In terms of provisions of Regulation 30 (read with Part A of Schedule III) and other applicable provisions of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (Listing Regulations) and further to our letter no. 2024\I\82 dated 9th May 2024 filed with the Exchange, this is to inform that the Company has received the final order dated 27/02/2026 of the National Green Tribunal (NGT) over alleged environmental pollution case filed against the Company's Goa plant.

The Tribunal has dismissed the original application filed by the applicants and has decided in favour of the Company.

Nature and details of the action(s) taken or order(s) passed	<p>Vide its order dated 27/02/2026, the Tribunal after being satisfied has dismissed the original application on the following grounds:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The Tribunal rejected the contention that villagers were suffering from serious ailments due to the pollution caused by the Company's industrial activities. Further, the medical reports relied upon by the applicants were held to be general in nature and insufficient to establish any grave or specific health impact attributable to the Company.

		<p>2. The grant of Consent to Operate by the Goa State Pollution Control Board demonstrated that the competent regulatory authority was satisfied regarding compliance; hence, no violation could be presumed at the stage of grant of such consent.</p> <p>3. The Joint Committee Inspection did not record any instance of non-compliance on the part of the Company, and the recommendations made by the Joint Inspection Committee have already been duly complied with by the Company.</p> <p>4. In view of the subsisting and valid Consent to Operate, coupled with the Joint Committee Report indicating substantial compliance, no ground was made out for directing shifting or closure of the Company's Goa Plant.</p> <p>5. The Tribunal observed that the applicants' case appeared to rest on apprehensions of pollution.</p> <p>6. Accordingly, Original Application No. 80 of 2024 (WZ) was disposed of.</p>
