### Deep understanding of data true differentiator in chess: Anand



Five-time World Champion Viswanathan Anand on Thursday said that in an era where players are overwhelmed by data from computers, deep understanding has become the only true differentiator in modern chess. "Funnily enough, the more that is available for you to know, the less you can know. If every day you're subjected to 20 or 30 new conclusions, how do you make sense of it? I believe that the only thing that separates chess players today is deep understanding," Anand said at the inaugural event of a three-day chess workshop. Drawing a parallel to the times when he adapted to the computer many, many years ago, the Grandmaster insisted that while being open to new ideas helps, understanding the details pushes a player to a new level. Anand also clarified that chess mastery is rooted in pattern recognition rather than rote memorisation. Having played approximately 6,000 to 7,000 competitive games, he explained that the brain subconsciously connects patterns from games played by others.

### Over 1k athletes dropped from Khelo India: Mandaviya



Sports Minister Mansukh Mandaviya on Thursday revealed that 1342 athletes in various disciplines have been weeded out of the Khelo India programme in the last three years for not measuring up in performance and doping violations. In his reply to a question in Rajya Sabha seeking details of the performance of the athletes enrolled in the programme, the minister stated 2905 fresh names have been inducted into the flagship scheme during the same period. "A total of 1,342 athletes have exited the programme during the last three years due to performance below the prescribed benchmarks and involvement in doping violations," stated the reply from the minister. "Performance benchmarks are revised annually and are updated on the Khelo India website from time to time. Athlete performance is mapped and measured annually as per the prescribed protocols and in assessment camps," said the minister, and he added that over 23000 athletes are being trained and supported across the nation under the Khelo India programme. A Talent Identification and Development Committee (TIDC) of the ministry handles the induction and exit of athletes from the programme through an established protocol that includes performance assessment camps. Khelo India was launched in 2017 to identify and nurture sporting talent at the grassroots level, and double Olympic medalist Manu Bhaker is one of the most prominent beneficiaries of the scheme.

### CM Rekha to inaugurate 'Khelo Delhi-Delhi Khel Mahakumbh'

Highlighting the scale of participation, the Minister stated that more than 16,000 athletes have already registered, and the registration process is ongoing. ## Smith becomes PSL's costliest signing

Seasoned Australian batter Steve Smith fetched PKR 14 crore as a direct signing in the revamped 11th edition of the Pakistan Super League, making him the most expensive player in the league's history. Smith, who is on his way to replace the injured Mitchell Marsh in Australia's World T20 Cup squad, was bought by the new franchise Sialkot Stallions for approximately \$500,000.

The PSL has expanded to eight teams from six, with the Pakistan Cricket Board introducing a players' auction system for the first time, replacing the draft



format that had been in place for the last decade.

The auction held in Lahore on Wednesday saw some notable overseas players, including David Warner, Adam Zampa, Daryl Mitchell, Mark Chapman, Mustafizur Rahman, Devon Conway, Rilee Rossouw, Tabraiz Shamsi, Dasun Shanaka, Kusal Mendis and Marnus Labuschagne. A total of 103 players were signed by the eight franchises.

Fast bowler Naseem Shah emerged as the most expensive Pakistani signing after being bought by Islamabad United for PKR 8.65 crore. All-rounder Faheem Ashraf also joined the same franchise for PKR 8.5 crore. Babar Azam

was retained by Peshawar Zalmi for PKR 7 crore, while the most expensive retention was Saim Ayub, who was retained by the same franchise for PKR 12.2 crore.

The PSL is due to be held from March 26 to May 3 and will clash directly with the more lucrative and prominent Indian Premier League.

Two new franchises - Sialkot and Hyderabad - have been added after their rights were purchased by overseas Pakistani businessmen for PKR 185,000 crore and PKR 175,000 crore, respectively. Multan Sultans was also sold and rebranded as Rawalpindi after new owners acquired the franchise rights.

### Afghanistan players withdraw from PSL auction

The Afghanistan players withdrew their names from the first-ever players' auction held ahead of the 11th edition of the Pakistan Super League (PSL). A franchise owner confirmed initially that players like Mujeeb ur Rehman, Seddiqullah Atal, Muhammad Nabi, Waqar Salamkheil and Fazal Haq Farooqi had registered for the auction held in Lahore on Wednesday. But they withdrew their names following the backlash over the direct signing of



Afghanistan opener Rahmanullah Gurbaz by Peshawar Zalmi.

However, Salman Naseer, the CEO of the PSL, said there were some players from Afghanistan who were on the roll, but no franchise picked them. "There were a few Afghanistan players in the auction, but no franchise went for them," Naseer claimed. But Naseer said the strained relation between the two nations was reflected in the auction. "There was a severe backlash after Zalmi signed Gurbaz because of the fractured relations between Pakistan and Afghanistan, and after Gurbaz pulled himself out of the PSL," he said.

### Federer's induction ceremony sold out

The International Tennis Hall of Fame said on Wednesday that Roger Federer's induction ceremony sold out in two minutes - even after the Hall added thousands more tickets for an outdoor watch party.

"As a small but historic venue, our capacity is limited," the Hall posted on social media. The Hall said it anticipated the excitement about the first man to win 20 Grand Slam singles titles, who will be inducted in the Newport-based shrine on Aug. 29 along with broadcaster Mary Carillo. In addition to the 900 tickets originally available for the induction ceremony, the Hall will open its 3,600-seat stadium for a watch party.



Even so, the 4,500 tickets were gone within two minutes, Hall spokeswoman Megan Erbes said.

### Bayern reaches German Cup semifinals

Harry Kane scored again as Bayern Munich advanced to the semifinals of the German Cup for the first time in six years with a 2-0 win over RB Leipzig. Bayern outplayed Leipzig 6-0 and 5-1 in the Bundesliga this season but only got the breakthrough midway through the second half this time, with Kane and Luis Diaz scoring just three minutes apart.

Kane scored his sixth in the cup, coolly converting from the penalty spot by sending goalkeeper Maarten Vandevoordt the wrong way in the 64th. Diaz capitalised on a through pass by Michael Olise to double the advantage, beating



Vandevoordt one on one. Bayern is a 20-time cup champion but hasn't won the trophy since the 2019-20 season and has not been

back to the semis since then. Defending champion Stuttgart, Bayer Leverkusen and Freiburg have already advanced to the semifinals.

## Arsenal routs Leuven 4-0 in Women's Champions League

Defending champion Arsenal took a big step toward the Women's Champions League quarterfinals by routing OH Leuven 4-0 in the first leg of their knockout playoff round on Wednesday.

After the victory in the inaugural Women's Champions Cup on Feb 1, Arsenal dominated from the start in Belgium to close in on a quarterfinal meeting against London rival Chelsea. Frida Maanum led

the visitors with two goals, and Olivia Smith showed she was worth the record transfer fee Arsenal paid Liverpool for her in July.

Also, Kim Little came on as a substitute to play her 400th game for Arsenal. Maanum headed in the opener after meeting a cross by Caitlin Foord from the right in the 22nd minute. Smith doubled the advantage a quarter of an hour later with a clinical finish as the Canada forward found the far corner of the net with

a first-time low shot. Maanum was left unmarked in the box

to add her second, with Foord setting her up again early in

the second half before substitute Alessia Russo completed

the rout with her fifth of the campaign.
