CJI made the remark while hearing a bunch of PILs challenging the SIR of electoral rolls in Bihar and at a pan-India level. CJI Kant said some cases go for days with unending arguments from (renowned senior) advocates and poor litigants who come to court on the scheduled date of hearing of their cases have to go back home disappointed as the cases are not taken up due to time constraints.

The step will redress the long-held lament that the "rich, power-

ful and influential" get ahead of other litigants by engaging high-profile lawyers and can hurt the "stars" among the legal fraternity who argue for hours, pushing others further down "you are in the queue" list.

This compensation is in addition to the commitment under the existing govt guidelines, as per which, IndiGo will provide a refund of up to ₹5,000 to its 10,000 depending on the block time of the flight, to those customers whose flights were cancelled within 24 hours of departure time, the airline said.

The announcement came as aviation watchdog DGCA

stepped up scrutiny of IndiGo's officials, also looking themselves at the carrier's head quarters to monitor operations, and CEO Pieter Elbers was questioned by an inquiry panel.

The civil aviation ministry has already directed the airline,

which generally operates around 2,500 flights, to enforce its winter schedule by 10%. IndiGo CEO Elbers, who appeared before the DGCA constituted inquiry panel, has been asked to provide a detailed report on why aircraft delays deep into the factors that led to massive flight disruptions, resulting in hundreds of flight cancellations, impacting thousands of passengers.

The four-member panel comprises joint director general Sanjay Brahman, deputy di-

rector general Amit Gupta, senior flight operations inspector Kapil Manglik, and POI Lokesh Rampa, with a mandate to identify the root causes of wide-spread operational disruptions at the leading domestic carrier. The committee's mandate includes assessing manpower planning, fluctuating rostering systems, and the airline's preparedness to implement the latest duty period and rest norms for pilots, which came into effect from Nov 1 this year.

A team has been sent to Phuket to coordinate the deportation, sources said. The brothers have turned 'wanted' after fleeing the country following last week's blaze at their club in Goa that claimed 25 lives. They had fled to Phuket, Thailand and were staying at a hotel. Go police had requested Interpol, through MEA and CBI for their apprehension. A blue corner notice was subsequently issued against

them by Interpol. The regional passport office in Delhi had issued a notice to the brothers seeking an explanation from both as to why action should not be initiated to impound their passports within seven days. Their passports were subsequently declared invalid, easing the apprehension of Indian request for their detention.

According to Goa police, the brothers purchased seats on a Phuket-bound flight at 1:17 am on Dec 7, even as firefighting opera-

tions were under way. By 5:30 am, they were airborne on IndiGo flight 6E-1073. By morning, a Goa police team had reached Delhi with an arrest warrant for the Luthra brothers and searched their residential and office premises, but they were not found. "Since they were unavailable, a notice for their apprehension was issued through the appropriate authorities of law was posted at their residence. By the evening of Dec 7, a lookout circular was issued against both by the Bureau of Immigration at the request of Goa

police," a police officer said. The blaze broke out around 11:45 pm Saturday (Dec 6) during an event attended by more than 150 tourists. A preliminary investigation by Goa police and Directorate of Fire Services found it was triggered when electric fire-crackers struck the wooden ceiling, causing flames to spread through the roof, guests and performers bolted. While most of them were able to step out of the club, many were trapped in the basement after the exit caught fire.

Arunachal accident kills 19, survivor reports after 2 days

Gurwahati: A possibly lone survivor among 22 people on board a truck that plunged into a gorge in a remote location of Arunachal Pradesh Monday night clambered out of the wreckage, clinging to a tree trunk and nearly died to reach a BRO camp late Wednesday to report the tragedy almost 48 hours later.

The victims - 19 bodies had been retrieved until Thursday evening - were all labourers from Assam being ferried to a site in Anjaw district, bordering China, when the accident occurred along Hailujiang-Chaglangang Road. Army teams continue to search for the other two survivors.

It wasn't immediately clear if the critically injured survivor included the truck driver among the 22 that he said were involved in the crash, officials said. He has been shifted to Assam Medical College and Hospital in Dibrugarh, around 300 km from Hailujiang.

Nang Chingni Choupo, in charge of the Anjaw district disaster management department, told TOI that Army teams used ropes to descend into the deep gorge and trace the wreckage. The 19 bodies found so far are still to be brought up. "Since the Army personnel do not have specialised equipment

to carry the bodies, an NDRF team from Dibrugarh is being sent there with the required equipment. The outbreak of the tragedy Friday morning, Choupo said. "For now, we are assuming there were 22 people, unless the driver wasn't counted. The mangled truck lies upside down and rescuers need to cut through the metal to determine if anyone is trapped inside."

The Assam govt has deputed a joint team of the Tinsukia civil and police administration to travel to the area and coordinate with Army and Arunachal Pradesh officials. The nearest camp, which the injured survivor reached, belongs to the General Reserve Engineer Force under which BRO operates.

Won't let long arguments eat into poor litigants' time: CJI

New Delhi: Chief Justice of India Surya Kant on Thursday announced enforcement of a new time distribution regime to equitably allocate judicial time for poor litigants.

"From January there will be a time limit for each advocate to conclude his/her arguments. What is happening is absolutely unfair and unjustified. A poor litigant, who comes to the court for a motor accident claims case or for bail because the court disapproved his case, has to wait because of these unending arguments from other advocates," the CJI said.

It took even the death of her husband to make her file a case, which she did not have a bank account, which was opened and the money was deposited," he said.
