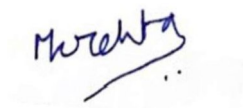

NCLT Rejects Plea against MT Educare by Its Ex-CFO

Court clarifies dispute over salary doesn't fall under 'operational dues'

Mumbai: The bankruptcy court has dismissed a petition filed against BSE-listed MT Educare by its former chief financial officer (CFO) for allegedly failing to clear his dues.

The ruling is expected to set a precedent for similar cases where disgruntled key managerial personnel approach the National Company Law Tribunal, seeking insolvency proceedings against their former employers.

The Mumbai bench of the NCLT has observed in its ruling that the petition, filed for the resolution of salary of two months' notice period, did not fall within the definition of an 'operational' debt, as it was not the salary for an actual work done by the operational creditor. In a 14-page order on May 12, a division bench of judicial member

LOC Cannot Be Issued for Non-cognisable Offence

As per this principle, every individual should get a chance of being heard, he argued.

Aggarwal highlighted the plight of individuals who can't travel on account of LOCs. They are isolated at the airport from their family and don't get a refund on tickets, he said. Those against whom LOCs are issued are not informed in advance, leading to a public spectacle as they are barred from leaving at the airport by the Bureau of Immigration, part of the ministry of home affairs.

Li urged the Delhi High Court to direct the authorities to inform him of the reasons for the LOC. His petition cited a February 18 show-cause notice issued by the I-T department to Hua-wei, arguing that the company referred to in the notice was non-cognisable. His lawyer argued that an LOC cannot be issued for a non-cognisable offence. Li also pointed out that he's not been served with a show-cause notice in his name for any prosecution proceedings by the I-T department.

INTERIM RELIEF

In interim relief, the Delhi High Court said Li can approach the investigating officer in case he needs to travel abroad for

emergency reasons.

"Needless to state that if such an application is filed, the same shall be considered on its own merits by the I-T department in accordance with law without being influenced by any observation made in this order," said the Delhi High Court order.

At Li's request, the high court also implored the central government through the Bureau of Immigration to inform him of the reasons for the LOC. He also challenged raids carried out by the I-T department at locations belonging to him and himself in February 17, sought quashing of the February 16 panchnama prepared by I-T officers, arguing that the raids were not carried out in consonance with the rules. A panchnama is a document that lists the evidence and findings made by officers at the scene of searches.

HV Subba Rao and technical member CB Singh also marked that the remedy for the creditor here would be to initiate legal proceedings against an appropriate legal forum and not under the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code (IBC). Advocate Nausar Kohli, appearing for MT Educare, argued that there was a pre-existing dispute as to whether the notice period was one month or three months. He argued that MT Educare, being a listed entity, must not be put into insolvency till such a triable issue was adjudicated.
