Pharma body fixes 39 drugs' MRP; cost of rabies shot up

Biological E's pneumococcal vax gets five-year patent shield

The National Pharmaceutical Pricing Authority (NPPA) has allowed an increase in the retail price of anti-rabies immunoglobulin while fixing the retail prices of 39 drug formulations.

According to a gazette notification, the retail price of anti-rabies immunoglobulin has been raised to ₹119.48 per millilitre (ml), a 6.49 per cent increase from the earlier price of ₹112.19 per ml.

The revision follows the NPPA's announcement in March this year of a 0.65 per cent increase in the prices of drugs included in the National List of Essential Medicines, based on changes in the wholesale price index.

The retail prices fixed by the authority at its 48th meeting cover a wide range of medicines, including those used to treat hypertension, diabetes, human immunodeficiency virus, heart disease, and eye infections, to make them more affordable for patients.

Among them, the retail price of a fixed-dose combination of amlodipine, bisoprolol, and telmisartan tablets, used to

treat hypertension (high blood pressure), has been fixed at ₹14.74 per tablet.

The combination cardiology drug comprising clopidogrel, aspirin, and atorvastatin capsules has been priced at ₹6.37 per capsule. The formulation is used to reduce the risk of heart attack and stroke.

Similarly, the retail price of eye drops containing nepafenac and moxifloxacin ophthalmic solution has been fixed at ₹68.64 per ml.

The NPPA notification also said that any manufacturer or marketing company failing to comply with the notified retail prices would be required to deposit the overcharged

amount, along with applicable interest, under the relevant provisions.

The fixation and revision of ceiling and retail prices is a routine exercise undertaken by the NPPA, which is tasked with enforcing the provisions of the Drugs (Prices Control) Order (DPCO), regulating both controlled and decontrolled drug prices, and ensuring the affordability of essential medicines.

Biological E vax gets a price-cap antidote
The pharmaceutical pricing authority has granted a five-year exemption from price control to Pneubvax 14, India's first 14-valent pneumococcal

polysaccharide conjugate vaccine, manufactured by Hyderabad-based Biological E.

The NPPA granted the exemption, saying that the formulation met the requirements of Paragraphs 32(i) and 32(ii) of the DPCO, 2013, and was covered under a granted patent. Under Paragraphs 32(i) and 32(ii) of the DPCO, 2013, the provisions of the price control order do not apply for five years from the date of commencement of commercial production in India to a manufacturer producing a new drug patented under the Indian Patents Act, 1970, that is not produced elsewhere and has been developed through indigenous research and development.

The authority has asked Biological E to share the dates of commercial production and commercial marketing of the vaccine in India, along with the price to retailer and the maximum retail price fixed by the company.

It also directed the drug-maker to either comply with the notified ceiling price or seek retail price approval three months before the expiry of the exemption for the pneumococcal vaccine.

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Lava Mobiles confirms death of channel partners in Vietnam boat accident

The bodies of 15 Indian tourists who were killed in a boat accident off Vietnam's Phu Quoc Island have been sent to Ho Chi Minh City from where they will be transported to India, the Indian mission said on Sunday.

On Saturday evening, Lava Mobiles confirmed in a statement that those who died were the firm's channel partners. "We at Lava are deeply saddened to confirm that 14 of our channel partners and one member of our Lava team have tragically lost their lives in a boat accident earlier today near Phu Quoc Island, Vietnam," it said in a post on X.

Lava International Managing Director Sunil Raina said the firm was working closely with the Embassy of India in Vietnam, the local authorities, and its teams on

the ground to provide support to those affected.

The Indian Embassy in Hanoi said that 16 of the 17 rescued Indian tourists were on their way back home. One, who was in critical condition, was hospitalised in Phu Quoc.

The 15 were killed when a speedboat carrying 32 tourists from India and four local crew members capsized near Hon Rut Ngaoi off Phu Quoc Island on Saturday. All others were rescued.

"After completion of formalities at Ho Chi Minh the mortal remains would be transported to India at the earliest," the embassy said in a post on X.

The embassy further said its teams were closely coordinating with the Vietnamese authorities, who have assured all assistance for the earliest transportation of the mortal remains to India.

Of the 15 victims, 10 were from Tamil Nadu, three from Andhra Pradesh and two were from Kerala. Two of the deceased were women, according to a list shared by the embassy.

The tourists were reportedly returning from an island visit. The exact cause of the incident is yet to be ascertained.

When Manmohan Singh told then-CEC Quraishi 'I will commit suicide'

"I will commit suicide," then prime minister Manmohan Singh had told Chief Election Commissioner SY Quraishi in 2012 after the poll watchdog chief conveyed his anguish over "loose talk" by ministers on the Election Commission functioning.

Singh had also told Quraishi that the Election Commission is not just India's pride; it is the soul of the country's democracy and "if we lose that, we lose everything".

The conversation is recalled in Quraishi's forthcoming book *India and I: A Hundred Memories, Not a Memoir*. In his book, Quraishi hails Singh as a leader for whom constitutional propriety was not a talking point but a lived conviction.

The former CEC recalls that during an election, in January 2012, in Uttar Pradesh, Salman Khurshid, then Law Minister, promised at a rally that if his party came to power, it would raise the quota for Muslims in jobs from 4.5 per cent to 9 per cent. "The BJP promptly complained of a Model Code violation, which stipulated that no

new scheme could be announced after the election process is set in motion and MCC, Model Code of Conduct, kicked in," Quraishi reminisced in his book published by Hachette India that is set to hit the stands soon.

"We held hearings for four days. Abhishek Manu Singhvi led the Congress side, Arun Jaitley the BJP, two formidable minds sparring over where a campaign promise ended and an inducement began. Eventually, we censured Khurshid, the strongest attack available under the Code," recalls Quraishi, who was the CEC from July 30, 2010 till June 10, 2012.

Isro tests Gaganyaan crew module systems

The Indian Space Research Organisation (Isro) on Sunday said it had successfully carried out three major tests of the Gaganyaan crew module systems.

The first test pertained to ensuring an upright position for the crew module after splashdown in the sea, considered one of the most important crew safety requirements. To this, a stored cold-gas-based uprighting system was developed and tested. "A system-level qualification test setup consisting of all the elements of CMUS (crew module uprighting system) was realised and successfully conducted inflation tests for the primary inflation module wherein stored gas in the high-pressure gas bottle was made to inflate the floatation by operating the control valves," the Isro said.

The second test involved examining the separation of the umbilical mechanism that serves as a link between the crew module, where astronauts live, and the service module, which provides power and propulsion.

The third test validated the structural integrity of the crew module during the apex cover separation event. P11

Over 273,000 candidates register for DU UG admissions

Over 273,000 aspirants have registered for undergraduate admissions at the University of Delhi for the 2026-27 academic session, officials said on Sunday.

University officials said 2,73,751 candidates signed up on the Common Seat Allocation System (CSAS) portal, of whom 2,18,284 completed their registrations. Of those who completed registration, 97,775 are male candidates and

1,20,509 are female candidates, according to university data.

The top 10 preferred programmes included BCom (Hons), BCom, BA (Hons) English, BA (Hons) Political Science, BA Programme (History and Political Science), BA (Hons) History, BSc (Hons) in Zoology, Mathematics, BSc programme Life Science and BA (Hons) Economics, they said.

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
