'Threats to BLOs during SIR unacceptable'

New Delhi: Supreme Court on Tuesday asked all states to provide adequate security to booth-level officers engaged in special intensive revision, and warned that it would seriously view any instance of BLOs being threatened or impediments being placed in their work.

The observations were made by a bench of Chief Justice Surya Kant and Justice Joydalya Bagchi after senior advocate V Giri, appearing for NGO Sanatani Sangsad, demanded security for BLOs, alleging that they were being intimidated and threatened during voter enumeration work in West Bengal.

EC, through senior advocate Rakesh Dwivedi, said the commission had written a strong letter to WB govt on security of BLOs and assured the court that it had adequate powers under the Constitution to handle the situation. Dwivedi said such situations were arising because EC had no control over state police. The petitioner sought deployment of paramilitary forces in WB for safety and security of BLOs.

Giving a pan-India dimen-

sion to the issue raised in the petition, the bench said, "If EC had any grievance about non-cooperation from state officials or police regarding safety and security of BLOs, it should approach the SC. We will pass appropriate orders. It is not only about West Bengal but for all states. Non-cooperation with EC work is a serious issue. BLOs must get full security."

While seeking a response from the Centre and EC, the bench asked the poll panel to assess the situation in all states and move SC for appropriate directives, if needed. "We will take strong action to protect BLOs. Their safety and security must be ensured, otherwise there will be anarchy," the CJ-led bench said and referred to

its Dec-4 order directing states to allow BLOs who are stressed or face health issues to withdraw from SIR work and provide adequate replacements.

When Dwivedi and senior advocate Maninder Singh said problems were arising in Tamil Nadu, Kerala and West Bengal because their state govts had made public their opposition to SIR, the bench said BLOs unwilling to carry out SIR work would have to file an application before the district electoral officer, who would inform the state.

During the proceedings, Justice Bagchi questioned the material submitted by Sanatani Sangsad to allege intimidation of BLOs in West Bengal. "Apart from a solitary FIR,

there is no other credible evidence to substantiate the allegations. Based on a solitary incident, can it be said that it is done only in West Bengal and not in other states? Is it not a narrative from one side? Should police in all states be put under EC?" he asked.

EC said there had been certain incidents in West Bengal that saw electoral officers being gheraoed and threatened by the public. "A lot of narratives are being floated by political parties. At present, a BLO is to do enumeration of a maximum of 1,200 voters in 37 days, which is roughly 35 per day. Is it too much work?" the poll panel said.

Justice Bagchi said, "This is not a desk job where the quota of 35 is met easily. A BLO must go from house to house, verify enumeration forms and then upload it. There could be stress and physical strain. We want to ensure that SIR at ground level is done without a hitch."

EC said the narrative of BLOs being under stress was being spread by political parties. The CJ said that was why the court had directed states on Dec 4 to augment the workforce.

Explain exemption for Assam voters from providing citizenship proof, SC tells EC

New Delhi: Supreme Court on Tuesday asked Election Commission to respond to a PIL questioning its decision to exempt Assam voters from giving documentary proof along with enumeration forms during SIR — which was mandatory in other states — even though the northeastern state has a large population of illegal Bangladeshi migrants.

Appearing for petitioner Mrinal K Choudhury, senior advocate Vijay Hansaria told a bench of CJI Surya Kant and Justice Joydalya Bagchi that EC, in its Nov 17 notifica-

tion, had said Assam's electoral rolls were being revised without requirement of any documents or enumeration forms, contrary to the procedure adopted for the

pan-India special intensive revision of rolls.

The bench said it would seek EC's response on why such an exception was made for Assam and what the circumstances requiring such exemptions were. It asked the poll panel to file its response by Dec 16, the next date of hearing.

The petitioner said, "EC in an arbitrary manner directed that the electoral roll for Assam will be revised only by way of Special Revision and not by way of SIR even though there is no difference in the ground realities between Assam and 12 other states where SIR is being con-

ducted." On another PIL seeking interim inclusion of people from minority communities, who were persecuted in neighbouring countries and entered India under Citizenship (Amendment) Act, on the voters' list of West Bengal, the bench said the question of right to vote would arise only after they were accorded citizenship.

Senior advocate Karuna Nundy said the applications had been pending for a long time and if they were not decided expeditiously, these people, estimated to be 50,000, would lose out on voting in the Bengal assembly elections.

EC has no jurisdiction to engage in determination of citizenship of a voter as that is the task of govt or Foreigners Tribunal. All of them argued that according to Representation of the People Act, if a person has proof of residence and is over 18, and gives a self-declaration that he is a citizen of India, then EC has no power to inquire into citizenship and delete him from the voters' list.

On Tuesday, a bench of CJI Surya Kant and Justice Joydalya Bagchi responded, saying, "EC does not claim that it has the power to determine citizenship of a person or declare him as a foreigner. But, if it has doubts about the citizenship of a person registered as a voter or seeking inclusion of name as a voter, it can surely inquire into it."

"The first and foremost pre-condition for inclusion as a voter is that he/she must be a citizen of India. Given the constitutional and statutory powers conferred on EC, can it not undertake an inquisitorial exercise to find out who are doubtful citizens? That is included in the constitutional task of superintendence of elections," the bench said, in what marked an endorsement of EC's own stance on the issue.

Farasat argued when a statutory procedure was provided for determination of citizenship, EC had no jurisdiction to usurp that process. SC said, "To argue that a person required only proof of residence and age for inclusion in a voter list without proof of citizenship would be a misnomer. Proof of residence and age are statutory requirements. But citizenship is a constitutional requirement."

Trump's rice tariffs threat unlikely to have severe impact on exports

New Delhi: US President Donald Trump's latest threat to impose fresh tariffs on rice is unlikely to have a severe impact on Indian exports.

"India exported \$392 million worth of rice to the US in FY2025, just 3% of its global rice exports, and already faces tariffs of about 53% in the US market; 86% of these shipments are premium basmati. New duties would scarcely dent Indian exporters, who have strong markets elsewhere, and would make rice costlier for American households," said trade research body GTRI.

A bulk of the 6 million tonnes exported to the US may be headed to kitchens of Indian-origin Americans or those on visas. The only substitute for basmati rice can be from Pakistan but the quantities are much lower. Overall, a bulk of India's rice exports consists of non-basmati rice.

Trump's latest threat comes amid a team from the US visiting India with talks on the much-delayed trade deal scheduled for Wednesday and Thursday. While the agenda for the latest discussions were not immediately known, the visit was a surprise as govt officials had earlier said most issues had been sorted out and last-mile talks were expected. News about the US delegation's trip came ahead of Russian President Vladimir Putin's visit to India.

While Trump has taken unilateral measures on trade

since returning to office, India's rice exports are not seen as "dumping" as claimed by the US president, who is not seen as someone who always sticks to facts. Given volumes, neither are rice exports causing harm to domestic market, nor are they subsidised.

As a result, it is seen as a pressure tactic amid talks for a bilateral deal.

India and the US had launched negotiations for a trade deal in Feb and hoped to close talks by Sept-Oct. But with govt refusing to agree to Trump's demand for reducing levies on food and GM crops, the US hit back with 25% reciprocal tariffs and another 25% secondary tariffs, citing India's purchase of Russian oil and defence equipment. In the first phase, which govt is hoping can be clinched by the month-end, India expects the secondary tariffs to be lifted while also seeking concessions on reciprocal tariffs.

Trump, in the same event, also threatened high tariff on agriculture imports from Canada and other countries.

Tirupati: As if the laddu controversy and the Parakamani (donation theft) case were not enough, the trust running Tirumala temple has now alleged that it was duped of crores by a firm that sold silk dupattas to it over the past decade, reports Sandeep Raghavan. Instead of pure mulberry silk, VRS Export of Andhra Pradesh's Nagari allegedly sold 100% polyester dupattas to Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams (TTD) from 2015 to 2025.

The board has referred the "dupatta scam" to the state anti-corruption bureau, asking it to identify those behind the alleged fraud. A copy of the TTD board resolution is with TOI.

TTD presents silk dupattas to donors and other devotees during VIP darshans. VRS Export and its sister concerns supplied cloth worth nearly Rs 64.95 crore between 2015 and 2025.

The alleged scam unfolded when TTD directed its vigilance wing to examine whether the dupattas met tender specifications. The norms state that the dupattas must be woven entirely from pure mulberry silk using 20/22 denier yarn in both warp and weft, with a resultant minimum count of 31.5 denier. Each piece must display "Om Namo Venkatesaya" in Sanskrit on one side and in Telugu on the other.

"Based on the findings of the vigilance wing, it has become clear that the tenderer defrauded the temple trust by supplying cheaper polyester material," TTD chairman B R Naidu said.

Why documentary proof waiver during Assam SIR? SC seeks poll panel response

New Delhi: Supreme Court on Tuesday asked Election Commission to respond to a PIL questioning its decision to exempt Assam voters from giving documentary proof along with enumeration forms during SIR — which was mandatory in other states — even though the northeastern state has a large population of illegal Bangladeshi migrants.

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The bench said it would seek EC's response on why such an exception was made for Assam and what the circumstances requiring such exemptions were. It asked the poll panel to file its response by Dec 16, the next date of hearing.

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PETITION IN SC

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On another PIL, seeking interim inclusion of people from minority communities, who were persecuted in neighbouring countries and entered India under Citizenship (Amendment) Act, on the voters' list of West Bengal, the bench said the question of right to vote would arise only after they were accorded citizenship.

Kolkata vendors beaten, abused over chicken puffs near Gita recital venue

Kolkata: Two snack vendors in Kolkata alleged they were assaulted, had religious abuses hurled at them and their trays of chicken puffs thrown away by men objecting to sale of non-vegetarian food near a mass Gita recital at Maidan this

weekend, prompting police to register FIRs under non-bailable charges Tuesday, report Dwaipayan Ghosh & Sarthak Ganguly. Sheikh Riyajul, 50, alleged eight to nine men confronted him. "As soon as I said my name, they threw

away the puffs," he said in a video that went viral. "They hit me on my ears and shoulders. I had food worth Rs 3,000. They threw everything away." Vendor Mohammad Salaudinn, 60, said two to three men assaulted him.

Ahmedabad: Gujarat HC has quashed a decision by IIM-A to expel three PhD scholars due to their academic shortfall in their first year's performance.

Justice Nikhil Kariel held that the institute's decision was contrary to Manual of Practice and Procedure for the Doctoral Programme in Management (DPM), which allows a doctoral fellow to improve academic performance by granting one more

year if the student fails to meet the required academic standards.

Three first-year PhD fellows — Abhilasha Kumar, Atul Gupta, and Uthara PK — were asked on May 22 to explain why their candidature in the course's second year should not be withdrawn due to their failure to fulfil conditions for promotion. They were given 24 hours to provide an explanation. The executive committee passed an

order expelling them for academic shortfall, and their appeal was rejected by the IIM-A director without a hearing.

The students' counsels, Anand Yagnik and Biju Nair, submitted that the DPM Manual prescribes review, rectification and remedial measures for minor academic shortfalls, and those options should be considered before asking the students to leave. TNN

Citizenship is a constitutional requirement, says Apex Court

EC has no jurisdiction to engage in determination of citizenship of a voter as that is the task of govt or Foreigners Tribunal. All of them argued that according to Representation of the People Act, if a person has proof of residence and is over 18, and gives a self-declaration that he is a citizen of India, then EC has no power to inquire into citizenship and delete him from the voters' list.

On Tuesday, a bench of CJI Surya Kant and Justice Joyymalya Bagchi responded, saying, "EC does not claim that it has the power to determine citizenship of a person or declare him as a foreigner. But, if it has doubts about the citizenship of a person registered as a voter or seeking inclusion of name as a voter, it can surely inquire into it."

"The first and foremost pre-condition for inclusion as a voter is that he/she must be a citizen of India. Given the constitutional and statutory powers conferred on EC, can it not undertake an inquisitorial exercise to find out who are doubtful citizens? That is included in the constitutional

task of superintendence of elections," the bench said, in what marked an endorsement of EC's own stance on the issue.

Farasat argued when a statutory procedure was provided for determination of citizenship, EC had no jurisdiction to usurp that process. SC said, "To argue that a person required only proof of residence and age for inclusion in a voter list without proof of citizenship would be a misnomer. Proof of residence and age are statutory requirements. But citizenship is a constitutional requirement."

"Take a hypothetical example of an illegal migrant residing in India for more than a decade and more than 18 years of age. Will he be counted as a citizen to be included in the voter list? To argue that citizenship is to be presumed when residential and age criteria are met will be wrong..." it said.

Farasat said, "The danger of illegal migrants getting into voters' lists is far less compared to mass exclusion of voters in the name of identifying non-citizens." SC said, "Can it be said that by asking for documentary proof, it is attempting to determine citizenship of a person?"

Protesting BLOs take stroke-hit colleague to WB CEO's office

Kolkata: A section of West Bengal's booth-level officers on Tuesday staged a dramatic protest outside the chief electoral officer's office, ferrying a 57-year-old stroke-hit colleague in an ambulance and blaming crushing SIR workload for his collapse, as his family demanded compensation.

Debashish Das of Booth No. 276 under Frasergunge gram panchayat in South 24 Parganas district suffered a severe brain stroke around 10 days ago and was undergoing treatment at SSKM Hospital. He was discharged earlier in the day and brought straight to the protest site by his family members and colleagues.

Members of the BLO Adhikar Raksha Committee

staged a sit-in in front of the CEO's office with the ambulance parked nearby, alleging that EC neither extended compensation nor inquired about the officer's condition.

Das' family claimed that the sudden and intense work pressure linked to SIR duties had triggered the medical emergency. "My father collapsed due to work stress. No one from the commission contacted us even once. We submitted a deputation and demanded compensation under the insurance scheme meant for BLOs. We are seeking Rs 15 lakh," son Sourav Das said.

Protesters said BLOs across the state had been under "tremendous mental and physical pressure" since the SIR exercise began Dec 4. PTI

भारत के बासमती चावल का अमेरिका चौथा सबसे बड़ा बाजार भारत ने 2024-2025 में 2.74 लाख टन का निर्यात किया

भारतीय चावल पर उच्च टैरिफ से अमेरिकी उपभोक्ताओं पर बोझ पड़ेगा। भारतीय चावल निर्यात महासंघ (आईआरईएफ) ने यह चिंता जताई। इसमें कहा गया है कि भारत अन्य देशों के साथ व्यापार सझेदारी को गहरा करना जारी रखेगा व भारतीय चावल के लिए नए बाजारों का विस्तार करेगा।

आईआरईएफ ने कहा कि भारतीय चावल निर्यात मजबूत है और अमेरिकी सहित दुनिया के कई बाजारों में इसकी मांग बनी हुई है। फेडरेशन का कहना है कि अमेरिकी उपभोक्ता पहले ही बढ़ी हुई कीमतों का बोझ उठा रहे हैं, जबकि भारतीय किसानों और निर्यातकों पर इसका सीमित असर पड़ता है।

आईआरईएफ का कहना है कि भारतीय चावल पर पहले से लगे 10 प्रतिशत शुल्क को बढ़ाकर 50 प्रतिशत कर दिया गया, जिसके बाद 40 प्रतिशत की अतिरिक्त बढ़ोतरी हुई। इसके बावजूद निर्यात में बड़ी गिरावट नहीं हुई क्योंकि मूल्य वृद्धि का बड़ा हिस्सा अमेरिकी खुदरा

थिंक टैंक ग्लोबल ट्रेड रिसर्च इनिशिएटिव ने कहा कि ट्रंप का कदम व्यापार नीति से अधिक घरेलू राजनीति का हिस्सा लगता है और अमेरिकी किसानों को साधने की कोशिश है। थिंक टैंक का कहना है कि अगर शुल्क बढ़ता भी है, तो भारत को बड़ा नुकसान नहीं होगा क्योंकि भारतीय चावल की वैश्विक मांग मजबूत है, जबकि बढ़ी हुई कीमतों का असर अमेरिकी परिवारों पर अधिक पड़ेगा। आईआरईएफ के अनुसार, वित्तीय वर्ष 2024-2025 में अमेरिका भारत का चौथा सबसे बड़ा बाजार रहा, जहां भारत ने बासमती चावल के 337.10 मिलियन डॉलर (2.74 लाख टन) का निर्यात किया। वहीं गैर-बासमती चावल के 54.64 मिलियन डॉलर (61,341.54 टन) का निर्यात हुआ, जिसमें अमेरिका 24वां सबसे बड़ा बाजार रहा।
