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ICICI Pru AMC Buys Office Space in Wadala for ₹525 crore

Mumbai: Investment management firm ICICI Prudential Asset Management Company has acquired nine floors of VIOS Tower from global asset manager Varde Partners in central Mumbai's Wadala locality through a company acquisition for about ₹525 crore. The domestic asset manager has acquired the commercial building with

over 300,000 square feet of office space through its ₹2,500-crore alternative investment fund, ICICI Prudential Office Yield Optimiser Fund II, which focuses on acquiring completed and pre-leased office properties across India's top property markets. The office space, spread over the ground floor to the eighth floor, is completely leased and occupied by established companies, and is expected to provide an annual yield of more than

8%. The existing lease agreements with the tenants include a 5% annual rental escalation. "Our focus remains on long-term wealth creation through diversification across asset classes. In the current environment of uncertainty and evolving market dynamics, we believe real income-yielding assets can play an important role in building resilient portfolios for investors," said Rohit Rathi, principal real estate business, ICICI Prudential AMC. The transaction marks the seventh commercial asset acquired by the fund in recent months, deepening its presence in income-yielding commercial real estate. Varde Partners had acquired the tower by acquiring the company NCP Commercial from Lodha Group for ₹1,100 crore in December 2019. It had later sold part of the building to Federal Bank and Trent. The deal with ICICI Prudential for the nine floors returns Varde Partners' absolute returns on exit at more than 120%. Federal Bank had acquired five floors in the tower for nearly ₹30 crore in November 2024. The tower is now partly owned by Trent and Federal Bank. Built in 2018, the tower has office space spanning more than 827,000 sq ft over 29 floors and forms part of a 22-acre mixed-use development.

- a) For the year and quarter ended March 31, 2026, the exceptional items relates to workforce reduction measures for an amount of ₹52.62 Crores and ₹8.99 Crores respectively provided for severance payments and retirement benefits at Pfaudler GmbH in Waghäusel, Germany. This provision covers costs for certain employees already released and proposed to be released in the next financial year.
b) On November 21, 2025, the Government of India notified the four Labour Codes - the Code on Wages, 2019, the Industrial Relations Code, 2020, the Code on Social Security, 2020, and the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020 - consolidating 29 existing labour laws. The Ministry of Labour & Employment published draft Central Rules and FAQs to enable assessment of the financial impact due to changes in regulations. The Group has assessed the financial implications of these changes on the basis of legal opinion obtained and the best information available, consistent with the guidance provided by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India which has resulted in increase in gratuity and leave liability by ₹12.89 Crores. Considering the impact arising out of an enactment of the new legislation is an event of non-recurring nature, the Group has presented this incremental amount under 'Exceptional Items' for the year ended March 31, 2026. The Group continues to monitor the finalisation of Central / State Rules and clarifications from the Government on other aspects of the Labour Code and would provide appropriate accounting effect based on such developments as needed.
- The figures of last quarters are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of full financial year up to March 31, 2026 and March 31, 2025 and unaudited published year to date figures up to December 31, 2025 and December 31, 2024 respectively, being the date of end of third quarter of the respective financial years which were subjected to limited review.
- The Board of Directors, in their meeting held on May 21, 2026, have recommended a final dividend of ₹1/- per share for the current Financial Year 2025-26 subject to approval by shareholders of the Company.
- The reported results for the quarter ended December 31, 2025 has been restated on account of updation of provisional fair values of identified assets and liabilities for the purpose of Purchase Price Allocation of the acquired entities during the Financial year 2025-26. - The consolidated figure includes financials of the wholly owned subsidiaries of the company named Transcorp Estates Private Limited , Ritco Travels & Tours Private Limited, Transwire Forex Limited and Transcorp Payments Limited .
- The Executive Director cum CFO of the Company have certified in terms of Regulation 33(2)(a) of SEBI (LODR) Regulations, 2015 that the above financial results do not contain any false or misleading statement or figures and do not omit any material fact which may make the statement or figures contained therein misleading.
- Company had during the quarter ended 31.12.2024 notified that in respect of its prepaid instrument transactions the amounts related to successful IMPS transactions involving 189.87 lacs were erroneously credited back to customer wallets due to failure of software in decrypting the API responses received. Company immediately took the necessary steps and has so far recovered back a sum of Rs.104.34 lacs from respective remitters. Process of recovering the balance amount is on. Company as per its best estimate booked a loss of Rs. 23 lacs in Year ended 31.03.2025 and Rs. 47 lacs booked till Quarter 3rd ended 31.12.2025. The final loss has been assessed at Rs. 85.53 lakh and as such has booked remaining Rs. 15.53 lakh in this qtr i.e. qtr 4th ended 31.3.2026.
- The Government of India has consolidated 29 existing labour legislations into a unified framework comprising four labour codes viz the Code on Wages, 2019, the Code on Social Security, 2020, the Industrial Relations Code, 2020, and the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020 (collectively referred to as the 'Codes'). The Codes have been made effective from November 21, 2025. The incremental impact of these changes, assessed by the Company, is not material and has been recognised in employee benefit expenses and provision for employee benefits for gratuity on account of past service cost.
- The Board of Directors recommended a final dividend of Rs. 0.4 per equity share of face value of Rs. 2 each
- The company is engaged in the business of forex and remittance and hence there is no separate reportable segment within the criteria defined under IndAS 108 - 'Operating Segments'.

Sebi Proposes Tweaks to Price Discovery for IPOs, Re-listing

Mumbai: The Securities and Exchange Board of India (Sebi) has proposed changes to the price discovery process for initial public offerings (IPOs) and re-listed shares on the date of their listing.

The move comes in the wake of concerns being raised by market participants that existing rules have in certain cases resulted in artificially suppressed price discovery for re-listed securities.

The regulator has suggested changes to the pre-open call auction process, including a new methodology for determining base prices for re-listed stocks and a more dynamic mechanism for widening price bands.

"Representations have been received by Sebi stating that the dummy price band and the mechanism for base price in case of a re-listed scrip are leading to situations of artificially suppressed price discovery," Sebi said in a consultation paper on Thursday.

"Subsequently there is persistent buying pressure in the scrips in the normal market leading to continuous hit of the upper circuits and additional surveillance measures as applicable in the respective exchanges," it said.

The regulator said, in one instance, it observed that during the call auction session of the re-listed stock, 90% of the buy orders were rejected due to being outside the price bands. Presently, the pre-open call auction session for IPOs and re-listed shares are from 9 am to 10 am.

Under the proposed framework, the existing issue price methodology for IPOs would continue. However, for re-listed stocks, the regulator plans to introduce a revised approach to determine the base price. For stocks resuming trading within six months of suspension, the latest available market price within the previous six months would be used.

Re Raises Head after 10 Days on Likely RBI Intervention

TO THE RESCUE Heavy dollar sales by state-run banks, and expectations of a rate hike helped rupee rebound, but elevated oil prices and FPI outflows continue to weigh

Mumbai: The Indian rupee, under the cosh for 10 straight days, Thursday rebounded against the dollar in the spot market to log its steepest gains in a fortnight after what dealers described as unusually heavy central bank interventions to support the currency.

Talk that policymakers might even raise interest rates buttressed the rupee, which outshone peers in the continent to emerge as the strongest Asian performer against the dollar Thursday.

The local unit closed at 96.20 per dollar in the Mumbai spot market against the previous close of 96.82. Traders reported heavy dollar sales by state-run banks, likely on behalf of the Reserve Bank of India (RBI), a day after forward market rates for the rupee had breached the psychologically important 100 per USD mark.

"The RBI must have sold \$4.5 billion today (Thursday), so there was heavy dollar selling after a long time. The stronger levels of forward importers a good opportunity to buy, but I suspect importers hedged only their short-term liabilities," said Anil Bhansali, head of treasury, Finrex Treasury Advisors. "Many are waiting for better levels on expectations the RBI would come up with some measures to protect the rupee."

Intervention was seen even before domestic markets started trading, with the rupee strengthening from around 96.75 a dollar at 8.45 am to open at 96.30. Traders said interventions continued through the day, as the currency moved in a 95.99-96.50 range, while stronger rupee levels prompted importers to step in and buy dollars.

"After touching almost 97, the currency recovered today (Thursday). Plus, there were reports that there is a possibility of rate action, which aided the rupee," said VRC Reddy, head of treasury, Karur Vysya Bank. "But underlying sentiments like higher oil prices and FPI outflows continue, and until those persist, there will be weakness."

India is considering all available options, including an interest rate increase, to help stabilise the currency, Bloomberg News reported Thursday.

Reddy said he also expects the depreciation pressure to moderate going forward, as "one positive news item will pave the way for a sharp appreciation in the currency."

DBS Bank, meanwhile, expects the rupee to be in the 95-100 range for the rest of 2026, the institution said in a note Thursday.

Brent crude futures gained \$1.39 to \$106.4 a barrel on Thursday, according to Reuters. The rupee has depreciated more than 3% in FY27 so far, and had lost nearly 11% in FY26 against the dollar.

LIC Profit Rises 23% in March Quarter on All-round Show

FY26 PAT UP 19% TO ₹57,453 CR

Mumbai: Life Insurance Corporation of India reported a 23% year-on-year rise in consolidated net profit for the March quarter at ₹23,467 crore, driven by strong premium growth, higher investment income and improved operating performance, even as the insurer cautioned that prolonged geopolitical tensions could weigh on savings flows and economic activity.

The country's largest domestic institutional investor had reported a net profit of ₹19,039 crore in the year-ago period. The board also recommended a final dividend of ₹10 per share for FY26.

For the full year, FY26 LIC posted a profit after tax of ₹57,453 crore, up 19% from ₹48,320 crore in FY25, while net premium income rose 10% to ₹5.38 lakh crore from ₹4.90 lakh crore a year earlier.

LIC expects macroeconomic uncertainty arising from the ongoing West Asia conflict to have some impact across sectors, including life insurance savings, however, it will continue targeting double digit growth in new business premium income.

"It is expected that every sector of the country will be impacted by the ongoing crisis," said R Doraiswamy, MD and CEO, LIC. "Naturally, when people experience some difficulty, savings, and that too savings through life insurance, can certainly have an impact, but we will try our best to continue to move towards our targeted growth rate."

First-year premium income rose 17% year-on-year to ₹13,009 crore in the March quarter, while renewal premium income increased 14% to ₹82,233 crore. Single premium collections climbed 22% to ₹70,119 crore.

Investment income, a key earnings driver for LIC, rose around 17% to ₹1,09 lakh crore during the quarter from ₹93,443 crore a year ago. However, the gains were partly aided by a change in accounting policy implemented in the fourth quarter, which contributed around ₹11,000 crore to growth in investment income.

The insurer's solvency ratio improved to 2.35 at the end of FY26 from 2.11 a year ago.

LIC also said it continues to focus on non-participating savings and protection products. Protection business registered a growth rate of nearly 29% during the year, helped partly by customers opting for higher sum assured products.

The share of foreign institutional investor ownership in LIC has risen recently to over 0.3% as of March 31, 2026, from 0.22% at the time of the allotment of Initial Public Offering. Shares of LIC closed flat at ₹80.70 when BSE benchmark index fell 0.24%.

Foreign Investors Keep Pulling Out from Banks

AMID STRONGER EMERGING MARKET ALTERNATIVES...

Mumbai: Foreign investors continued to pare exposure to financials in the first half of May, pulling out ₹17,960 crore from the sector, nearly 47% of the overall foreign outflows during the period, amid concerns over tighter banking margins and India's lower appeal compared to other emerging markets.

"Banks are facing headwinds from higher bond yields, which could impact treasury income, while implementation of Expected Credit Loss (ECL) norms, requiring higher provisioning, is expected to keep return ratios volatile in the near term," said Pankaj Pandey, head of retail research at ICICI Securities.

Between January and April, overseas investors dumped more than ₹91,000 crore worth of financials, a sector with the highest foreign ownership in India.

The Bank Nifty has fallen nearly 7% over the past month, compared with a 4% decline in the benchmark Nifty.

"The valuations in the banking space remain reasonable, and the foreign outflows in the sector are due to these investors wanting to cut exposure to India as a whole, as they find better bets in the rest of the emerging markets," said Siddharth Bhamre, head of research, Asit C Mehta Intermediates. "They cannot reduce weightage in India without selling banking stocks."

Overall, foreign investors sold shares worth ₹38,443 crore across 19 sectors in the first half of May, according to NSDL data. Oil & gas saw outflows of ₹6,885 crore, while telecom stocks witnessed selling worth ₹2,542 crore, extending the pressure seen in April.

Overseas investors bought shares worth ₹11,395 crore across four sectors, with nearly 60% of the inflows directed in the services sector. "The services sector, which includes Adani Group stocks such as Adani Ports and Adani Enterprises, performed well after resolving issues related to the US Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC)," said Pandey.

Pandey said that the MSCI rebalancing next week could draw some foreign inflows, but that is a one-time event.

"The extent of selling pressure will be contingent on oil price movement," he said.

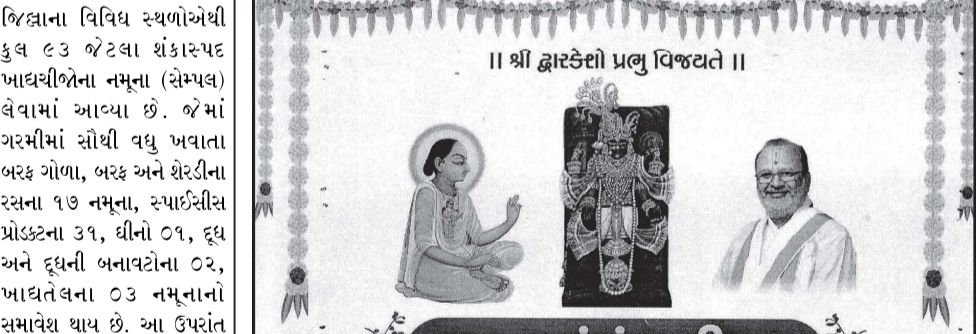
