 of the Act, you, the Defendants are directed as under :-

(1) To show cause within **30 (Thirty) days** of the service of summons as to why relief is prayed for should not be granted.

(2) To disclose particulars of properties or assets other than properties and assets specified by the applicant under Serial Number 3A of the original application.

(3) You are restrained from dealing with or disposing of secured assets of such other assets and properties disclosed under serial number 3A of the original application, pending hearing and disposal of the application for attachment of the properties.

(4) You shall not transfer by the way of sale, lease or otherwise, except in the ordinary course of his business any of the assets over which security interest is created and / or other assets and properties specified or disclosed under serial number 3A of the original application without the prior approval of the Tribunal.

(5) You shall be liable to account for the sale proceeds realised by the sale of secured assets or other assets and properties in the ordinary course of business and deposit such sale proceeds in the account maintained with the bank or financial institutions holding security interest over such assets.

You are directed to file the Written Statement with a copy thereof furnished to the applicant and to appear before DRT-II on **06.10.2026 at 11:00 A.M.** failing which the application shall be heard and decided in your absence.
