Devraj decided to take revenge through extortion letter

Accused Devraj Singh recently had an altercation in which the younger man, Sandeep Singh, allegedly slapped him. Nursing the humiliation, Devraj decided to implicate Sandeep by writing the extortion letter using his name and address, believing that authorities would arrest the youth while he would escape unnoticed.

The incident dates back to Sept 2, when the letter reached Teonthar court via registered post. It carried the sender's name as Sandeep Singh with his full address. Alarmed, the court forwarded the matter to Sohagi police station.

Police said that during the investigation, the registry details were traced to the RMS post office in Prayagraj. The person whose name appeared on the letter told police he had no idea about it but mentioned that he had a recent dispute with Devraj Singh. When CCTV footage of the post office was examined, it clearly showed Devraj Singh mailing the letter on Aug 28. He was picked up & confronted with evidence, after which he confessed, police said.

The accused told investigators that he was not satisfied with the action taken against Sandeep Singh by local police. So, he decided to take revenge by implicating him in a serious crime through extortion letter. TNN

Usually Sept Sees Decline, But This Yr IMD Forecasts Heavy Rain

The monsoon arrived in the state on June 16. July and August typically account for the bulk of rainfall, while September usually sees a sharp decline. But this year, widespread showers are expected to continue into September due to multiple active weather systems.

A well-marked low-pressure area currently lies over northwest Madhya Pradesh and adjoining east Rajasthan, influencing the monsoon trough that extends through Jaisalmer, Sidhi, Daltonganj, Digha and up to the Bay of Bengal. In addition, an upper air cyclonic circulation is active over the northeast Arabian Sea and Gujarat coast.

The IMD has issued warnings of heavy rain, thunderstorms and lightning for nearly half the districts in the state in the coming days. TNN

85+ houses under water in Gwalior

Bhopal: An entire colony in Gwalior was swallowed by floodwaters on Thursday, forcing residents to flee as more than 85 houses in Lalipura near Sitholi went under 3-4 feet of water. After the locality was completely submerged, families abandoned their belongings and took shelter with relatives. The water rose so high that even ambulances could not enter the colony.

Collector Ruchika Chauhan later said all necessary measures were taken to meet the situation. Senior administrative officers were deployed, and food packets were distributed to the affected families. Officials added that many residents were not keen on moving to temporary camps. They said a survey is being carried out to sanction financial help. Officials cautioned that if rains continue, both bridges could be submerged. TNN

Two, including minor, held for gang-raping teen

Jabalpur: A 13-year-old girl was gang-raped by a 22-year-old and his minor nephew in Jabalpur district. The duo kidnapped and raped her in a jungle. While the 22-year-old accused was arrested, the minor was detained. They were produced before the court which sent the 22-year-old accused in the judicial remand and the minor was sent to a juvenile home on Friday.

Majhawan police station in-charge Hardayal Singh said that the survivor used to live with her mother at her grandmother's house. A 17-year-old boy, a resident of the village where in-laws of survivor's mother lived, used to talk with the girl over the phone. The boy also made the girl talk to his maternal uncle, Shivanshu, 22, a resident of Jabalpur. On Tuesday afternoon, both of them called the girl out of the village to talk. When the girl came out of the village, the uncle and nephew forcibly took her to the forest on a motorcycle, Singh said. TNN

Youth strangled to death over love affair, body dumped in forest

Jabalpur: A 19-year-old youth was strangled to death by his girlfriend's brother and four of his friends, who later dumped the decomposed body in a forest near Bijha village under Bargi police station limits. Police arrested one accused while hunt is on for others.

On Aug 20, villagers spotted a highly decomposed body in the forest, but police couldn't identify it due to its condition. However, a rakhi & kada on the wrist helped establish the identity of the deceased as Satyendra Ukey, a resident of Seoni district. He was missing since Aug 15 & a complaint was lodged at Ghansaur.

"Based on interrogation, it has been established that the youth was killed over his relationship. One accused has confessed, and efforts are on to nab remaining suspects," CSP Mishra told TOI. TNN

After probe, airline's tech team suspects a problem with oil filter

The flight, IX 1028, carrying 161 passengers, landed safely at 9:57 am, about 20 minutes later than its scheduled arrival. The pilots followed all standard operating procedures and landed the plane safely. The passengers were immediately deboarded and taken to terminal, where they collected their luggage.

"After receiving information about a technical fault in one of the engines of Air India Express plane coming from Delhi to Indore, we took all precautions and aircraft landed at Devi Ahilyabai Holkar Airport at 9:55 am. As per schedule, it was supposed to land at Indore airport at 9:35 am," the airport director VK Seth told TOI.

The airline canceled the flight's return journey to Delhi, offering passengers a refund. A technical team from the airline began an in-depth investigation into the aircraft's engine issue, which was suspected to be a problem with the oil filter. TNN
