7. The net worth of the Company got eroded during the last few years. The Company's current liabilities are higher than its current assets. However, the Company has settled the dues of ten secured original lenders (including Canara Bank). Consequently, upon filing of a Memorandum seeking withdrawal of the petition filed by Canara Bank before the Hon'ble NCLT, Mumbai, the NCLT vide its order dated July 29, 2025, has dismissed the petition as withdrawn. The DRT vide its orders dated May 1, 2025 and October 14, 2025 has allowed withdrawal of applications filed by all the ten secured original lenders. The Company is now awaiting the OTS sanctions from the rest of the lenders.

The Company has also entered into Upside Sharing Agreement with eligible lenders for sharing 75% of the net recovery amount of Arbitration Proceedings, amongst the lenders in the agreed proportion. Pending the outcome of the Arbitration proceedings, the Company is continuing its efforts to arrive at a settlement in respect of Arbitration matters as well.

Accordingly, the Management is of the view that it would be in a position to revive the Company and continue its operations. Hence it continues to prepare its financial results on a going concern basis

8. The Company has neither paid nor provided interest on its borrowings during the period ended September 30, 2025 in view of the foregoing as explained.

Had such interest been recognized, the finance cost for the quarter and period ended September 30, 2025 would have been more by ₹ 9,340.81 lakhs and ₹ 18,658.03 lakhs respectively. The resultant profit / (loss) would have been ₹ (13,243.79) lakhs and ₹ (20,982.14) lakhs and the EPS would have been ₹ (8.45) ₹ (13.38) for the quarter and period ended September 30, 2025 respectively. The auditors have issued modified opinion in respect of this matter.

- 9. Exceptional items of ₹ 95.55 lakhs is net amount which comprises of:
 - (a) An amount of ₹ 15,843.86 lakhs, towards remission of principal and waiver of interest of fully settled secured lenders;
 - (b) An amount of ₹ 2,151.69 lakhs representing one time revenue; and
 - (c) A claim of ₹ 17,900.00 lakhs, arising on invocation of pledge on the shares held by the promoter company earlier considered under Contingent Liabilities now crystallized.

10. The figures for the previous quarter / period / year have been regrouped / rearranged / recast wherever considered necessary.

Limited Review Report

Review Report to,

1. We have reviewed the accompanying statement of unaudited financial results of **GTL LIMITED** ("the Company") for the quarter and period ended September 30, 2025 (the "statement"), being submitted by the company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 33 of the Securities Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulation, 2015, as amended ("Listing Regulations").

This Statement, which is the responsibility of the Company's Management and approved by the company's Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" ("Ind AS 34"), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (the "Listing Regulations"). Our responsibility is to issue a report on the Statement based on our review.

We Conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagement (SRE) 2410, "Review of Interim Financial Information performed by the independent Auditor of the Entity" issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI). This standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement. A review of Interim Financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of the Company's personnel responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Standards on Auditing specified under section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013 and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. We have not performed an audit and accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

2. Basis for Modified Conclusion

As mentioned in Note No. 8 to the Statement, the Company has neither paid nor provided interest on its borrowings during the quarter ended September 30, 2025. Had such interest been recognised, the finance cost and interest liability for the quarter ended September 30, 2025 would have been more by Rs. 9,340.81 Lakh.

Consequently, the reported Loss after Other Comprehensive Income by the Company for the quarter ended September 30, 2025 would have been a loss of Rs. 13,243.79 Lakh. The Earnings per Share (EPS) would have been negative Rs. 8.45

3. Modified Conclusion

Based on our review conducted as above, except for the effect of the matters described in the basis for modified conclusion paragraph above, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying statement of unaudited financial results prepared in accordance with applicable accounting standards and other recognised accounting practices and policies, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.

4. Material Uncertainty relating to Going Concern

We draw attention to the following note to the accompanying statement:

Note no. 7 which inter-alia states that, the Company's net worth has been eroded during the last few years and its current liabilities are higher than the current assets as at September 30, 2025. The above condition indicates the existence of material uncertainty that casts significant doubt about the company's ability to continue as a going concern. However, the financial results of the company have been prepared on going concern basis for the reasons stated in the said note.

Our opinion is not modified in respect of the above matter.

5. Emphasis of Matter

We draw attention to the following note to the accompanying statement:

Note No. 9 which inter-alia states that, exceptional items of $\stackrel{?}{\sim}$ 95.55 lakhs is net amount which comprises of:

- (a) An amount of ₹ 15,843.86 lakh, towards remission of principal and waiver of interest of fully settled secured lenders;
- (b) An amount of ₹ 2,151.69 lakh representing one time revenue; and
- (c) A claim of ₹ 17,900.00 lakh, arising on invocation of pledge on the shares held by the promoter company earlier considered under Contingent Liabilities now crystalized.

Our conclusion is not modified in respect of above matter.

6. Other matters

As at September 30, 2025, balance Confirmations, with respect to Bank Loan including interest accrued and Balance in Escrow Account, Bank Guarantee, Bank Current Accounts and Fixed Deposits aggregating to Rs. 3,28,222.13 Lakh have not been received.

Our conclusion is not modified in respect of above matter.
