Man lures minor with job offer, rapes her; held

Kanpur: Police arrested a businessman over the charge of drugging and raping a 16-year-old girl after luring her with a job offer in the Kidwai-nagar area of the city. Police produced the accused in a court, which remanded him in judicial custody on Sunday.

Acting on the survivor's complaint, police registered a case under relevant sections of the PoCSO Act. Police said the accused businessman, 45, took the girl to a hotel telling her he would introduce her to an associate, drugged her, and sexually assaulted her.

Dharmendra Kumar Ram, in charge of Kidwai-nagar PS, said: "We arrested the accused businessman, who deals in threads, from his house in Kidwai-nagar. The survivor has undergone a medical examination."

The survivor from Kanpur is the eldest of four siblings and her father is a farmer. She came to Kanpur looking for work, Ram said.

2 cops hurt in clash with farmers in Gzb

Ghaziabad: Two policemen were injured after farmers clashed with police during a protest against a solid waste management plant in Tronica City on Sunday.

More than 500 farmers and locals, including women and children, gathered outside the plant in Mirpur Hindu village. "More than 10 people, including some women, received severe injuries during the lathi-charge,"

Raghubar Singh, a local, said. Villagers said that the plant - built by Ghaziabad Municipal Corporation - will "spoil the clean environment" of area and increase risk of diseases.

Over 90% work has been completed at plant, which may be functional soon. The work started three years ago.

'Lessons for us': US Admiral lauds execution of Op Sindoor

Defence Ties On 'Steeplly Upward Trajectory'

New Delhi: US commander of Indo-Pacific Command Admiral Samuel J Paparo, during his India visit on Sunday, "applauded the tactical execution" of the Indian military operations against Pakistan during Operation Sindoor and said both India and the US have "lessons to learn" from the conflict.

He said the US-India defence relationship is on a "steeplly upward trajectory", even as he flagged concerns about increasing "coercion" and "aggression" in the Indo-Pacific region.

In reply to a TOI query about his views on Op Sindoor, the US commander said, "First of all, I have tremendous reverence for the terrible event (Pahalgam terror attack) that preceded the crisis. In my discussion with my partners, I applauded the tactical execution (of operations).

We also sincerely applauded the restraint that was exhibited." Admiral Paparo also said that he has seen a deep commitment from Indian military to learn lessons from this conflict. Asked what lessons the US took away from Op Sindoor which saw Chinese weapons being used by Pakistan, Admiral Paparo said, "Complex long-range weapons have complex long-range kill chains". With the "combination of sensors, communication, propulsion, warheads, seekers in the 21st century, geography is no longer a commodity..."

On China's increasing military might, the Admiral, who is responsible for all US military operations in the region, said, "Deterrence is our highest duty. It is my job to think through the worst-case scenario and to be prepared for that. India shares some of those concerns in the Indo-Pacific, as the region is home to 60% of the world's population, more than 60% of the

world's GDP and seven of the world's largest militaries. "We deal with those concerns with the growing partnerships... mutually respectful, sovereign relationship between the world's oldest democracy and the world's largest democracy," he said, adding both the US and India are committed to the principles of sovereignty, freedom of navigation and freedom of seas. "We applaud India as a great net contributor to the security of the Indian Ocean region," he said.

The two sides are also looking at boosting maritime security cooperation, including in the sphere of undersea domain awareness. With the impending MILAN exercise in mind, Admiral Paparo said, "It is great to see the deepening of Indo-US defence partnership, enshrined in the recent defence agreement signed in Kuala Lumpur between US Secretary of War Pete Hegseth and Indian defence minister Rajnath Singh.

Skill push falters: 5 yrs after launch, seat closures & sharp drop in student intake

New Delhi: Conceived to provide job-oriented skill education to youth from low-income and underserved communities, Delhi Skill and Entrepreneurship University (DSEU), set up in 2020 by merging 10 govt polytechnics to widen access, is witnessing a sharp decline in seats and enrolment, according to data submitted to a Delhi govt-appointed committee examining complaints about its functioning.

The public state university has seen a significant number of seat closures, including the elimination of all 802 girls-only diploma seats. Diploma intake has fallen by 44%, from 5,286 in

2020 to 2,970 in 2025, while the number of diploma courses has reduced from 28 to 17. Between 2022 and 2024, the university shut 3,332 of 8,107 undergraduate seats (41%), with 78% of seats listed in 2023 marked closed. Enrolment is weak across DSEU campuses, with 39% seats vacant in the ongoing academic session.

As many as 26 of 37 programmes are running at less than half capacity and 12 at below 25%. The decline has coincided with a steep fee escalation. Diploma fees rose from about Rs 30,000 to Rs 49,650 by 2021-22, increased to Rs 51,700 over the next two years, and then jumped to over Rs 1.9 lakh in 2024-25, before slightly reducing to about Rs 1.8 lakh this year.

Mom busy in photo shoot, 3-yr-old drowns in B'luru

Bengaluru: What began as a maternity photoshoot venue ended in tragedy for a seven-month pregnant woman as her three-year-old son drowned in a pond at a private studio in Bengaluru on Saturday. The woman, Swathi's son, Lakshveer C, was playing at The Shire Studio. Police suspect Lakshveer may have wandered towards pond and accidentally slipped into the water.

When Swathi could not find her son, she began searching the premises. He was found in one of the ponds. He was taken to a hospital, where doctors declared him dead. Police said pond had more than 2 ft of water. Lakshveer, was about 3 ft tall. He may have got stuck in the mud, police said.

Delhi WCD-NGO joint roadmap in works to plug child safety gaps

New Delhi: Despite nearly 2.2 lakh distress calls to Child Helpline 1098 between Sept 2023 and Dec 2025 - and 14,684 cases escalated to District Child Protection Units (DCPUs) - a large number of vulnerable children in Delhi still fall outside the protection net. Many remain on the streets, and even those aware of support systems often struggle to access them.

This gap has prompted the Department of Women and Child Development to work with civil society organisations on a joint roadmap aimed at strengthening last-mile delivery of child protection services in the city.

The push gathered momentum during a recent multi-stakeholder consultation organised by CHETNA (Childhood Enhancement Through Training and Action) along with Delhi govt. More than 90 participants, including govt officials, NGOs and children, met to discuss how to make the city safer and more responsive for at-risk children. Officials shared updates on the functioning of protection systems, noting that the 24x7 helpline remains a critical emergency link connecting children in crisis to rescue, care and long-term rehabilitation.

Operating through a central control room, district units and help desks at major transport hubs, it is often the first point of contact for children seeking assistance.

Murder over cap in Delhi staged as accidental fall

New Delhi: What was initially reported as an accidental injury from falling on an iron rod has turned out to be a murder over a cap in northwest Delhi's Vijay Vihar. According to police, the incident came to light on Feb 11 when a PCR call was received from a govt hospital about a minor boy being admitted with a serious injury. The injured teen was declared unfit to give a statement at the time.

Later that night, around 10.50pm, he told doctors he had accidentally fallen on an iron rod from the roof of his home.

Two days later, on Feb 13, the boy succumbed to his injuries. "A post-mortem conducted the following day revealed that the wound on his body was a stab injury caused by a sharp-edged weapon and not consistent with an accidental fall. Investigators said the findings indicated that the incident had been deliberately projected as an accident, while the actual cause of death was homicidal." Additional CP (Rohini) Rajeev Ranjan said. A case was subsequently registered at Vijay Vihar police station.
