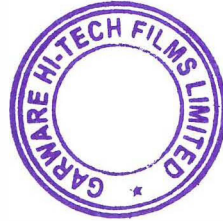

Centre Scraps 14 BIS Quality Control Orders

Move to ease imports for key sectors like textiles, chemicals & plastics, cut raw material costs

Relief for Key Sectors

What Was Removed?

14 BIS Quality Control Orders (QCOs)

Pune: The Centre has withdrawn 14 BIS quality control orders (QCOs) covering key chemical, polymer and fibre-based materials, which are used to make finished goods such as garments, fertilisers and several chemicals, simplifying the process of their imports and making them cheaper.

The QCOs, which are compulsory certifications given by the Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS), increased compliance costs for small businesses, leading to higher prices for consumers and reduced competitiveness, especially for MSMEs and export-oriented industries.

The rescinding of QCOs indicates a major shift towards industry liberalisation and reduced regulatory burden in a major relief to the chemical, plastics and textile sectors. Globally, about 70% of the garments are made using synthetic fibre, and Indian exporters were unable to compete as they were forced to buy expensive domestically produced polyester fibre and yarn.

The chemicals and fertilisers ministry removed the QCOs on Wednesday, a move that would make the Chinese polyester fibre available to Indian garment and fabric manufacturers at 20-25% lower rates than the domestic polyester, said industry executives. The move will ensure raw material availability, ease import constraints and lower input costs for downstream MSMEs in the packaging, textile and moulding sectors.

"The decision of rescinding QCO on polyester fibre and yarn is a big move to make India competitive in man-made fibre, which has 70% market share. With the already bagged FTAs (free trade agreements) and Europe negotiations on fast track, India looks set to become a global leader in apparel and textiles," said Sanjay Jain, former chairman of the Confederation of Indian Textile Industry.

The Southern India Mills' Association said the initiative will help prevent the closure of many power loom units that are on the verge of becoming non-performing assets due to non-availability and shortage of required fibres at competitive prices.

Its chairman, Durai Palanisamy, said, "Many domestic manufacturers of comfort wear and technical textile products had been struggling to procure fibres at globally competitive rates, resulting in a loss of market share built over decades.

ED Arrests Jaypee Infratech's Former CMD Manoj Gaur

ED says funds meant for housing projects were siphoned off to related Jaypee firms and trusts

New Delhi: The Enforcement Directorate (ED) Thursday arrested Manoj Gaur, former executive chairman and chief executive officer of Jaiprakash Associates (JAL) and former

CMD of Jaypee Infratech (JIL) for his alleged involvement in a money laundering case linked to alleged fraud with homebuyers.

In a statement issued Thursday, the agency said that Gaur was taken into custody, following a detailed investigation and analysis of evidence gathered by the Economic Offences



Wings (EOW) of Delhi and UP Police,

based on complaints filed by homebuyers of Jaypee Wishtown and Jaypee Greens projects, alleging criminal conspiracy, cheating, and criminal breach of trust against the company and its promoters.

It has been alleged that the funds collected from thousands of homebuyers for construction and completion of residential projects were diverted for purposes other than construction, leaving the homebuyers defrauded and

their projects incomplete.

ED said that ED's "investigation revealed that out of approximately ₹14,599 Crore collected by JAL and JIL from homebuyers (as per claims admitted by NCLT), substantial amounts were diverted for non-construction purposes and siphoned off to related group entities and trusts, including Jaypee Sewa Sansthan (JSS), Jaypee Healthcare (JHL), and Jaypee Sports International (JSIL)".

मुंब्रा रेल्वे दुर्घटनेप्रकरणी सदोष मनुष्यवधाचा गुन्हा दाखल झाल्यानंतर अटक टाळण्यासाठी सत्र न्यायालयात धाव घेणाऱ्या रेल्वेच्या दोन्ही इंजिनीअरचे अटकपूर्व जामीन अर्ज न्यायालयाने गुरुवारी फेटाळले. आदेशाची प्रत मिळाल्यानंतर पुन्हा अटकपूर्व जामिनासाठी मुंबई उच्च न्यायालयात अर्ज दाखल करणार

असल्याचे त्यांच्या वकिलांनी सांगितले. मुंब्रा स्थानकाजवळील वळगावर ९ जून रोजी दोन लोकलमधून पडून पाच प्रवाशांचा मृत्यू तर, आठ प्रवासी जखमी झाले होते. व्हीजेटीआयचा अहवाल आणि रेल्वे पोलिसांच्या चौकशीनंतर ही दुर्घटना रेल्वे अधिकाऱ्यांच्या हलगर्जीमुळे झाल्याचे उघड झाले. त्यामुळे पाच महिन्यांनंतर रेल्वे पोलिसांच्या तक्रारीनंतर रेल्वेचे

सीनिअर सेक्शन इंजिनीअर समर यादव, असिस्टंट डिप्टी जनरल इंजिनीअर विशाल डोळस यांच्यासह रेल्वेचे इतर अधिकारी, कर्मचाऱ्यांविरुद्ध १ नोव्हेंबर रोजी ठाणे रेल्वे पोलिस ठाण्यात सदोष मनुष्यवधाचा गुन्हा दाखल करण्यात आला होता. त्यानंतर यादव आणि डोळस यांनी ठाणे न्यायालयात अटकपूर्व जामीन मिळण्यासाठी अर्ज केला.

सुनावणीवेळी इंजिनीअरच्या वकिलांनी अतिगर्दीमुळे ही दुर्घटना घडल्याचा दावा करत रेल्वे प्रशासन तथा इंजिनीअरची चूक नसल्याचे म्हटले होते. न्यायाधीश गणेश पवार यांनी जामीन अर्जावरील निर्णय राखून ठेवला होता. न्यायालयाने गुरुवारी निर्णय देत दोन्ही इंजिनीअरचे अटकपूर्व जामीन अर्ज फेटाळून लावले. यामुळे या दोघांना कोणत्याही क्षणी अटक होण्याची शक्यता आहे.
