IMD warns of heat wave in state till April 30

AHMEDABAD RECORDED the highest maximum temperature in the state as heat wave conditions prevailed Monday. Meanwhile, the India Meteorological Department (IMD) has warned against heat wave conditions across the state till April 30.

On Monday, severe heat wave conditions prevailed in isolated pockets of Saurashtra districts, including Gir Somnath, and Junagadh.

Governor calls on farmers to 'liberate' India from chemical fertilisers, adopt natural farming

Addressing a national workshop on Innovative Agriculture, Gujarat Governor Acharya Devvrat called upon the farmers to adopt natural farming and to "liberate the country from chemical bound agriculture through the mass movement of natural farming, just as the country was liberated from British slavery."

The Governor also said that due to chemical agriculture, India is carrying the financial burden of Rs. 1.60 lakh crore to subsidise fertilisers for farmers. He added that in natural farming, the use of cow dung, cow urine, gram flour, jaggery and jivamrut-ghanjivamrut made from soil "can save the cost incurred in using chemical fertilisers."

"The Governor said that the resolution taken by the Prime Minister Narendra Modi to double the income of the farmers would come true only when the farmers across the country would abandon chemical agriculture and adopt natural farming with full vigour," the release added.

Jardosh chairs meeting for better state-Centre coordination in railway projects

FOR SMOOTH coordination between the state government and central government on railways related projects, Union Minister of State for Railways Darshana Jardosh Monday held a high-level meeting in Gandhinagar under the chairmanship of Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel, said an official release.

The Union minister thanked Patel for the fact that 98.7% land acquisition work in Gujarat for the Ahmedabad-Mumbai High Speed Rail has been completed with active cooperation of the Revenue department.

As per the release, considering that Gujarat gets the benefit of both central and state governments, Jardosh expressed expectation that important railway projects in the state will be completed on time.

"Chief Minister Shri Bhupendra Patel told the officials present in the meeting that such an atmosphere should be created where the pending issues related to railways between the state and the Centre could be resolved through mutual understanding and discussion," the release said.

"In this regard, he (the CM) directed the Chief Secretary, Pankaj Kumar to set up an institutionalised system for various issues including dedicated freight corridor, state-central partnership in railway overbridge and to carry out a review meeting after one month to resolve the questions that come up," it added.

The meeting was attended by the concerned ministers and top officials of Gujarat's revenue department, urban development department and roads and buildings department.

Officials of the Union Ministry of Railways, Western Railway High Speed Rail Corporation and Dedicated Freight Corridor were also present in the meeting.

The highest maximum temperature of 42.1 degrees Celsius was recorded at Ahmedabad. On Tuesday, too, the city is likely to experience a maximum temperature of 42 degrees Celsius.

Other centres with temperatures above 40 degrees were Amreli at 42, Surendranagar at 41.8, Kandla Airport 41.3, Gandhinagar 41.2, Keshod 41.1, Rajkot and Vadodara 41, Bhuj 40.7, Deesa 40.5 and Surat 40.4 degrees Celsius.

"Heat wave conditions are very likely to prevail at isolated pockets in the district of South Gujarat region namely Valsad; in the districts of Saurashtra namely Porbandar, Gir Somnath, Junagadh and Kutch," the IMD cautioned for April 26 and 27.

This would be extended to northern districts of Banaskantha and Sabarkantha, along with Rajkot and Kutch, from April 28.
