- In fact, growth in traffic was visible on a sequential basis:
 - In March 2025, Pax traffic increased by 10.4% MoM (compared with Feb'25) with Domestic Pax growth of 12.5% due to resumption & enhanced domestic connectivity
 - In Q4 FY25, Pax traffic increased by 8.1% QoQ (compared with Q3 FY25) with Domestic Pax growth of 5.7%
- GOX cumulatively handled 9.8 mn Pax since commencement of domestic operations from 5 Jan'23 & International operations from 21 Jul'23
