- 2) The above standalone audited financial results for the Half year ended and year ended March 31, 2026 have been prepared by the Company were reviewed and recommended by the Audit Committee of the Board and thereafter were approved and taken on record by the Board of Directors in their meeting held on May 11th, 2026, Above results has been audited by the statutory auditors of the company.
- 3) The company has incorporated a subsidiary on January 21, 2025 in the name of HOAC Foods India Limited with 75% of share holding in the same company.
- 4) These financial results have been prepared in accordance with Accounting Standards (AS) prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued there under and in terms of the Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligation and Disclosures Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (the 'Listing Regulations'), as modified by Circular dated July 5, 2016
- 5) The company has received intimation from suppliers regarding their status under Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act 2006 and disclosures relating to the amount unpaid as at year end, as required under the said Act, have been provided. The Company has provided the interest on outstanding from supplier under Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises as on 31-03-2026.
- 6) The comparative results for the half-year ended and year ended March 31, 2026 have been audited by the statutory auditors of the Company
- 7) As the Company's business activity falls within a single primary business segment, the disclosure requirements as per AS 17 "Segment Reporting" are not applicable.
- 8) The figures for the half-year ended March 31st, 2026 are balancing figures between audited figures in respect of the full financial year ended March 31st, 2026 and the unaudited half-year ended September 30th 2025.

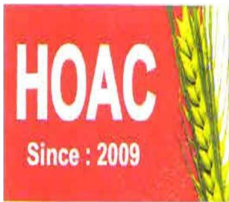
