- The Unaudited financial results for the quarter ended June 30, 2026 have been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the Indian Accounting Standards 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" ("Ind AS 34") prescribed under section 133 of The Companies Act, 2013 and Regulation 33 of SEBI (Listing Obligation and Disclosure Requirement) Regulation 2015 (as amended) and circulars and notifications issued thereunder.
- Figures of previous reporting periods have been regrouped/reclassified wherever necessary to correspond with the figures of the current reporting period.
- These financial results have been extracted from the audited financial statements. Figures for the quarter ended March 31, 2026 represent the difference between the audited figures in respect of full financial years and the published figures for the nine months ended December 31, 2025.
- The Company's Operations fall under a single segment "Manufacturing and Trading of refractory ceramic products (Vitrified Tiles)". Hence, Segment reporting is not applicable as per Indian Accounting Standard (Ind AS) - 108 - Segment Reporting.
- The Government of India has consolidated 29 existing labour legislation into unified framework comprising four Labour Codes viz. Codes on wages 2019, Codes on Social Security 2020, Industrial Relation Code 2020, and Occupational Safety, Health and Working Condition Code 2020 (collectively referred to as the New Labour Codes). These Codes have been made effective from November 21, 2025. The corresponding draft rules under these codes have been issued by the Government.
The company continues to monitor the finalisation of Central/State Rules and clarifications from the Government on other aspects of the New Labour Codes and would provide appropriate accounting effect on the basis of such development as required.
