# Awami League ramps up pressure on Yunus as confrontation mounts

The political standoff in Bangladesh deepened on Friday as the Sheikh Hasina-led Bangladesh Awami League intensified its agitation against the interim government headed by Nobel laureate Muhammad Yunus. With Yunus under increasing pressure after announcing that a referendum will be held alongside national elections—a long-standing demand of a hardline Islamist party—the Awami League has rolled out an expanded protest calendar. “Our struggle will continue... Nationwide protests, demonstrations, and resistance programmes on Friday and Saturday, November 14 and 15. A total nationwide shutdown on Sunday and Monday, November 16 and 17. The movement will continue until Yunus resigns,” the party declared.

The Awami League claims its lockdown in Dhaka has been “immensely successful” and says more protests across the weekend will further tighten the screws on the interim administration. In a strongly worded statement, the party described Dhaka’s current paralysis as a symbolic uprising;

“Today... the word ‘lockdown’ has returned with a new mission. It is not for public health, but for national survival. Dhaka stands still... beneath the calm lies the thunder of a nation’s heart.”

The political temperature has surged ahead of November 17, when the International Crimes Tribunal is scheduled to deliver its verdict against former Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina in absentia. Accused of crimes against humanity, Hasina has rejected the charges as politically motivated, saying her ouster was orchestrated by foreign powers backing Yunus.

The interim government, however, insists the Awami League’s protests have failed. The Chief Adviser’s Press Wing dismissed a viral video of Dhaka Metropolitan Police Commissioner Sheikh Mohammad Sajjat Ali purportedly supporting the “lockdown”, calling it AI-generated misinformation.

Security across Dhaka has been tightened, checkpoints erected, and public gatherings restricted. Police have reportedly arrested Awami League supporters for alleged sabotage and explosions as tensions continue to escalate.

## Left Alliance Warns of Crisis

The Democratic Left Alliance (LDA) has accused Chief Adviser Muhammad Yunus of driving Bangladesh into a long-term political crisis by attempting to appease the BNP, Jamaat-e-Islami and the National Citizen Party (NCP), local media reported. The criticism followed Yunus’ announcement that elections and a referendum will be held together in early 2026. The LDA, a coalition of six leftist parties, called the move “one-sided and unconstitutional”, arguing that the constitution provides no mechanism for such an order. The alliance further disputed Yunus’ claim that

broad political consensus had been achieved on constitutional reforms.



# REPORT: CHINA GIVING ‘RED EDUCATION’ IN TIBET SCHOOLS

Chinese authorities are expanding ideological and militarised programmes in Tibetan elementary schools, deepening concerns over cultural suppression, according to a new investigation by the Washington-based International Campaign for Tibet (ICT).

The report, cited by Phayul, reveals that Beijing is increasingly using the education system to instill loyalty to the Chinese Communist Party (CCP) while undermining Tibetan identity, language

and traditions. Drawing on Chinese state media and local propaganda channels, ICT found that even first-grade students are being subjected to “red education” activities designed to embed political obedience from an early age.

In one documented case from Medog County in southern Tibet, uniformed personnel including military veterans were filmed introducing primary school children to army equipment. Images showed an instructor displaying a QBZ-191 assault rifle, the standard weapon of China’s armed forces, to a group of young students. ICT said the episode reflects attempts to normalise militarisation within Tibetan childhood education.

## Storm Claudia causes disruption, flooding in England

The UK Environment Agency on Saturday warned that while weather conditions are now more settled, ongoing river flooding impacts remain likely following Storm Claudia. The recent heavy rainfall associated with Storm Claudia has led to widespread disruption, and flood risk remains in place across parts of England. Ongoing river flooding impacts are still probable throughout today, with residual minor flooding on some larger rivers expected to continue through to Tuesday, the agency stated. While the Met Office’s rain and wind warnings have now expired, there were about 58 flood warnings and 150 flood alerts - meaning flooding is possible - around Saturday noon, UK time.

## Ind supply Brahmos to Philippines

India has long sought a foothold in the global arms market and its first major export of the BrahMos system to the Philippines marks its emergence as a defence exporter of an advanced missile technology, a report said on Saturday. The move reflects India’s strategic interest in the Indo-Pacific region, strengthening defence ties with the ASEAN nations and contributing to a multipolar regional security framework designed to check China’s hegemonic ambitions in the region. “India appears to have been happy to supply the Philippines with its advanced missiles, at least in part because the likely target of those missiles will be China.”

# Four killed, six injured in explosion in Pakistan

At least four people were killed and six others injured after a massive explosion ripped through an illegal fireworks factory in Hyderabad, Sindh, on Friday, officials told.

The blast occurred at a firecracker unit operating out of a residential house near the Laghari Goth river under the Lati-fabad Police Station B Section limits, triggering a fire that quickly engulfed the structure. A duty doctor at Liaquat University Hospital confirmed that one body was brought dead

and six injured victims were admitted with moderate to severe burn wounds. Another doctor reported that two of the injured had nearly 100% burns. Medico-legal officer Dr Mohammed Hussain said two unidentified bodies were shifted to the mortuary, another charred body was taken to the burns ward. Lati-fabad Assistant Commissioner said the factory was being run illegally without licence. Hyderabad SSP Adeel Chaudhary stated that authorities were verifying licensing details and investigating the ownership of the facility.

# IAF joins France for ‘Garuda 25’ exercise

The Indian Air Force (IAF) is taking part in the 8th edition of the bilateral air exercise ‘Garuda 25’ with the French Air and Space Force (FASF) at Mont-de-Marsan, France, from November 16 to 27, the Ministry of Defence said on Saturday.

The IAF contingent, which arrived in France on November 10, is participating with Su-30MKI fighter aircraft. The C-17 Globemaster III is providing airlift support during deployment phases, while IL-78 tankers are extending range and endurance through air-to-air refuelling.

According to the Ministry, the exercise will see IAF’s Su-



30MKI jets fly alongside French multirole fighters in complex simulated combat missions, including air-to-air engagements, air defence drills and coordinated strike operations. The training aims to refine joint tactics, improve operational synergy and enhance interoperability between the two air forces in realistic battle settings. Exer-

cise Garuda 25 also facilitates professional exchanges, sharing of best practices and deeper operational understanding. The Ministry added that India’s participation reinforces its commitment to strengthening defence ties with partner nations through multilateral and bilateral engagements.
