Dog bites woman for 2nd time in 4 months, owner booked

THE OWNER of a German Shepherd was booked for negligence by the Ahmedabad City Police on Saturday after her pet dog allegedly bit a 54-year-old neighbour in the Ramol area of the city.

An FIR was registered on the basis of a complaint by 54-year-old Kapila Maheshwari Pranjapati, a resident of Vastral. In the FIR, she said that the incident occurred around 5:30 pm on September 4 when she was sweeping her front yard. When she stepped out of her house, the front door of her neighbour Dharmishtha Dinesh Pranjapati was open and her dog, a German Shepherd, bit her on her right hand. Pranjapati's daughter immediately called an ambulance and took her to the nearby Community Health Centre (CHC), Kapila alleged in the FIR that the same dog had bitten her on her right hand and left hand about four months ago.

Dharmishtha Dinesh Pranjapati was booked under BNS sections 29 (negligence towards animals) and 125(a) (negligence that endangers the life or personal safety of others).

Following the incident, officials of the Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation (AMC), along with a veterinary officer and the Ramol Police, conducted an inspection.

In a statement on Saturday, the AMC said, "The pet dog 'Rani' has been vaccinated and the certificate is valid till September 30, 2026. The dog was immediately taken into custody by the CNCD department and shifted to the Dog Welfare Center at Danilimda."

Speaking to The Indian Express, Naresh Rajput, Head of the CNCD, said that about four to five dogs had been seized and impounded by the AMC since the new regulations of dog registration came into force in December 2024. FIRs had been filed in all the cases of dog attacks, he said.

"These dogs are placed in special hostels and the owners are supposed to pay for the same. They are kept there for at least a month and when the animal is released, we take an affidavit from the owner assuring that the dog will not be taken to the same place where the attack took place," said Rajput.

Between January 1, 2025, and August 31, 2026, a total of 17,467 pet owners had registered 19,839 dogs in Ahmedabad. The most popular breeds include Labrador (3,589), German Shepherd (1,527), Staff (1,497), Golden Retriever (1,416), Pomeranian (1,138), Beagle (571) and Siberian Husky (476).

Email to High Court threatens explosion at 'Ahmedabad court'; bomb squad deployed

THE GUJARAT High Court on Saturday received an email threatening explosion at an Ahmedabad court.

This led to the immediate deployment of police at all major courts, including the HC on SG Highway, the Metropolitan Court in Gheekanta and the Sessions Court in Lal Darwaza.

The threat was received by the Registrar of the Gujarat HC on Saturday morning and forwarded to the Ahmedabad City Police, which responded by sending Bomb Detection and Disposal Squads (BDDS).

ALLEGATIONS OF RAGING, THREATS AT BARODA MEDICAL COLLEGE

After 18 junior doctors complain, associate professor transferred

Action amid concern over raging in state medical colleges

WHAT BEGAN as a surprise inspection of Vadodra's largest government hospital turned into an extraordinary closed-door hearing where nearly 18 resident doctors approached Gujarat Health Minister Pratul Pansheriya with allegations against a senior faculty member.

The complaints ranged from raging and mental harassment to inappropriate messages and threats linked to their academic careers. Within hours, the professor named in the complaints was transferred out of Vadodra.

The incident occurred at SSG Hospital and Baroda Medical College, where 18 resident doctors from the psychiatry de-

partment submitted a written complaint against Dr Chirag Barot, an associate professor, alleging physical and mental harassment. Chirag Barot, Dr Dhara Barot, spoke to the media and denied the allegations.

The allegations were heard against the backdrop of heightened concern over raging in Gujarat's medical colleges following the death by suicide of a postgraduate medical student in Surat less than a month ago.

As per a government release, Chirag was accused of raging, sending inappropriate messages, and making demands of doctors even after working hours.

Women resident doctors alleged he made "inappropriate comments" about the physical appearance and clothing of women and used obscene gestures. The resident doctors also alleged that they were threatened with consequences affecting their academic careers, including their theses and examinations.

The matter had earlier been raised before the psychiatry department's anti-raging committee, following which the committee has already written a report to the health ministry, prompting Pansheriya's visit on Thursday, sources said.

Wife cites ongoing probe, denies allegations

Addressing the media in Vadodra, Dhara, a clinical psychologist, said, "There is an ongoing inquiry into the complaints filed by the students. A committee has already been formed. We don't know the motive behind the allegations," she added.

She denied the allegations against her husband. "The students who have been alleging that he called them home for meals and was involved in raging came to our home on multiple occasions—in the presence of my son and I. I have cooked meals for them myself. We never imagined that being nice would turn into a nightmare... We don't know the motive behind the allegations," she added.

Zero tolerance to raging: Minister

During his visit, Pansheriya reportedly asked senior officials, including the hospital superintendent, to leave the hall before meeting with the resident doctors in a closed-door meeting for about an hour. The doctors placed their complaints and supporting material directly before him.

The interaction was fol-

lowed by swift administrative action. The Health and Family Welfare Department transferred the faculty member from Government Medical College, Vadodra, to Government Medical College, Bhavnagar, with immediate effect through an internal department communication issued on Friday.

In a statement, Pansheriya said the government "would not compromise on the safety, dignity and mental well-being of students and doctors." The state, he said, had adopted a "zero tolerance" approach towards raging, physical or mental harassment, and misconduct in medical educational institutions.

"The complaints and material placed by the resident doctors have been taken seriously and immediate action has been deemed necessary. Such indulgence or harassment will not be tolerated in any medical educational institution in Gujarat and that strict action would be taken in future cases as well," he added.
