Tweak Sought in Capital Norms for Urban Coop Bank Licence

RBI had proposed ₹300 cr threshold in a discussion paper issued in January

New Delhi: The Reserve Bank of India is evaluating requests to lower the minimum capital requirement to ₹200 crore for co-operative credit societies seeking an urban co-operative bank (UCB) licence, people familiar with the matter said. The central bank had proposed a ₹300 crore threshold in a discussion paper issued in January.

Other suggestions under consideration include allowing financially sound societies with a five-year track record to merge with existing UCBs, the people said.

"We are hopeful the central bank will look favourably at these suggestions as they align with current economic realities and will help UCBs bring more people into the formal banking system," a bank executive said.

Industry bodies have also sought raising the aggregate ceiling on unsecured advances to members to 25% of a UCB's total loans, from the revised 20% cap.

In guidelines issued in February, the RBI said any additional unsecured advances beyond this limit would be allowed only for priority sector-eligible loans, subject to a ceiling of ₹50,000 per borrower.

According to latest available data, co-operative banks accounted for 5.4% of total banking sector deposits and UCBs for 3.1% as of March 31, 2025. Their share in loans stood at 5.6% and 3.8%, respectively.

In its January discussion paper, the RBI said five years may be too short to assess a co-operative soci-

ety's performance. "Hence, active operations for at least 10 years and a good financial track record of at least five years are desirable" for applying, it said.

An email sent to the RBI did not receive a response till press time Tuesday.

"We have also sought a ₹5 lakh ceiling on advances to nominal members for tier-3 and tier-4 UCBs," another UCB executive said.

Earlier this year, the RBI raised the lending limit to nominal members for purchase of consumer durables to ₹2.5 lakh per borrower across all UCBs. "The RBI may also consider extending the tenure of such loans to up to five years from the current one year," the executive said. "The above amendments shall come into force from October 1, 2026, or an earlier date when adopted by a UCB in their entirety," the central bank said in its February notification.

ZURICH AIRPORT GROUP-OWNED HUB HAS TO APPOINT AN INDIAN AS NEW CEO FOR FLIGHTS TO COMMENCE: GOVT Security Approval for Noida Airport CEO Rejected

New Delhi: The Bureau of Civil Aviation Security (BCAS) has rejected the security approval of Christoph Schnellmann, chief executive officer of the new Noida International Airport, as he is a foreign national which violates the current aviation security norms for greenfield airports.

A 2011 order by the BCAS mandates that the CEO of any greenfield airport shall be the security coordinator at the respective airports and responsible for coordinating the implementation



of security measures. Director General of BCAS Rajesh Nirwan did not immediately respond to queries.

The airport, owned by Zurich Airport group, has to now appoint an Indian as its new CEO for flights to commence, said a senior government official. Schnellmann, a Swiss citizen, has been leading the airport project since 2020.

ASPNOD UNDER REVIEW
The Noida airport is the first instance of a foreign investor owning 100% equity in an Indian airport. In March, it received its aerodrome licence from the Directorate General

of Civil Aviation, but its aerodrome security programme (ASP) is currently under review by the BCAS. Noida airport said authorities they are working closely with the BCAS to secure approval for the ASP.

Foreign Ownership Can Boost Credit Profiles of Indian Lenders: Fitch

New Delhi: Fitch Ratings said on Tuesday that significant ownership by foreign shareholders can be positive for Indian financial institutions' credit profiles through long-term capital, as well as lifting of governance standards in some cases.

"We believe there is more scope for foreign shareholders to gain control of non-bank financial institutions (NBFI) than banks, as regulations allow up to full foreign ownership of NBFIs," Fitch said in a statement.

However, it cautioned that foreign interest is not in itself a reliable signal of stronger credit fundamentals. Transactions that strengthen internal controls, risk management and leadership accountability can be more credit-relevant

than those purely for financial gains, it noted.

"Recent greater interest from foreign investors indicates their rising confidence in India's long-term growth prospects, the financial sector's regulations and oversight, and improved risk governance," Fitch said.

Closer alignment with the stronger shareholder raises the likelihood of contingent capital and liquidity support.
