'Look forward to hosting PM Modi soon': Australian PM Albanese hails bilateral ties

Canberra, Hailing their bilateral relationship, Australian Prime Minister Anthony Albanese stated that the ties between the two nations continue to deepen through culture, education, cricket and trade and that he looks forward to hosting Prime Minister Narendra Modi in the near future. In his address at the Australian Parliament, Albanese highlighted India's economic growth and emphasized that the trade relationship between the two nations has been further enhanced by the Economic Cooperation and Trade Agreement (ECTA). He recalled his first visit to India in 1991, describing it as a "wonderful experience".

"India, of course, has the largest population in the world, but it will also grow to be the third largest economy in the world over this decade. That is an extraordinary opportunity for us in our region. We are a Pacific nation, but we are also an Indian Ocean nation as well. Our trading relationship has been enhanced by the Economic Cooperation and Trade Agreement, and we are further drawn together through culture, education, and, of course, the international language of cricket. One of my great honours has been my two visits so far to India as Prime Minister."

"When I first visited India



as a backpacker way back in 1991, a long time ago, I travelled a bit differently in those days. I do want to say, if you want to understand India, get on a video bus or train. It is a wonderful experience to see firsthand the warmth that is there. Now, likewise, will have the privilege of hosting Prime Minister Modi here soon, a privilege I look forward to repeating for the second time," he added.

Albanese lauded the Indian community's contribution to Australia and how they have strengthened ties between the two nations. He expressed the Australian government's commitment to supporting Indians and their interests.

"Like last time, Prime Minister Modi's visit will be made extraordinary by so many of the million-strong Indian Australian community,

the largest growing migrant community in Australia. That's so much through their love of this country, their spirit of generosity and through generations of hard work and aspiration that have strengthened our economy and enhanced our society, not least, of course, all those wonderful small businesses that have benefited from the Indian diaspora," he said.

"What these great Australians have done in the process is strengthen the important links between this land that is their home and future and the land of their extraordinary heritage. I say to them, we're a better country because of you. My government will always stand up for you and your interests. We will reject any attempt to divide. That is definitely worth noting that we need to celebrate the contribution that Indian migrants have made and will continue to make to this country," he added.

While sharing Albanese's view on X, Australia's High Commissioner to India Philip Green said: "When your Prime Minister Anthony Albanese speaks with so much conviction & passion about India - the country where you serve as the High Commissioner - it makes your job infinitely more meaningful. We look forward to welcoming you to Australia, Prime Minister Narendra Modi ji."

BJP appoints Jat Sikh Kewal Singh Dhillon as Punjab chief, replacing Jakhar

Chandigarh, Ahead of the Assembly elections in Punjab, the BJP national President on Thursday appointed a Jat Sikh face and former legislator Kewal Singh Dhillon, 75, a close confidante of former Chief Minister Capt Amarinder Singh, as the new state president, replacing Sunil Jakhar, the party's prominent Hindu face in the state. Political observers said the BJP's decision to bet on Dhillon is part of a strategy to project a Sikh face in the Sikh-dominated Punjab with an eye on the 2027 Assembly elections.

Dhillon served as a Congress legislator from Barnala from 2007 to 2017 before being defeated by AAP's Gurmeet Singh Meht Hayer, who is now the party's Member of Parliament.

Dhillon joined the BJP in June 2022 along with Congress leaders after the party's defeat in the Assembly elections.

He contested the Sangrur Lok Sabha by-election in 2022 and the Barnala Assembly bypoll in 2024, both on a BJP ticket, but lost both.

In September 2024, there were rumours about the resignation of Sunil Jakhar as state unit president, which was denied by the BJP. At that time, party sources had said Jakhar had been upset for some time over the state of affairs and had already apprised the top leadership about his unwillingness to work as the state party president. At that time, there were rumours about his



purported "differences" with the party. He had also preferred to remain absent from a meeting called by him to finalise the party's strategy for the ongoing membership drive.

Currently, Jakhar was aggressively taking up issues relating to the state and participating in the party's meetings and functions by travelling across the state.

The Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) in July 2023 appointed former Congress leader Jakhar as its state unit president.

Jakhar, one of the senior Congress leaders in Punjab, joined the BJP in May 2022, three months after the Assembly elections that the Congress lost.

A former Lok Sabha MP from Gurdaspur, Jakhar is a three-time MLA from the Abohar Assembly constituency. He is known for his plain speaking and straightforward approach. Jakhar had been the Congress chief in the state for four years before being replaced by Navjot Singh Sidhu in 2021.

India, South Korea to form sub-groups on digital trade, supply chains under CEPA upgrade talks

New Delhi, India and South Korea have decided to create dedicated sub-groups to deepen discussions on digital trade, supply chain cooperation and strategic industrial collaboration as part of efforts to upgrade the India-Korea Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (IK CEPA). It was announced on Thursday.

The talks were conducted pursuant to the Joint Declaration signed on April 20 by Union Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal and Korean Trade Minister Yeo Han-woo during the State Visit of the President of the Republic of Korea to India, according to an official statement issued after the latest round of negotiations in the national capital.

According to the statement, both sides reviewed the progress made so far in the CEPA upgrade negotiations and held discussions in a "constructive and cooperative spirit", reflecting the "Futuristic Partnership" envisioned by Prime Minister Narendra Modi and South Korean President Lee Jae-myung.

"Both sides reviewed the progress achieved so far in the IK CEPA upgrade negotiations," the Ministry of Commerce and Industry said.

"The discussions were held in a constructive and cooperative spirit, reflecting



the strong bilateral relationship and the 'Futuristic Partnership' envisioned by Prime Minister Narendra Modi and President of the Republic of Korea Lee Jae-myung," it added.

During the latest round, negotiators discussed multiple areas including trade in goods, trade in services, rules of origin and origin procedures, investment, and sanitary and phytosanitary standards.

India and South Korea also acknowledged the widening

bilateral trade deficit since the original IK CEPA came into force in 2010 and agreed to address the issue within the broader CEPA framework.

The two countries reaffirmed their commitment to conclude the CEPA upgrade negotiations in a time-bound manner with the aim of achieving a modernised and mutually beneficial agreement that promotes balanced bilateral trade and stronger economic cooperation.

Stronger India-Canada trade ties can bolster supply chain resilience: Report

New Delhi, A Canada-India trade agreement may seem modest in aggregate volume, but it is disproportionately important for Canada's diversification strategy and North American supply chain resilience, especially in critical minerals, clean energy and knowledge intensive services, according to an article in One World Outlook. Of late, bilateral commerce has grown into a mid-sized but still underexploited relationship. In fiscal year 2023-24, India-Canada merchandise trade reached about \$8.4 billion, up slightly from \$8.3 billion in 2022-23. In calendar year terms, bilateral trade in goods and services stood at \$18.38 billion in 2023 and rose to roughly \$23 billion in 2024, which shows that services now account for a significant share of the relationship, the article observes.

India imports pulses, fertilisers, newsprint, wood pulp, and industrial chemicals from Canada, creating concentrated dependencies in specific food security and input intensive sectors.

On the export side, India ships gems and jewellery, pharmaceutical products, ready-made garments, organic chemicals and light engineering goods to Canada, reflecting India's role as a diversified manufacturing and processing hub rather than a simple commodity supplier. Services are where the



bilateral relationship has grown most dynamically and where an Early Progress Trade Agreement (EPTA) or Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (CEPA) EPTA/CEPA could deliver the highest value added gains for Canada and the United States.

Canada's services exports to India account for only about 1 per cent of its total services exports, whereas services imports from India have climbed to an estimated 3.5 per cent of Canada's total services imports, implying rising Canadian reliance on Indian IT, professional, and back-office capabilities, the article states.

For Ottawa, the strategic value of an India deal lies less in raw volume and more in diversification, away from an overwhelming dependence on the United States and a fraught but still sizable relationship with China. Global Affairs Canada has explicitly identified India as a priority partner within its Indo Pacific

strategy, with an ambition to double two-way trade with India by 2030, the article points out. It highlights that on the Indian side, sustained high growth and surging energy demand anchor the economic rationale for deeper engagement. Canada's natural resources ministry explicitly notes that India is expected to account for the largest growth in global energy demand through 2030, positioning it as a key long term market for Canadian liquefied natural gas (LNG), crude, and other fuels.

India's rapid electrification, ambitious renewable energy targets, and expanding middle class also create demand for critical minerals, advanced manufacturing inputs, and aerospace technology that Canada can competitively supply.

Siddaramaiah decides to step down as K'taka CM after breakfast meet with Shivakumar

Bengaluru, In a major development, Karnataka Chief Minister Siddaramaiah on Thursday announced his decision to tender his resignation during the breakfast meeting hosted by him at his official residence 'Kaveri' in Bengaluru. The official statement by the CM's office stated, "Chief Minister Siddaramaiah will visit Lok Bhavan today at 2.30 pm. Later, at 3 pm, he will address a press conference at his other official residence, 'Krishna'."

State Minister for Law and Parliamentary Affairs H.K. Patil, while leaving after attending the breakfast meeting, further confirmed, "CM is going to Raj Bhavan. CM Siddaramaiah will make Shivakumar the new CM."

Sources further revealed that Siddaramaiah announced while having breakfast with his cabinet colleagues. He stated that he would tender his resignation by 3 p.m. Siddaramaiah appeared composed while making the announcement and calmly said that he would head to Lok Bhavan later in the afternoon



to submit his resignation. Congress insiders stated that Siddaramaiah will announce Shivakumar's name to the post of the CM at the Congress Legislature Party Meeting. The meeting is yet to be scheduled by the party leadership. It can be recalled that amid intense speculation over a possible leadership change in Karnataka, Chief Minister Siddaramaiah and Deputy CM Shivakumar met over breakfast at the former's official residence 'Kaveri' earlier in the day.

Deputy Chief Minister D.K. Shivakumar, who is considered a strong contender for the CM's post, arrived at the residence along with several cabinet ministers and senior Congress leaders close to Siddaramaiah.

Trinamool leader Santanu Sen resigns from party's All-India Spokesperson post

Kolkata, Doctor and Trinamool Congress leader, Santanu Sen, resigned from the post of the party's All-India Spokesperson, by sending a letter to former Chief Minister and Trinamool supremo, Mamata Banerjee on Thursday.

The former Rajya Sabha MP said that he has decided to leave the post after accepting the verdict of the people in state Assembly elections. Santanu had spoken out about hospital corruption after the rape and murder of a junior doctor at RG Kar Medical College and Hospital in 2024. At that time, he was suspended from the party for making anti-party statements. He was also removed from the post of party spokesperson. Later, he got the post back. Now with Trinamool Congress out of power, Santanu has left that post again. He has sent a letter to the party leader in this regard. However, it is not yet clear whether his resignation has been accepted or not. A few days ago, he posted a note on social media congratulating the newly-elected BJP government in the state and thanking new Chief Minister Suwendu Adhikari.

New leadership a positive step: Cong leaders back Shivakumar for K'taka CM post

Bengaluru, Karnataka politics witnessed a major development on Thursday after senior Congress leader Siddaramaiah confirmed that he would step down as Chief Minister, bringing an end to the prolonged leadership tussle within the party over the state's top post. The announcement also put to rest months of speculation surrounding the power-sharing arrangement between Siddaramaiah and his deputy D.K. Shivakumar that had frequently dominated political discussions and at times threatened to overshadow the functioning of the government in the state. Siddaramaiah also confirmed that Shivakumar would succeed him, paving the way for a leadership transition within the Karnataka Congress.



Reacting to the development, Maharashtra Congress MLA, Vijay Wadettiwar, said the transition was linked to earlier discussions within the party before the elections. "Before the elections, there were some discussions, and this is all related to that. Siddaramaiah is a very senior and respected leader in our party. He will be given due respect in the party, as he has made a significant contribution and has done good work as Chief Minister," Wadettiwar said.
