Nature and details of the action(s) taken, initiated or order(s) passed	The Appellate Authority vide order dated 27 th February 2026 (received on 12 th March, 2026) has partially upheld the Order-in-Original No. 69/ADC/Noida-Cus/2023-24 dated 22 nd March, 2024 passed by Additional Commissioner, Noida Customs Commissionerate, Uttar Pradesh.

Details of the violation(s)/ contravention(s) committed or alleged to be committed;	<p>The Company had initially received an order dated 22nd March, 2024 from the Office of Additional Commissioner, Noida Customs Commissionerate, Uttar Pradesh ("Impugned Order"), confirming an amount of Rs. 33.43 crore as duty paid short along with applicable interest, imposing penalty of Rs. 82 crore and redemption fine of Rs.191.76 crore under the Customs Act, 1962.</p> <p>Subsequently, the Company filed an appeal against the Impugned Order and now the Appellate Authority vide its order dated 27th February 2026 (received on 12th March, 2026) has partially allowed the Company's appeal and upheld the Impugned Order with respect to demand of Rs. 33.43 crore as duty short paid along with applicable interest and penalty of Rs. 41 crores . The demand for penalty amount of Rs. 41 crore and redemption fine of Rs. 191.76 crore has been set aside. Consequently, there has been a reduction in the substantial amount of total demand against the Company in this matter.</p>
Impact on financial, operation or other activities of the listed entity, quantifiable in monetary terms to the extent possible.	Based on the Company's assessment and advice of the legal counsel, the Company has a strong case on merit and will file the second appeal against such demand of duty, interest and penalty confirmed by the Appellate Authority and does not reasonably anticipate any material impact on its financial or operational or other activities.
