Chodankar's comeback sparks fresh crisis in Cong

Resignations Pile Up After Change In Guard

Margao: Girish Chodankar was brought back as Goa Pradesh Congress Committee (GPCC) president to steady the ship — and soon found himself in a storm he didn't see coming. Hours after his appointment, resignation letters started piling up from party functionaries upset over the change of guard.

For a party that can ill afford any more self-inflicted damage with the 2027 assembly elections closing in, the optics could not be worse.

When Amit Patkar was elevated to GPCC president in March 2022 — picked, as political analyst Prabhakar Timble put it, from "nowhere", a man whose only party credential at that point was having been a candidate — Congress was at its nadir after a disastrous assembly election. The appointment was a gamble.

Patkar's commitment to the party was never in question. Political analyst Cleofa Coutinho acknowledges that despite all the internal bickering, Patkar "kept working till the very end, as though nothing was amiss".

But Coutinho adds, "Congress failed to capitalise on the resentment against govt," ticking off a list of squandered opportunities: the cash-for-jobs scandal, cholera deaths, the Arpora night club tragedy that claimed 25 lives, civic failures of Panaji. "These were issues the opposition should have gone to town on. But hardly any mobilisation happened," he says.

Timble's observation lays bare the fault line between the Congress organisation and its legislature wing. He says Congress's own social media handles gave almost no space to its legislators over the past year. Assembly debates, positions taken by the leader of the opposition — none of it found its way onto the party's social media platforms. The deeper cause of this dysfunction, analysts suggest, was a near-total breakdown between the party organisation and its legislature wing. "From the time of the zilla panchayat elections, communication between the legislature party and the party functionaries had effectively collapsed," Coutinho said.

While party insiders said the change at the helm was being talked about in the inner circles of the party for long, South Goa MP Viriato Fernandes, who has been assigned to head the campaign committee in the reconstituted GPCC, told TOI he was caught completely off-guard

by the change. "The manner in which this was done was not right," he said. "I was the only one from the newly constituted GPCC who was not taken into confidence. My question to the party is simple: Do you consider me a suspect? I have toiled alongside the party of it found its way onto the party's social media platforms. Rocking the boat at this point has caused damage. For me, my state comes first, politics is secondary," he said. He called on the party to act swiftly to contain the fallout.

Many of the former senior functionaries have crossed over to the enemy camp. With that pool drained, the high command turned to a trusted, battle-tested loyalist. "Nobody would imagine that Girish will ever leave Congress — not even if the whole world did," Timble said. "Loyalty is his first credential. The second is his direct line to the high command. That rapport matters — it opens doors, both for human resources and capital resources."

His Tamil Nadu assignment — where, as All India Congress Committee in-charge, he helped negotiate Congress's entry into the TVK-led govt — has also burnished his credentials as someone who can navigate alliances, an essential skill for the opposition heading into 2027.

Underpinning all of this, Timble adds, the high command was not convinced Patkar was not convinced the electoral fight that the 2027 elections demand. His ability to strike alliances, too, had come under a cloud.

However, analysts concur that Chodankar inherits the same intra-party fissures that his predecessor had to put up with.

"The gap between the legislative wing and the party may have narrowed," Coutinho acknowledged. "But a new tension — between the old Patkar camp, Viriato's circle, and the party — is already taking shape."

However with the 2027 state assembly polls closing in, it leaves no room for a prolonged standoff.

"Girish has to organise his party and cadre to be ready when the anti-incumbency tide turns in their favour," Timble said. "The fish is there. You have to be ready with the net."

Meteorologist and National Institute of Oceanography (NIO) Goa, retired chief scientist M Ramesh Kumar said that while the northern limit of the monsoon has reached parts of Goa, the state has not yet witnessed the synoptic conditions necessary for a formal declaration of monsoon onset. "Synoptic conditions such as rainfall, upper-level winds and convection have not set in over the west coast of India, particularly over Goa," he said.

According to the weather criteria, three conditions must be fulfilled before monsoon onset can be declared. These include widespread rainfall, strong westerly winds extending from the surface up to about 5km in altitude with speeds of at least 6m per second, and the presence of deep atmospheric convection.

"All three criteria have not yet been met," Kumar said. "When we talk about the monsoon, it is essentially the establishment of strong southwesterly or westerly winds that transport large amounts of moisture over peninsular India and produce sustained rainfall."



Goa yet to witness conditions needed for declaration of monsoon onset

The monsoon reached Kerala only a day earlier on June 5 before progressing rapidly towards Goa. "This is one of the fastest progressions of the monsoon towards Goa in recent years," Kumar said. "There have been several years when the monsoon stalled near Karwar for days before advancing into Goa. This year, the movement has been much quicker."

Meteorologists are monitoring rainfall activity, wind strength and convective development over the Arabian Sea and the west coast. Once these conditions strengthen and become sustained across Goa, the IMD is expected to formally declare the onset of the southwest monsoon over the entire state.

Water metro DPR to be prepared within two months

Panaji: Goa govt has intensified efforts to advance the proposed water metro project. According to the river navigation department (RND), Union govt has advised the state to prepare a detailed project report (DPR) immediately and submit it for consideration of financial assistance. In response, Goa govt has initiated the process of appointing Kochi Metro Rail Limited to prepare the DPR. The report is expected to be completed within the next two months.

"River navigation minister Subhash Phal Desai is following up the water metro project with the Centre for putting it on fast track," said RND director, Vikram Raje Bhosale.

TOI had reported in Nov 2025 that Kochi Metro Rail Ltd began a detailed survey across 28 locations in Goa as part of a feasibility study for the proposed mass water transit system to assess potential routes and passenger demand for a future water taxi network across the state.

Following the feasibility study, the Kochi team identified eight feasible routes covering around 11km across Goa, including Panaji-Narve, Betim-Old Goa, Old Goa-Sarmas, Vasco-Cortalim, Cortalim-Durbhat, Old Goa-Cumbharjua, Panaji-Dona Paula-Vasco and Panaji-Chapora. The ninth route, including a sea-route stretch from Chapora to Keri and Tiracol, is also under consideration.
