- **Delhi Airport Regulatory Update:** TDSAT¹ vide its judgement dated 01 July 2025 has quashed and set aside the calculation of HRAB² earlier done by AERA³ and directed it to recalculate the HRAB value afresh as on 01 April 2009, keeping in mind the values of the tariff components as provided in the State Support Agreement entered between GOI through Ministry of Civil Aviation and Delhi Airport.
