Gurunanak Agriculture Secures Gujarat Subsidy Listing and Commences West Bengal Harvester Deliveries Ahead of a Favourable Harvest Season

Raipur, 17 August 2026

Gurunanak Agriculture India Limited (GAIL), a leading manufacturer of harvesters, threshers, and other agricultural equipment, is pleased to share the below announcements:

Gujarat: Harvesters and Threshers Approved for Subsidy Eligibility on iKhedut

Our harvesters and threshers have been approved for subsidy eligibility on **iKhedut**, the Government of Gujarat's official agricultural subsidy portal. Under the scheme, farmers purchasing approved farm machinery receive a substantial subsidy on each unit, materially reducing the effective cost of ownership.

The approval opens an important new addressable market for Gurunanak Agriculture. iKhedut is the single-window platform through which Gujarat farmers apply for state and central agricultural subsidies, and inclusion on the approved-machinery list positions the Company's products directly in front of a large registered farmer base. Management believes subsidy-backed pricing will be a meaningful demand driver in the state.

West Bengal: Harvester Deliveries Commence with a New Dealer

Deliveries of TCH harvesters have commenced in West Bengal to, marking the Company's expanded presence in the eastern market. The onboarding strengthens Gurunanak Agriculture's distribution reach in a state where mechanisation of harvesting operations continues to gain adoption.

Following a favourable monsoon across the region, the Company is also confident of achieving strong thresher deliveries in West Bengal this season. Adequate rainfall typically supports both crop output and farmer purchasing capacity, which in turn underpins demand for post-harvest equipment.

Chhattisgarh and Odisha: Deliveries to Follow the Harvest Cycle

India's harvesting cycle progresses from east to west, and the Company plans its dispatches accordingly. Deliveries in Chhattisgarh and Odisha are expected to commence in approximately 15 days, following the completion of the current phase in the eastern belt.

While the season had earlier been approached with caution given El Niño-related concerns, the monsoon has since been favourable.

Product Development: Tyre-Type Harvester Targeted for Launch from October 2026

We are preparing to introduce a tyre-type harvester, with the launch targeted for March/April 2027. Research and development, along with product testing, is currently in progress and is expected to be completed by October/November this year.

The commercial launch timeline remains subject to the completion of CMVR and RTO certification. The addition of a tyre-type variant is intended to broaden the Company's harvester portfolio alongside its existing range, addressing field conditions and customer preferences that favour wheeled machines.

Management Commentary

“This season has opened on an encouraging note. Subsidy approval on the iKhedut portal gives our harvesters and threshers direct access to Gujarat's farmers on far more affordable terms, and our first deliveries in West Bengal through a new dealer reflect the steady widening of our distribution network. A favourable monsoon has improved sentiment across our core markets, and with the tyre-type harvester moving through certification, we are building the product depth to serve a broader set of farmers.”
