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Hitachi inaugurates its re-constructed manufacturing facility at Kadi (Gujarat)

- ❖ Hitachi rebuilds the entire plant of 35000 Sqmtr. in record 165 days.
- ❖ Company will manufacture domestic and commercial air-conditioners under one roof which is Unique in the industry.

Ahmedabad, January 13, 2013: Hitachi Home & Life Solutions (India) Ltd (HHLI), a subsidiary of Hitachi Appliances, Inc. Japan, inaugurated its re-constructed air-conditioner manufacturing unit 2 at Kadi (Gujarat) near Ahmedabad. The Chief Minister of Gujarat, Mr. Narendra Modi, inaugurated the plant today. This plant was entirely gutted in a major fire incident happened on 18th July 2012. This manufacturing facility is unit 2 of company's plant at Kadi, 40 km. from Ahmedabad.

This facility is spread on a plot of 85000 Sq. Mtr. with approximately 35000 Sq. Mtr. of Industrial shed, re-built in a record time of only five & half months. The plant has the capacity to produce 600000 units (230000 units in single shift) per year. We shall be manufacturing window & split air-conditioners, Ductable air-conditioners, Water Cooled Chillers, Set Free (Front Flow) and Spacemaker (Telecom Tower AC).

Mr. Haruki Yamamoto (President and CEO, Hitachi Appliances, Inc. Japan) was present at the occasion.

Mr. Motoo Morimoto (Managing Director, HHLI) said we are focusing on Inverter technology for energy saving therefore new line will include split AC with Tropical inverter technology & Green refrigerant (i-Clean Inverter). We are increasing our focus on B2B product range and will introduce Chillers with green refrigerant, for the first time in India we are introducing installation friendly Side throw and Top throw VRF systems. We are aiming at least 10% growth over last year."
